The Lancashire Grand National and The War of The Roses

The stage is again set for one of the "classical greats" in motor-cycle sport—the Lancashire Grand National. In the many years that I have watched this event it has never failed to be a thriller, although the pattern has changed somewhat—and I am one of those who regrets the passing of those good old days—it is still the finest and most unpredictable Scramble of its kind.

Today, the L.G.N. is run on the more conventional moto-cross lines . . . on a good, spectacular and fast course, with riders and machines to match. But one thing hasn't changed, we still have an upper limit of 100 entrants. Of course, nowadays it's a heats and final affair, but that's the way the majority of riders prefer their racing today.

But I can remember many epic battles in the past when, up on treacherous Holcombe Moors, nr. Bury, the entire entry lined up across the 300 yd. wide starting-line, engines dead and riders some 10 yds. behind. Then, the wait before the "off"—air loaded with suspense . . . the dash to the bikes and the fantastic cavalry charge under a thick pall of blue exhaust smoke, as this great mass of riders roared up the hill to the first narrow bottleneck.

From then on it was a bitter struggle in deep mud—it always seemed to rain for days before the L.G.N.—and if ever a winner deserved his laurels this one did!

Today, the battle to win, even to survive the distance, is as great as ever and you cannot fail to enjoy racing when everyone puts so much "go" into it.

The race-within-a-race is still one of the big features of this event, for the original spirit of the "War of the Roses" is kept. Irrespective of who wins the L.G.N. the silver casket containing the faded red and white roses will be presented to the first Lancashire, or Yorkshire, rider to cross the line. It may well be the winner, of course, for in the long history of this event it has been known to happen with uncanny frequency!

The winner of the Lancashire Grand National will also receive the DAILY HERALD Trophy and souvenir and the MOTOR CYCLING Challenge Trophy.

Added to all this excitement, we have the second round of the A.C.U. 250 cc Scrambles Driver's Star Competition, the equivalent of the British Championship for lightweight machines. The holder of the 1962 Star is Dave Bickers, former World and European Champion, who is now touring the Continent in a determined attempt to win back the World 250 cc crown for Britain.

And the young man who could well follow Bickers to the top in world moto-cross, but first has his sights set on the 250 cc Star, is here today—Bryan Goss, the latest addition to the Greeves team, who rides a replica of the scrambles machine Bickers used when winning the world title. Goss, stockily built, rides with the dedication of a world-beater. Watch as he drives himself to the limit . . . with success written over every move he makes.
