

On behalf of the Bristol Motorcycle Club, welcome to Dodington Park, which this afternoon stages the First Round of the 1977 British Sidecar Cross Championship.

Todays meeting here at Dodington where the B.M.C.C. has previously sucessfully promoted four 250cc Moto Cross Grand Prix, two 500cc Grand Prix and the 1973 Trophee Des Nations (the 250cc World Team Championship) marks the departure from tradition with the first Sidecar Cross in the Clubs 31 year history, and introduces a new course and venue to many Sidecar Cross drivers and enthusiasts.

Our competitors in todays meeting include Terry Good and Jess Rixon, the 1976 British Sidecar Cross Champions, and European Sidecar Cross Championship runners up Nick Thompson and Garry Withers on their new Wasp, outfit, plus all of the top ranking drivers from the 1976 British Championship who compete in the two legs of the Sidecar Cross Championship. In addition to the championship contenders we have a large number of expert sidecar drivers entered, in the British Sidecar Cross Qualifying Championship and many invited expert solo moto cross riders who compete for the Wessex National Solo Scramble Trophies.

The Sidecar Cross Championship is run over a series of six rounds, where drivers compete in two 30 minute plus 2 lap races. Points are awarded for each race of the Championship as follows:- 15 points for first place, 12 points second, 10 points—third, 8 points—fourth, 6 points—fifth, 5 points—sixth, 4 points—seventh, 3 points—eigth, 2 points—ninth, 1 point—tenth. The Championship is decided on the agregate points accumulated by each driver throughout the season. At the end of each season, as with the solo Moto Cross Championships, the highest placed drivers in the series are seeded to contest the European Sidecar Cross Championship and the lowest placed competitors relegated to the Qualifying Championship Series from which a similar number of top qualifying drivers are promoted to the championship proper.

The Bristol Motorcycle Club would like to express its thanks to Nick Thompson and Gary Withers who travelled to Dodington on a cold and foggy day, back in December to assist in the initial planning of the course and to the many club members who have given so much of their time to organise this meeting.




