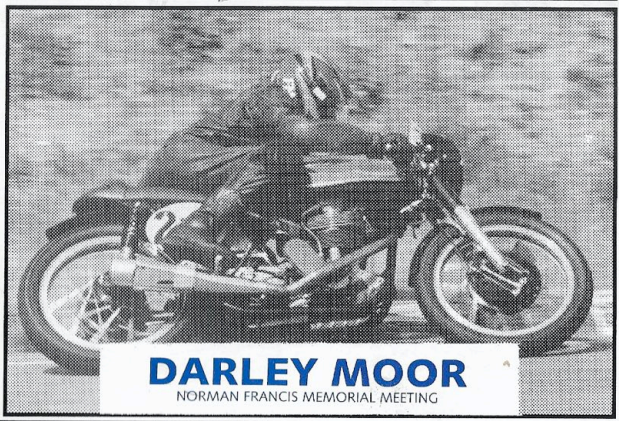
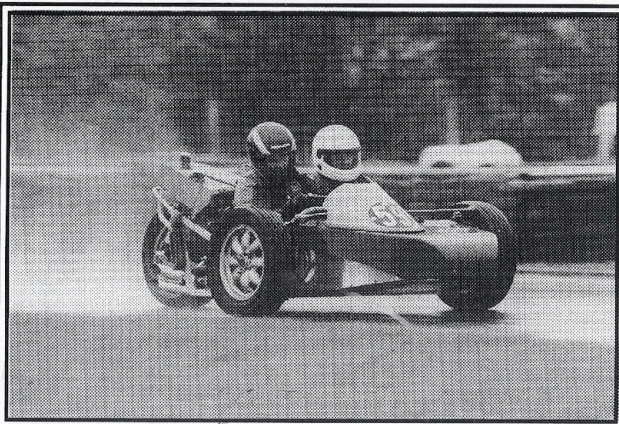

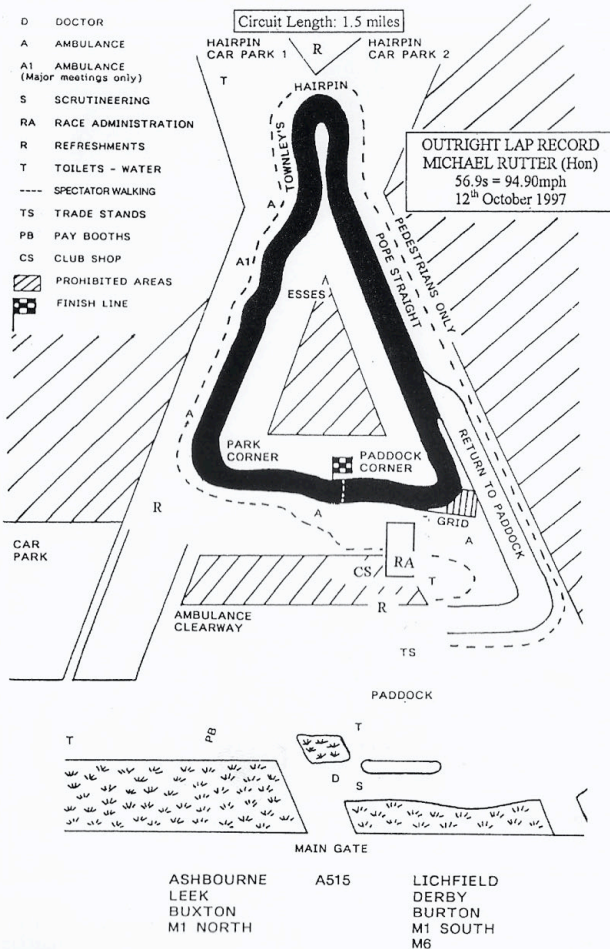

### DARLEY MOOR – ROUND 5

Welcome to the VMCC Historic Racing Club's fifth meeting of the 2000 season here at Darley Moor.

We have had only five days to rest since our last meeting down in Kent at the twisty Lydden circuit. Riders will have been beaver away in their sheds to ensure the bikes are in peak condition to survive the rigours of Darley's fast triangular track.

You will be able to see each race gather just off circuit at Paddock Corner: in an effort to keep the race gaps tight and the meeting on schedule the off-circuit starting grid is a real advantage.

The paddock is easily navigable as most competitors park up on the main drag: spectators are encouraged to come and take a closer look at the machinery during the lunch break.

Although viewing at the Hairpin means a long trip on foot there is a car park close to the rear of the circuit, so for the less energetic, it is still possible to get to see the close-up action. The riders brake hard to get round the 180 degree turn before they disappear up the long Pope Straight, an ideal opportunity for the photographers.

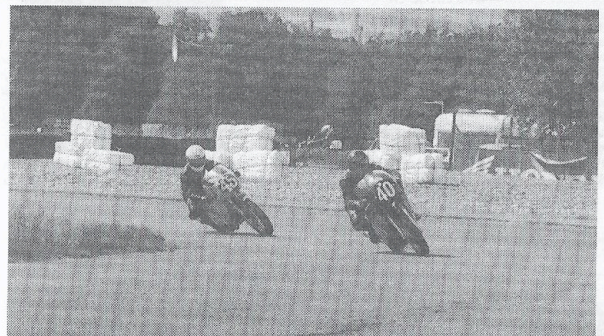
