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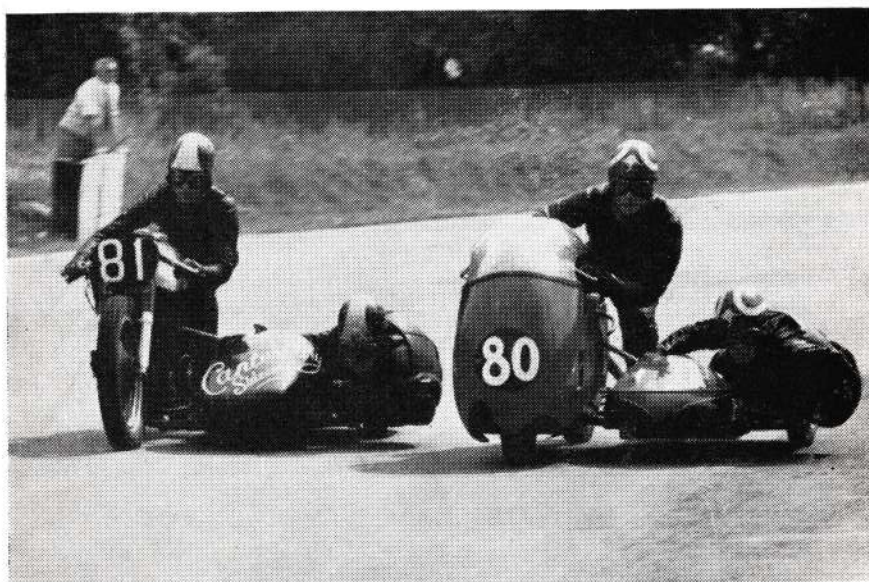

FOREWORD

Londoners who like motor cycle speed are lucky to have the Crystal Palace, for no other big city in Britain has a specially constructed road circuit within its metropolitan area, right in the midst of a densely populated district, owned by the ratepayers and easily attainable simply by boarding a bus!

Another of the specialities of the Palace that appeals to enthusiasts is its "open-ness". Set as it is, in the centre of acres of enclosed parkland, there is freedom to move about and watch the racing from different vantage points without having to do much walking.

Long experience of the running of speed events—remember path racing was popular at the Palace way back in the 1920s—has taught the organisers everything there is to know about how to put on, and carry through, a varied, fast-moving programme. There's never a dull moment at a Crystal Palace meeting.

Another good feature is the closeness of the racing. Catering very much for local riders, the Palace always produces really clean competition. And with contenders of the calibre of 1961 Senior M.G.P. winners Ned Minihan, Joe Dunphy, Norman Surtees, Fred Hardy, Ernie Wooder and Robin Dawson in action—to mention only a few—you can be sure that, whatever the weather, today's meeting will bring you some of the finest sport to be seen anywhere in Britain this Easter.

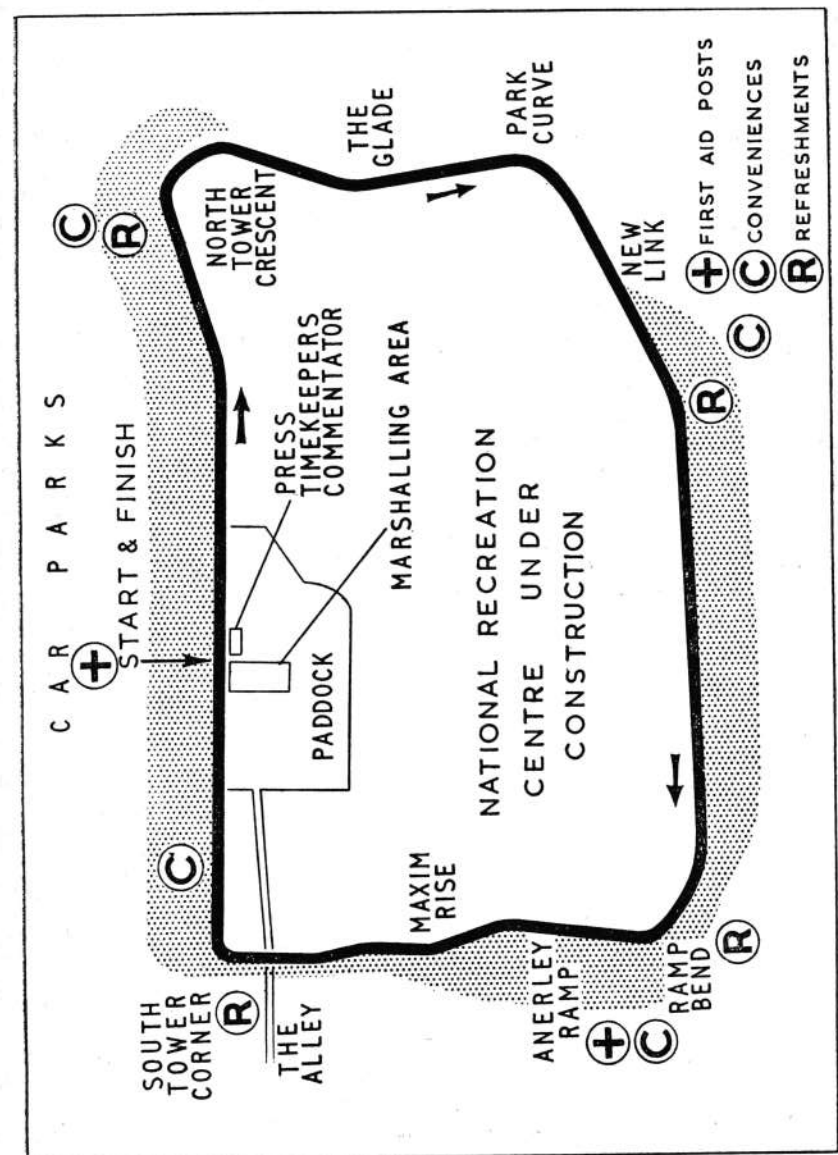

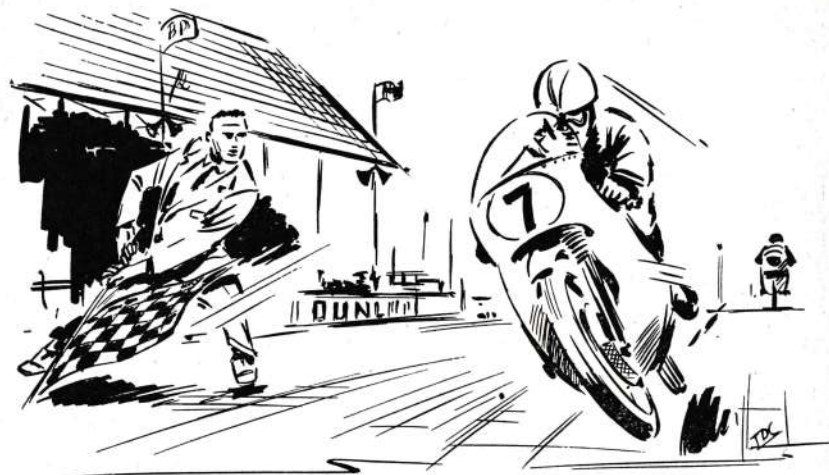
