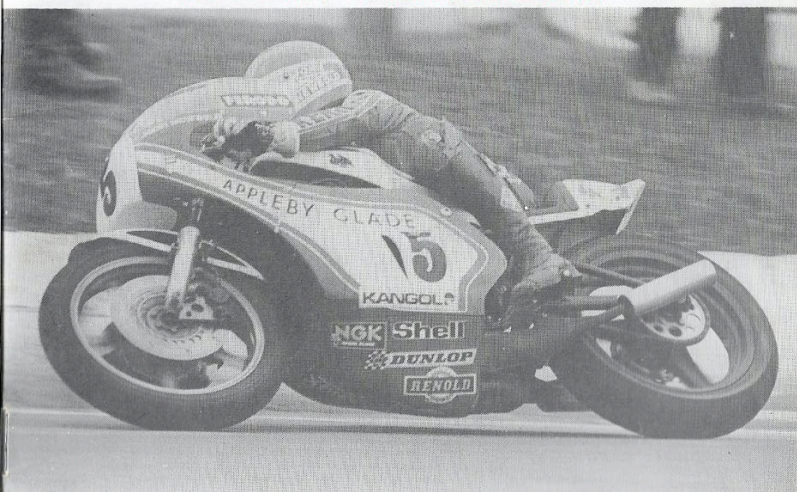

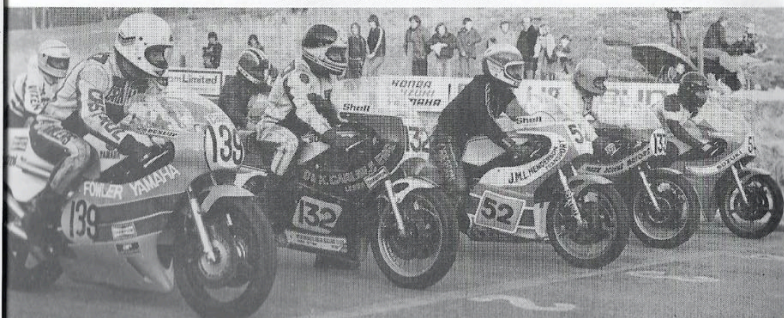

Wood kicks-off best

Graham Wood, the popular 27 year old Scunthorpe rider, comes to today's Donington fixture with a nine point lead in the ACU British Solo Championship and with the knowledge that he is to contest a full season of Grand Prix racing on the Fowler of Bristol Yamaha.

The British Championship season started off brilliantly for Wood at the beginning of March at Mallory Park. He won the 10 lap opening round after a determined challenge from reigning champion Keith Huewen. Huewen valiantly tried to usurp Wood from the lead, but the Scunthorpe rider held the upper hand on that day — as he did with the two start-to-finish victories in the Trans Atlantic Qualifiers at the same meeting.

Once Steve Manship retired with a seized gearbox, third slot in the first round went to Bill Marks, in front of Tony Rutter, Chris Guy and Steve Henshaw.

For the second round of the series at Cadwell Park, Ron Haslam claimed the honours from Wood but not without Wood giving Haslam a good challenge. Haslam of course is missing from today's action having been summoned to Japan for Honda testing, but Ron will be back at Donington for the International on April 12/13.

Chris Guy and Bob Smith were next in line at Cadwell but Guy fell and Smith was forced into the slip road, finishing up eighth. So third place fell to Langley Mill's Alan Pacey from Bill Marks, while Steve May pipped Phil Henderson for fifth place on the last of ten laps.

A multiple shunt stopped the first heat of the Cadwell qualifier. Steve Manship's front wheel locked, causing him to fall, and taking Steve Henshaw and a couple of other riders with him. Manship suffered concussion, and Henshaw a broken finger.

500cc
Phil Henderson leads the 500cc ACU Star Series by five points from Steve Ward prior to today's 15 lap round.

Leeds' Steve Ward, Manx Grand Prix winner, won the opening round in the series at Mallory Park after early leader Rob Marks dropped out of the running. Henderson claimed second spot, from Phil Mellor and Jacksdales' Steven Henshaw.

For the second round, at Cadwell, Graham Wood had just taken delivery of his TZ500 1980 Yamaha and the result was a foregone conclusion. Wood waited until half distance before making his mark over Wakefield's Phil Henderson and Stuart Jones.

350cc
Tony Rutter heads the points table in both the 250 and the 350 Star Series before today's round. As far as the 350cc table goes, Rutter has a 3 point advantage over Alan Stewart, the first Donington champion.

The first round though, at Mallory, gave a first national win for Welshman Steve Williams on a Fowler's Yamaha. Williams' narrow win over Rutter came when Rutter lost time through clutch trouble.

At Cadwell a week later, Rutter was second again, this time to Alan Stewart who held the lead from lap one and this despite Stewart using a new 350 Yamaha engine and riding with a cracked frame.

250cc
Rutter's victory in the first round of the 250cc Star series, at Mallory, was a memorable sight for it was on the new 250 Rotax-engined Cotton — the first time the British-framed twin had defeated the Yamaha.

It was a close race too. Rutter led from start to finish but had a bevy of Yamahas in close contention, Phil Mellor finishing a tenth of a second behind with Andy Bond third and setting fastest lap. Donington's new local prospect, Steve Henshaw was right there too until an exhaust pipe retaining spring broke.

At Cadwell, the 250cc race was in two 8 lap parts, the first being won by Pete Hubbard and the second by Graham Atha. Overall though it was Hubbard's race, with Atha's average speed only being good enough for tenth on overall placings.

Once passed early leader Steve Wright, Hubbard and Rutter had a good tussle for the lead of their race and it wasn't until the penultimate lap that Hubbard, supported by the Dean of Lincoln Cathedral, got to the front.

Henshaw finished a fighting third, his broken finger from the multiple shunt in the Superbike heat being taped to the adjoining finger!

125cc
Hubbard's Cathedral sponsored operation is also a strong threat in the 125 ACU Star series, holding second place after two rounds and seven points behind Mick Higgins whose ex-Clive Horton Morbidelli won the opening round, at Mallory's March 2nd fixture.

At Cadwell Higgins had to give best to Hubbard; although Hubbard's Honda didn't match the power of the Morbidelli on the straights, Hubbard beat Higgins through the multitude of bends.

Sidecars
The only round of the Sidecar Star series, at Mallory, produced a good win for former world champion George O'Dell.

O'Dell was third to begin with, but ended up easy winners from Mal White and Clive Stirrat, with Dave Saville spinning out of the top placings.

At Cadwell however, in a non-championship round, O'Dell had to give best to White after a hard-fought contest with Terry Haslam being a very competitive third.

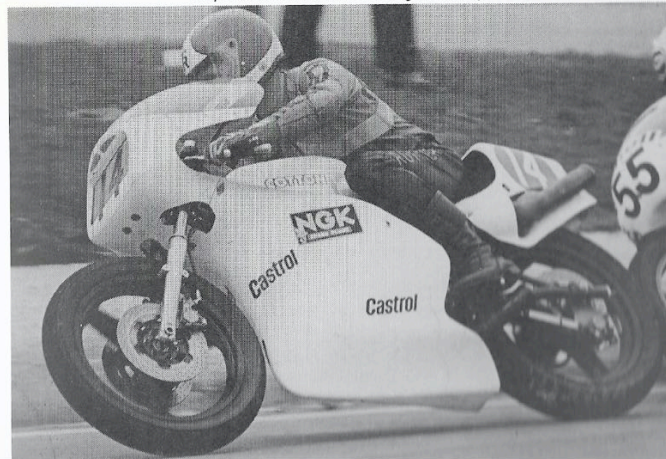

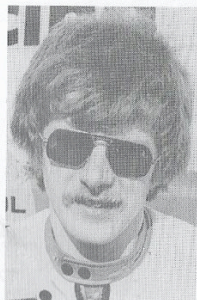

1979, 1st Mallory Trans Atlantic race, 2nd Ulster 500 GP, 3rd Ulster 750 GP.

Plans: To do Grand Prix racing again, "but need some good results in England first".

Career: First raced in 1969 on Tiger Cub; 1971 Triumph Prod Bonneville, 1972 Seeley Norton, 1973 Rocket

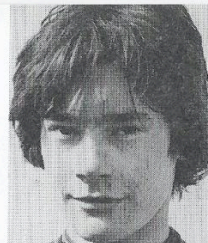
Three, 1974 Spondon Yamaha.

Plans: This season, to contest all British Championship rounds.

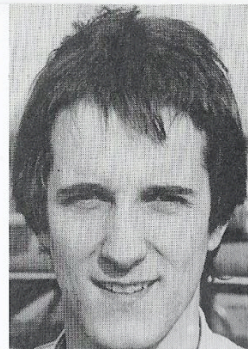
