

Today's Racing

The name M. P. O'Rourke first appeared in the Crystal Palace results book on 22 August, 1953 as the winner of the 350 c.c. event in which he set new lap and race records. Mike O'Rourke's last race at this circuit was just four years ago when he was placed third in the 250 c.c. at the Easter meeting.

Today we say a very hearty "welcome back" to Mike who is riding today in both the 125 c.c. and 250 c.c. classes. In the former event, O'Rourke-on a Bob Rowe Honda—will find the going about three m.p.h. faster than when he last raced here. Dave Simmonds, last Easter's winner and his brother Mike, both on Tohatsus, Jim Russell (Honda), and Wilf Friend (Bultaco) will all set a hot pace. But Mike's main problem may well be the brand new works Honda which Joe Dunphy collected two weeks ago from London airport. Though Joe has never ridden in this class at the Palace before, the performance he put up in his first race with a 250 c.c. machine last year suggests that he will be difficult to beat on a smaller machine.

If Dunphy does win this race he could go on to sweep the board and win all four solo races, which feat has not been done at the Palace since Mike Hailwood's

last appearance five years ago.

Joe will be up against Mike O'Rourke again in the 250 c.c. class. Mike will have the 250 desmo twin Ducati which Hailwood and Surtees have both raced. Dunphy will be driving a '64 works Greeves. The '63 Greeves, with Joe in the saddle, scored its first win on any circuit at this meeting last year. Not two months ago Joe brought it home first of the British machines and fifth overall in round one of the 1964 world championships at Daytona. This sort of form must make him favourite here again. However Terry Grotefeld (AerMacchi) who was first in the Isle of Man "Southern 100" last May and at Silverstone in the Bemsee Trophy meeting when he beat Hailwood's lap record, and Fred Hardy (Bultaco) who had a first in this class at Brands last October could both upset Joe's plans today.

Dunphy should again be prominent in the 350 and 500 c.c. classes which he also won here last August Monday. You may remember that, in winning the latter he became the first man on two wheels to lap this circuit at over 80 m.p.h. More recently Joe was first in the senior class in a National meeting at Snetterton in September and third in the Redex trophy race at Brands a month later. This year he has forsaken the Norton marque and will be riding the 350 AJS and 500 Matchless entered by Tom Kirby.

Roger Hunter is another Kirby entrant on similar machines to Dunphy's. Hunter was second in the Manx Junior last year and had the hard luck story of the year in the Senior when an empty fuel tank forced him to retire when leading on the last lap.

The man who passed Hunter and went on to win the Senior in record time was Griffith Jenkins. Griff, who is featured in this Easter's Palace Portrait on p.17 scored his first win in a National meeting in the Senior class here last Easter and won the 350 class in the Brands International on Whit Monday. He and Hunter should prove to be Dunphy's closest rivals, though there may be a surprise from Geoff Young who is due for a good result after a run of bad luck with faulty machines.

In the three-wheelers A. T. Baitup (Triumph), Mike Rowell (Norton) and Alan Thurgood (Matchless), all previous winners, are all competing today. Any of these could take the prize, but with only eight laps to run instead of the ten of previous Easters the fastest away may be the first home.

One of the runners in this race who should be able to treat his own cuts and bruises is Dr. Roger A. G. d'E. Willoughby of a local hospital. Dr. Willoughby hopes to find out just what it is that attracts those drivers who have come to him for running repairs. Another interesting racing debut in the sidecar event will be that of Mike Fiddaman of Colchester with the home-made Triumph powered Fiddaman Kneeler. To Mike and Dr. Willoughby we bid welcome to the sport and hope that they like everyone else will enjoy what should be a great day's racing.





Map of the Crystal Palace Circuit



PALACE PORTRAITS

5 Griff Jenkins

Our first Palace Portrait which appeared in last Easter's programme told the story of Joe Dunphy, a London Irishman. Today is the turn of the London Welsh in the person of Griffith Jenkins. For despite his name and Welsh parentage Griff Jenkins was born in London twenty-four years ago.

Motorcycling has been Griff's greatest interest since he left school, and whilst still a bachelor he can devote himself wholeheartedly to the sport. His first road race was in the Isle of Man at the age of 18, and later in the same year he rode in his first short circuit race on the mainland—at the Crystal Palace.

Like many another before, he did not strike gold at the first attempt and, by 1961, although his name was appearing among the first six in the results sheets, there were perhaps few who would have predicted anything remarkable for the future. In last year's Easter Monday programme we did not even mention him as a possible threat to Joe Dunphy in the 500 c.c. race.

But Griff won that race by 0.2 seconds, holding off a tremendous challenge from Dunphy who had been baulked at the start. So much for our pre-race forecasting.

Griff went on to rub in this lesson by winning the 350 International race at Brands on Whit Monday and rounded off a highly successful season by taking the Manx Senior title three months later.

In the "Senior" Griff was mounted on Charles Mortimer's Beart-prepared Norton which had only had one previous outing—with Joe Dunphy at Ulster. At the time Francis Beart was quoted as saying that Jenkins' Norton was the fastest he had ever prepared. This year Griff has the same machine as well as last year's 350 c.c. A.J.S. He hopes to race both bikes in the T.T. and the Ulster G.P. and possibly the Dutch and Belgian as well.

His family follow Griff's racing career very keenly. His brother acts as mechanic and his father is usually there to cheer him on. No doubt the Jenkins' family will be represented here today hoping to see the Red Dragon of Wales on Griff's helmet lead the field home.




