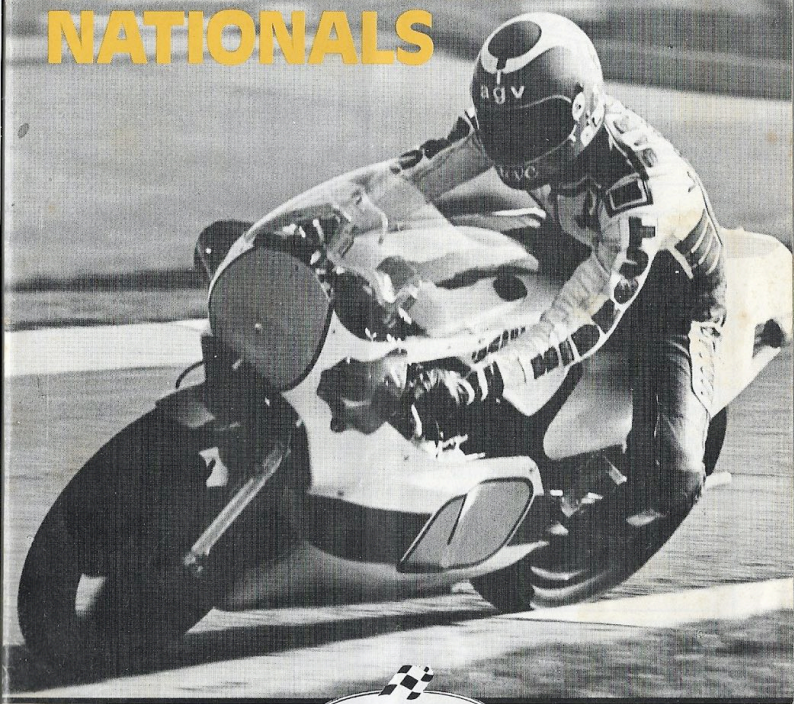

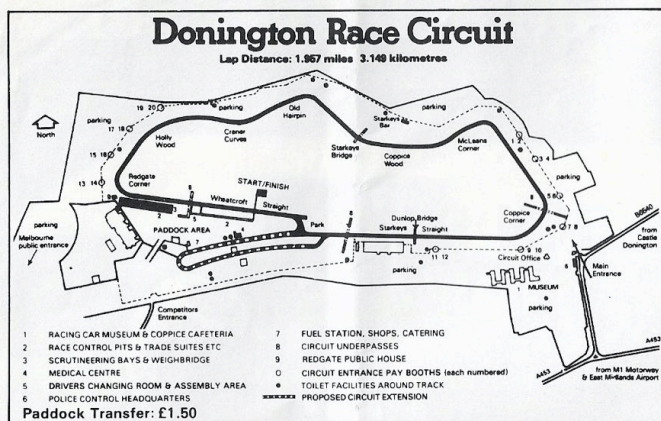

Catering facilities

The Coppice Cafeteria, situated within the Museum complex adjacent to the main entrance car park, offers full catering facilities. The Paddock Cafeteria (licensed) also offers a full range of meals while the adjoining open Barbeque bar offers steaks, pizzas and a carved buffet.

Ron Haslam — can he repeat last year's brilliance at Donington?

Quantity and quality

As Steve Parrish put it: "really, it is an International line-up," such is the quality of entry for the day's main race, the opening round of the John Player Superbike Trophy.

This is a new championship worth £9000 overall and should prove to be the highlight of Donington's national racing season. The prize money is certainly a lucrative carrot and as Suzuki Racing Manager Rex White quipped: "the prize money is so attractive we might earn something out of the meeting."

And money has to be uppermost in everyone's mind — however, the continued support of John Player and Sons here at Donington means quantity and quality is possible throughout the season with today's meeting the start of an ambitious programme of 10 meetings that takes in six Internationals.

Back though, to today's 10 race John Player Nationals meeting which brings the debut of the "British Suzuki" team and action against Ron Haslam and the Honda works team.

Keith Huewen debuts the Suzuki 500cc machine in the 18 laps 35.23 mile John Player Superbike Trophy opener while Haslam, and team-mates Wayne Gardner and Joey Dunlop will be on their latest 999cc bikes.

Haslam is quietly confident he can hold off the challenge of the Suzuki team, after all last season he was the dominant figure in racing at Donington with no less than eight race victories. Along the

way he clocked up enough points to make him the John Player Rider of the Year — an award worth £1500 — as well as winning the John Player Grand National Challenge.

Formidable as the Honda threat is, Suzuki reckon they pull off a race win. Roger Marshall, a winner last season at Donington rides one of the team's latest Formula 1 bikes, as does John Newbold. And there is the rising challenge of two of this country's brightest prospects Mark Boughton and Paul Iddon.

The action would seem to centre around those two teams and their eight riders, but that is far from the case. Steve Parrish has already put in many hours of testing on his new 500cc Yamaha and feels he could be amongst the winners. "It might be a bit down on horsepower compared to some, but its lighter weight should compensate, especially around Donington which is the sort of circuit that allows you to make up a bit of time. Although, when you are up against people like Ron Haslam, that is never easy."

Adding to the challenge is the winner of the opening round of the ACU British 1000cc Star championship at Cadwell Park Chris Guy on the Sid Griffiths Suzuki, and fresh from an early season triumph at Oulton Park, the 1981 British champion, Bob Smith on a Suzuki, together with another winner at that meeting Rob McElnea on a 750cc Yamaha.

Steve Henshaw rides the Harold Coppock Racing Yamaha, Gary Padgett, second to Guy at Cadwell is on a Suzuki, while Alan Carter, keen to prove a thing or two this season rides a 750cc Pharoah Yamaha.

John Player Superbike Trophy

Open to 401-1300cc Superbike machines, the series offers £9,000 in prize money based on £1,500 per race.

The dates of the series are today, May 16, May 31 and August 8.

The final on Sunday August 8 is The John Player Trophy Super round when double prize money and double points are at stake.

The May 31 Bank Holiday Monday round will be run in two 12 lap parts with £1,500 prize money awarded in each leg.

Overall positions for points will be based on times from both legs.

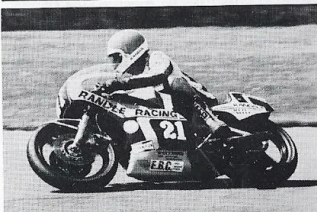
The three other rounds will be run as single races, each over 15 laps.

Prize money in each race is awarded as follows: 1st £400; 2nd £300; 3rd £250; 4th £200; 5th £150; 6th £100; 7th £70; 8th £30.

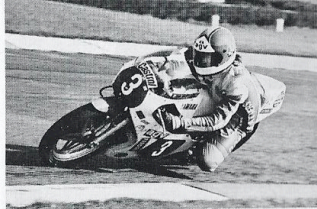
This is doubled for the final round.

Points will be awarded on a 15/12/10/8/6/5/4/3/2/1 basis to the first ten finishers in each round, except when they are doubled for the final round.

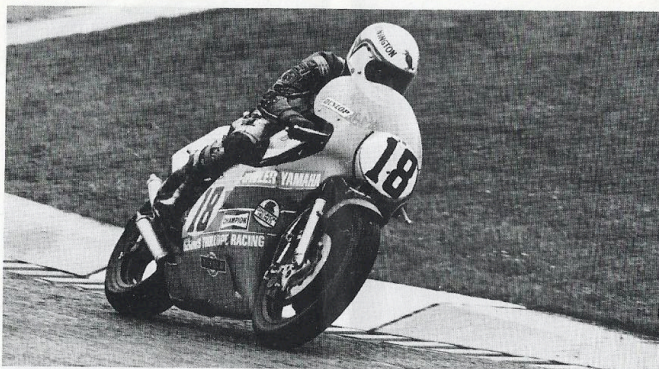
The overall winner will receive The John Player Trophy.



Clive Horton faces a busy time — he rides in the 125cc, 250cc and 350cc races.

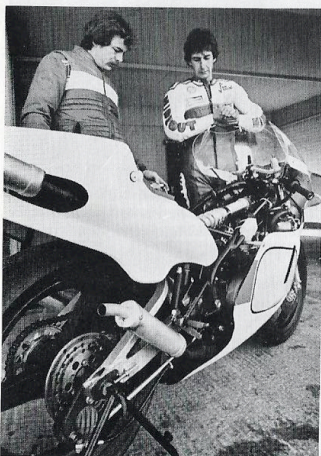


Peter Wild — bids for victory in the John Player Superbike Trophy on the Appleby Glade Suzuki.

The 250cc race also boasts an excellent entry. Gary Padgett, winner of the opening round of the ACU 250 Championship, is confident, but he faces a stiff challenge from a trio of Derbyshire riders, headed by Peter Wild on the John Davies Yamaha.

Wild's best performance at Donington came last season when he won the 250cc John Player European Championship round. Also bidding for a local victory are Tom Drury, a rider with a number of triumphs at Donington in past seasons, and Derby's Clive Horton, another rider who always goes well at Donington. He has already one race win to his credit this season, having won the 250cc race at Oulton Park. Also keen to impress is Tony Head, fourth in the Daytona 100, on the Waddon Ehrlich.

Phil Mellor, runner up to Haslam in the John Player Rider of the Year, has to be another strong contender for victory for an event that has produced enough entries to run two heats, each of 6 laps, with the first 18 qualifying for the 10 lap final.

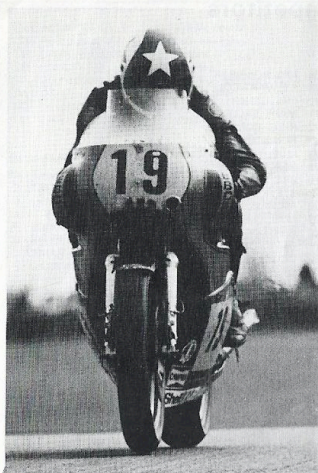
But, there is more than just prize money at stake in the race. The first 10 finishers, providing they hold an International Licence, are guaranteed a start in the double header John Player 250 International Championship races to be held on April 17/18.

This new championship offers a total prize fund of £15000 over a five race series, another feature of this year's John Player sponsorship programme at Donington Park.

Tony Rutter, a winner this season at Oulton Park, rides the Sid Griffiths Yamaha in the 12 lap 350cc race. Again, a strong entry should ensure close racing.

He can expect a tough time from team-mate Chris Guy, together with the Mal Carter Pharoah Yamahas of Donny Robinson and Alan Carter.

Another packed grid starts the 15 lap 500cc

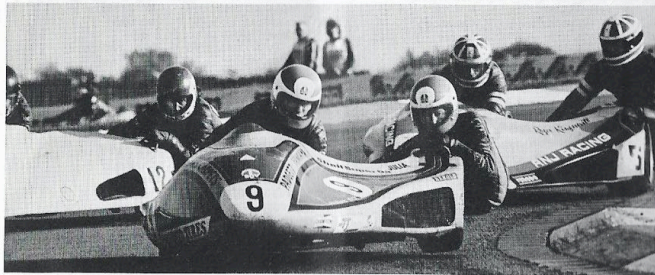

And, if Ron Haslam is everyone's tip for success in the opening round of the John Player Superbike Trophy, could it be that brother Terry will manage to make it a real family day out.

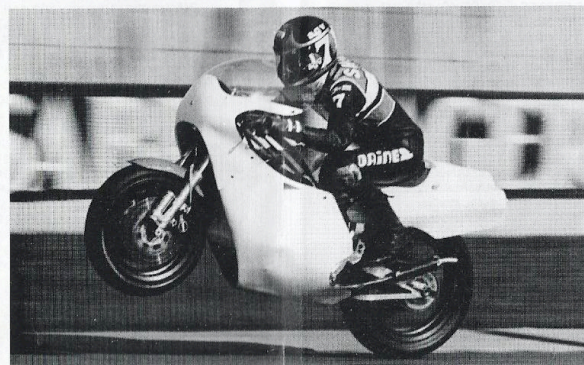
