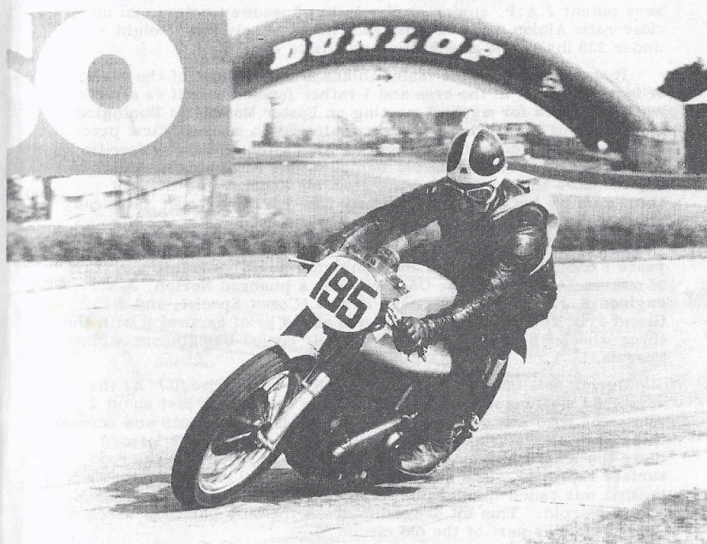

DONINGTON MEMORIES

On Easter Monday 1931 the first Donington Park meeting was held and I was there as an excited spectator, a 16 year old schoolboy who had already got the 'racing bug' since watching one or two meetings at another Midland short-circuit - Syston Park near Grantham.

I couldn't wait to have a go myself and in 1933 I acquired a 500cc racing OK Supreme in road-going trim. This was the 1931 T.T. bike which South African Joe Sarkis had raced in the Island. It had a very potent J.A.P. engine similar to the Speedway motors, an ultra close-ratio Albion gearbox, and with its extremely light weight - under 230 lbs. - the acceleration was quite something.

It was also one of the fastest bikes amongst those of the crowd of lads who lived in the area and I rather fancied myself as a racer when I entered for my first meeting on Easter Monday at Donington in 1934. But my illusion was soon shattered on my very first practice lap. Going down the straight at what I thought was a terrific speed, I was passed by Harold Daniell on his Norton doing about 20 m.p.h. more than me! The blast from his exhaust and the grit thrown up by his back wheel into my face really hurt me, physically and morally, as he disappeared into the distance.

However, it didn't put me off altogether and over the next 5 years I competed at most of the Donington meetings riding a mixture of makes. Apart from the OK there was a pushrod Norton, J.A.P. engined A.J.S. Special, Vincent-H.R.D. Comet Special, and a 250 Grand Prix New Imperial. There was also a brief excursion with the three-wheeler brigade in 1938 with an air-cooled Blackburne engined Morgan.

During this time I saw several changes in the circuit. At the very first meeting, when the length of the course was just about 2 miles, the road was comparatively narrow, loose in places and several trees were uncomfortably close to the road. By the time I raced there the length had increased to 2 miles 1000 yards and the road surface improved. The start and finish was still on the sweep down to what was called the hairpin because at the first meeting it was almost a hairpin. This bit of road is about the only part now which is recognisable as part of the old circuit.

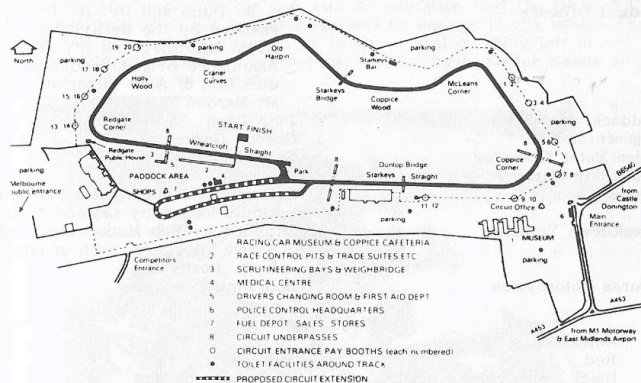
The great variety of bikes in those pre-war days, the friendly atmosphere, the 'camaraderie' amongst the riders, to say nothing of the fun and games before and after a meeting, leave wonderful memories. Happily this same atmosphere has been repeated to a large extent at V.M.C.C. meetings.

It was a great disappointment when Donington didn't reopen soon after the war as we had hoped. I played a small part in trying to bring this about. I was at school with Gillie Shields, who by now

owned the Park, and I went to see him to try and help in this direction.

Now, thanks to Bernard Wheatcroft, we have a wonderful new circuit, unrecognisable from the pre-war Donington, but of course the old circuit would not have been suitable for present-day racing, and already we have had successful meetings for the old machines. What we have managed to do is to retain a lot of the spirit and atmosphere of those early days and I hope that today will be no exception and that everyone will have an enjoyable meeting.

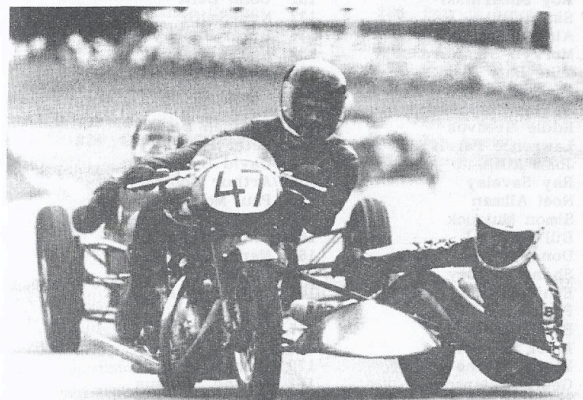

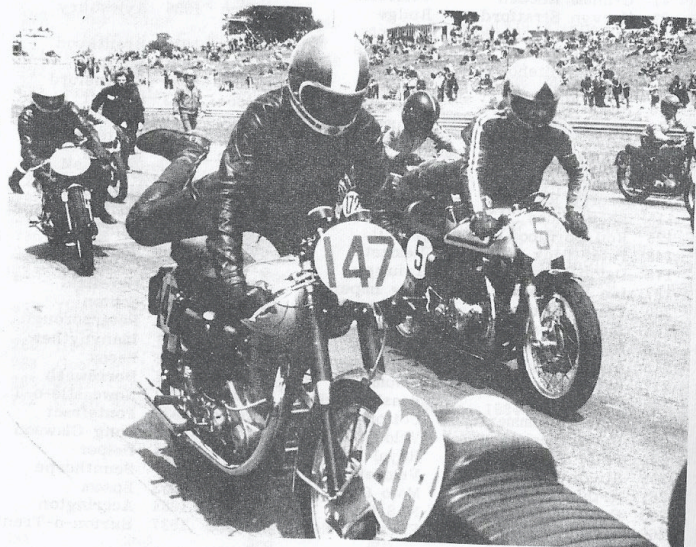
