Any additional races not shown in the programme will not count towards the overall position.

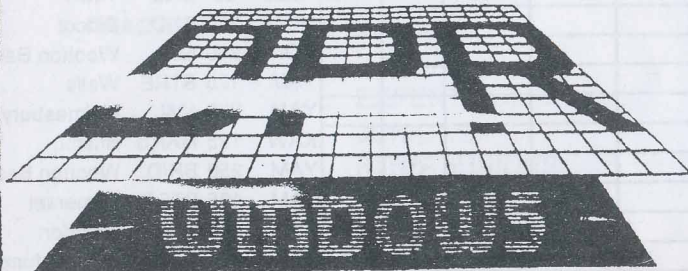

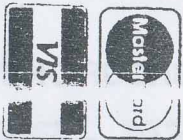
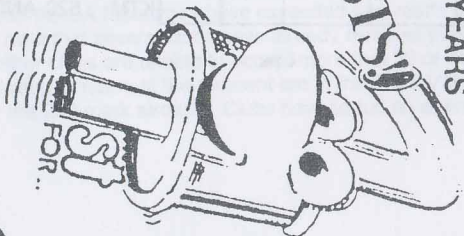

The AMCA Solo Championships.

The Opening Rounds of the 2005 Motocross Championships get underway on the 15th May at Culham with the Faringdon Club organising the First Round for the 125 and Open Classes. In an effort to spread the Championship Rounds throughout the whole of the AMCA each group of clubs have been asked to organise a round. The Second Round moves to the North Midlands on the 5th June with the venue likely to be Warmingham Lane and two weeks later the riders move to Bridgewater's track at Enmore for the Third Round. A new venue for the Championships will be used in the Trent Valley Group on the 10th July for the Lincoln Club, using the Caister Circuit and on 31st July the riders return again this year to Matchams Park with the South East Group organising the event followed a week later by the North Shropshire and Welsh Group hosting the 6th Round at Hawkstone Park in Shropshire. This year the rounds have been extended from the usual six to eight and Round Seven is due to be run on the 18th September by the Hereford Club and finally the North West Group take on the last round on the 9th October.

The other groups not mentioned in the Championships are hosting Internationals and these are the West Midlands with the Wolverhampton Club organising the 250 and 500 Open Class at Bewdley on the 1st May. In August the Northampton Club from the East Group host the 125 International followed by the Sidecars on the 11th September at Boraston with the Teme Valley Club, (Border Group), organising this event. The Yorkshire Group are hosting the one round Super Class Championships with the best riders from last years 125 and Open Classes on the 20th March at Fingingley.

New Grouping

Some reorganisations of certain Groups has taken place since last year, due to balancing the numbers in the groups and the South West Group has perhaps had the biggest changes. The group now consists of Andover, Bath, Bridgwater, Christchurch, Devizes, Marshfield, North Wilts, Purbeck and Street Clubs. Meanwhile a new group has been formed to the north of Bristol, which is called North Avon and has amongst them a new club called Berkeley Heath, which is an offshoot from the Dursley Club. This group also includes Bristol, Cheltenham, Chipping Sodbury, Dursley, Stroud, Tormarton and Uley.

Several of the Wessex clubs from last year are helping to form a new group called Wessex and South Wales and this group now consists of Gloucester, Hereford, Llantrisant, Merthyr, Newport (Gwent), Raglan, Ross Falcons, Skewen, Upton and Worcester and these clubs have already arranged over 33 events this year. The West Midland Group remains basically the same with the Acorns returning to the group, whilst the Border Group has lost Hereford Club from last year. The rest of the groups are unchanged from last year with a new club at Ilkeston joining the Trent Valley Group. A new South East Group has been formed consisting of Avon Sporting, Eastbourne, Faringdon, Hillingdon, Rugby, Southam and Stratford with the possibility of a new club being formed at Milton Keynes in connection with the new track, which is now open on a permanent basis for practice near to the M1 at Milton Keynes. Riders do need to be members and have to book a practice session.

A total of 360 Motocross events have been organised this year amongst the 12 Groups and on Sunday the 13th March there are eight events arranged at present, which have been included in the Fixture List. During April riders will be given a choice of entry and details will be included on the Entry Sheets now with clubs.

Licences Up

Already licences this year for AMCA Motocross have exceeded last year's figures with well over 3,000 already issued. It is interesting to note that several clubs have already reached their maximum target, which is 60 in many cases and several other clubs are unable to accept more than 30 or 45 riders due to the problems in running events. The largest group of riders at the moment are in the Trent Valley with over 300 licences issued and most groups are over the 250 mark already. Clubs have to run an event for up to every 15 riders they issue licences to.
