





Today's Racing

Today is the tenth time that the Crystal Palace season has opened on Easter Monday with a joint London County Council - South Eastern Centre venture. They were among the first to arrange meetings so early in the year, but their success soon encouraged other circuits and the weekend is now one of the most popular in the road racing calendar. But even with meetings at Thruxton, Oulton Park and Cadwell Park, there are still enough riders—and plenty of reserves—for today's fifteen races.

Practising went on right through Saturday afternoon, but this morning's early arrivals can see more between 10 o'clock and 11.30. Every driver has to complete at least three qualifying laps during one of the practice periods.

The 125 c.c. event is to be run off at noon, and it will be a surprise if, at the end of the ten laps, Fred Hardy on the Sheene Bultaco isn't the first past the flag. In all, over a third of the field consists of Bultacos—they took the first four places here last Easter—but it will be interesting to watch the performance of a Tohatsu in the hands of David Simmonds, one of the racing brothers from Stanwell.

Then, after a lunch break, the racing programme gets fully under way. The 250 c.c., 350 c.c. and 500 c.c. solo classes are all to be run off in two 5-lap heats with a 10-lap final. Among the lightweights, Fred Hardy-this time on the R.E.G. twin-will surely be out to avenge his one second defeat last Easter by Blake Osborne, who is again riding an N.S.U. Others to watch are Ken Watson (Aer-Macchi), Alan Pavey (N.S.U.) and Joe Dunphy-hardly a regular performer in this class—on the Villiers Special-engined Greeves prepared by Francis Beart. Joe Dunphy—whom you can read more about on page 17—must be an odds-on favourite for both Junior and Senior events. He is the only rider to have equalled John Surtees's five-and-a-half year old lap record for the circuit and, if conditions today are good, he might well knock off the six-tenths of a second needed to push the lap speed above 80 m.p.h. He can rely on Geoff Young, Alan Hunter, Noel Wright, Ian Goddard and others to make sure that he isn't allowed to dawdle.

Finally, the three-wheelers. Only nine starters are allowed (as against twenty-five solos) so there will be more heats—three of 5 laps each—as well as a 10-lap final and a 5-lap invitation handicap for the twelve fastest at the end of the day. It's nice to welcome back Alan Young after several years' absence from the Palace and it will be interesting to see how he fares against another Alan—Thurgood—who won at Bemsee's meeting last August.

With fourteen races in under four hours, it should be a full enough afternoon for anyone. but if the lunch break seems a little long, why not take a stroll down to Ramp Bend and have a look at the progress that's been made on the National Recreation Centre since last Easter. Now you can clearly see the exciting architectural features of this centre—the crescent-shaped stadium, the high hostel block on the hillside and the massive sports hall with its Olympic standard swimming and diving pools.

No more motor-cycle racing at Crystal Palace till August Monday... but why not make a note of





Anyone who had not previously met Joe Dunphy might have been somewhat surprised by his win in the 1962 Manx Senior Grand Prix. After all, before this race Joe had only short circuit successes to his credit, although he had aimed persistently at Manx honours for six years. Now, at the age of 24, he had arrived. However, those who know him well or have even casually spoken to him are not at all surprised by Joe's achievements. On a rain-soaked course, he demonstrated a characteristic steadiness and determination, which combined with his skill at covering wet surfaces, proved more than a match for his rivals.

Joe's racing career began at Brands Hatch in 1956. He was 19 and riding a 650 c.c. Triumph; but this was no story book success—he fell off. However, Joe registered his first win at Brands in the following year at the Eynsford Trophy meeting and, in May that year, had his first race at the Palace—a "Bemsee" Club Day—but it was not until Easter Monday 1961 that he had his first victory in a final here. On that day he won the 500 c.c. event, heading a field that included Ned Minihan, Robin Dawson and Ernie Wooder. Last year, Joe again won this race, followed it up with another Palace "first" on August Monday and, in September, came victory in the Manx Senior.

Quiet and unassuming, Joe would be the first to agree that more than a little credit for his success last year must go to the fine machine he rode and to the outstanding technical assistance he received from Francis Beart. In fact, the '61 Norton on which he won the Manx Senior was the same machine on which Ned Minihan had won twelve months earlier. Significantly, Joe was the only one of the first five home whose bike offered no mechanical trouble. *Motor Cycling's* report of the race remarked that, when examined after the race, "Dunphy's Norton showed not the slightest trace of external oil". His association with Francis Beart has continued and indeed today Beart has taken the unusual step for him of preparing a two-stroke machine—a 250 c.c. Villiers-powered works Greeves.

Although he is usually regarded as Anglo-Irish, Joe Dunphy was born in Paddington 25 years ago and has lived most of his life in London and seems to like it. Certainly Crystal Palace is his favourite circuit.

Road racing naturally occupies the greater part of Joe's spare time, although he is still able to find time for swimming and judo, which keep him in peak fitness.

Next year Joe will be going abroad to participate in the World Championship circuit. We wish him the best of luck there and hope that we shall see a championship performance this afternoon.




