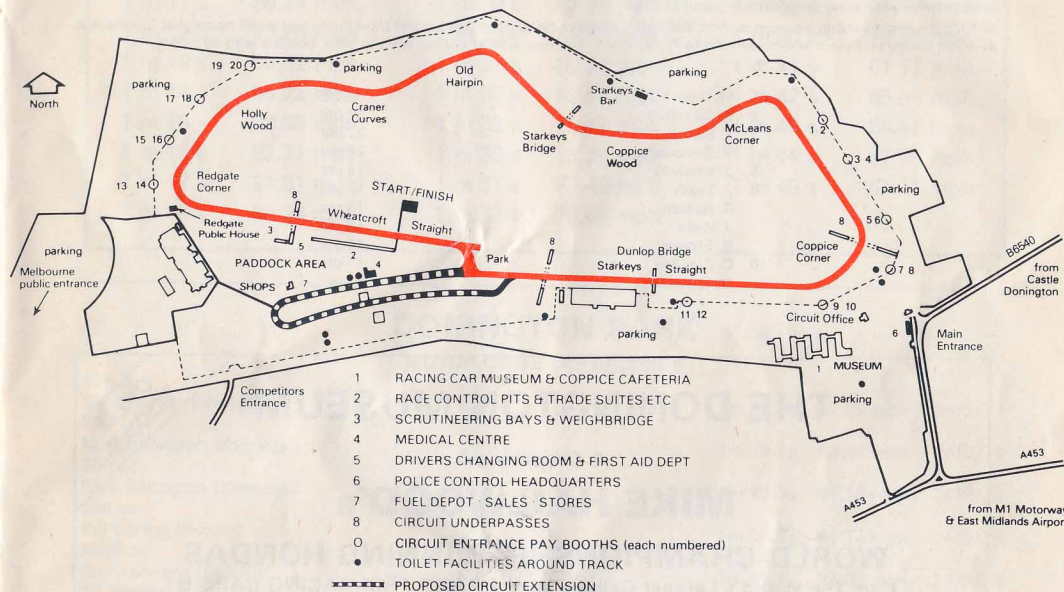

### CATERING FACILITIES

Coppice Cafeteria, is situated within the museum complex adjacent to the main entrance car park, offers full catering facilities (including restaurant) from 10 am.

Donington's own public house, the Redgate Lodge, is situated on the outside of Redgate Corner and access is by means of a paddock transfer. Buffet meals are available here.

Another bar facility is situated at Starkey's Bridge, adjacent to the popular 'Old Hairpin' spectator area. This also offers snack food.

A temporary bar is situated at Coppice Corner and there are tobacconists at other points around the circuit.

### Paddock Transfer

Spectators wishing to take a close view of the competitors in today's meeting can do so by purchasing a paddock transfer ticket, price £1, from the two entrances to the paddock area: Next to Redgate Lodge or the main competitors vehicle entrance to the paddock.

Spectators purchasing a paddock transfer also gain access to the inside spectator enclosure at Park Chicane.

Holders of paddock transfers also gain access to the Redgate Lodge public house. Other catering facilities and shops, selling a variety of items, are also situated in the paddock area.

### GRANDSTAND TRANSFER

Open Grandstand seating is available at Redgate, McLeans and Coppice Corners; charge is £1.00.



## DONINGTON CHAMPIONSHIP

Organised by The Pathfinders & Derby Motor Club Ltd, there is a season long series covering all promoted motor cycle meetings at Donington in 1979. The championship is decided in all the final results of every race (not heats or legs of a race) for solo and sidecar machines at national and international meetings held in 1979 at Donington.

The points are awarded on a 16-11-7-4-2-1 basis to the first six finishers. Ties will be decided by (a) the greatest number of first, second, etc. places; (b) the greatest number of points won at any one meeting.

The Champion will receive after the final meeting, £500. The runner-up wins £300 and the third place driver £200. The highest placed sidecar driver will receive an additional award of £250.

In 1978 the championship was won by Kork Ballington with 64 points. Barry Sheene and Dave Potter tied on 59 points, but Sheene was awarded the second place with three wins to Potter's two. The best sidecar placing went to Mick Boddice with 40 points.

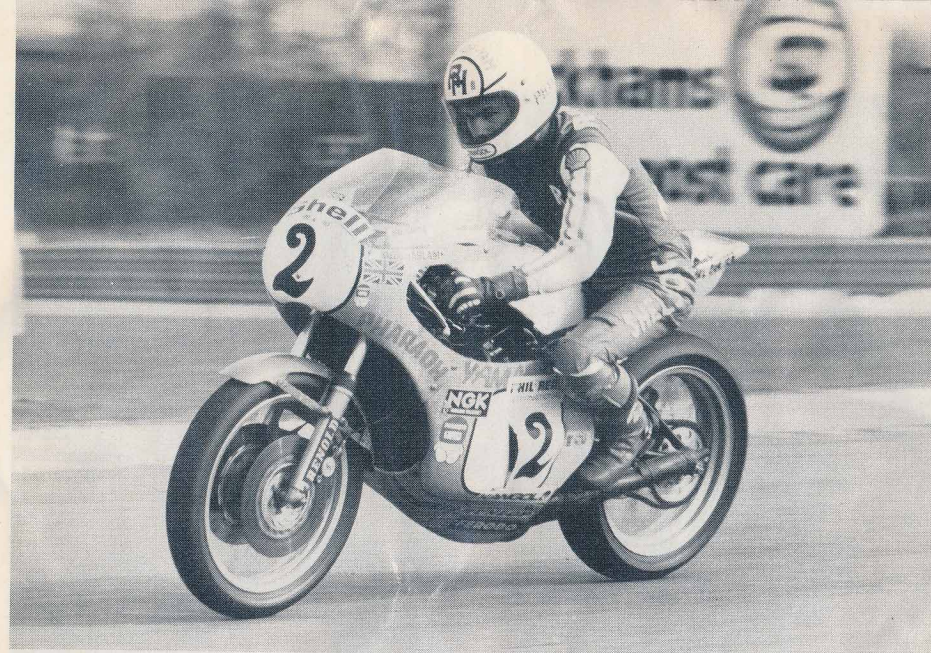

### **Ron Haslam: local superstar heads today's entry**

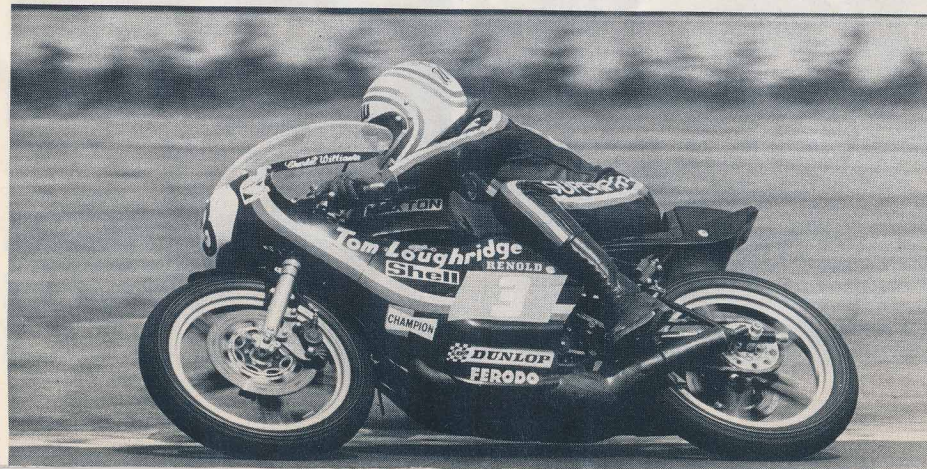

Two members of the defeated British team in the Easter Transatlantic Trophy Match Races, Ron Haslam and Keith Huewen, had to qualify the hard way, by topping the practice leaderboard the day before the opening round. But the pair will find precious little respect for their performance here at Donington today.

Hard on their heels in that wet and dry Brands qualifying session were Bob Smith, Graham Wood and Stan Woods, and Donington is as good a place as any for them to show that they can beat the teamsters.

Ron Haslam will have very different plans, of course. But for a seized engine Ron, the cheery Langley Mill racer might well have beaten both Barry Sheene and Mick Grant in the ATV televised race at

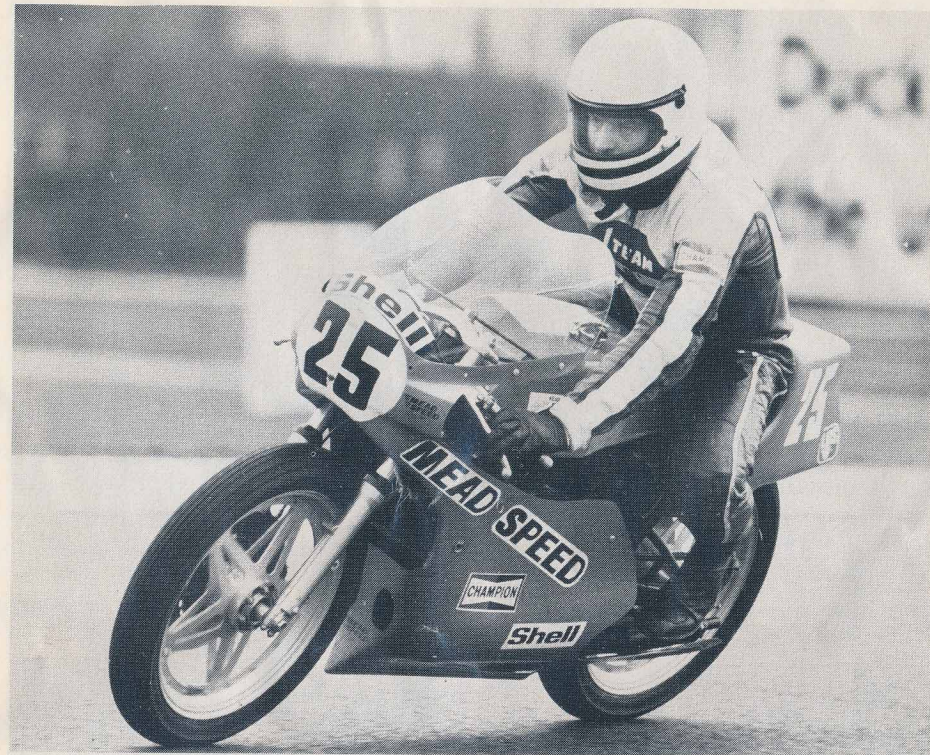

Donington back in March.

Add to that two British championship wins, a superb hat-trick at Cadwell Park, including two wins in the opening round of the MCN-Duckhams Superbike championship, and it shows that Ron Haslam on the Mal Carter supplied Pharaoh Yamaha is on top form.

His new team-mate Chris Guy, the blond haired youngster from Lichfield, has not had the same sort of luck. But despite a couple of painful and embarrassing crashes Chris has lost nothing of his skill, enthusiasm and daring.

With just a couple of seasons racing behind him 20 year old Chris has already rocketed through from the ranks of clubman to be one of this country's most exciting prospects. If he can hang on to his flying team-mate today he'll be up there in

the cash.

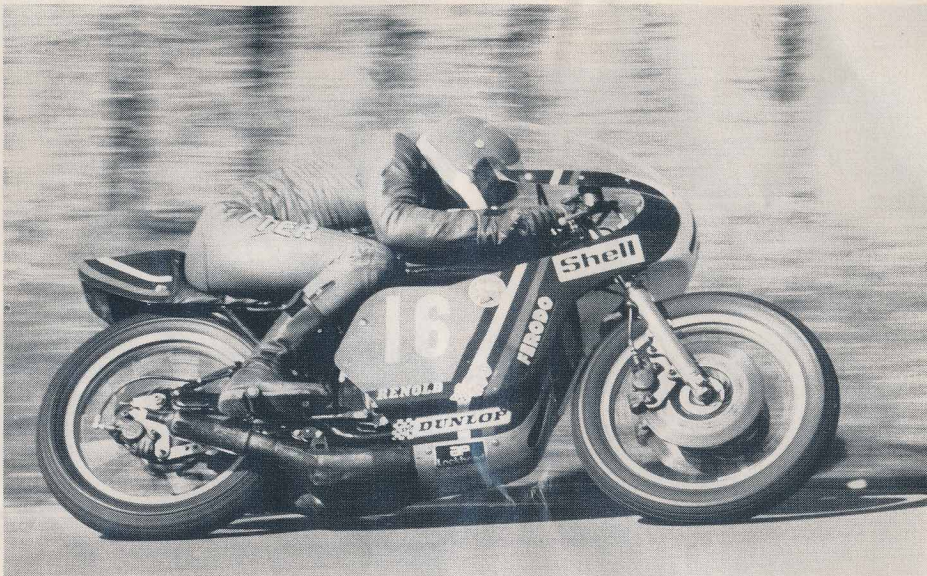
Keith Huewen is another overnight sensation. Third in the Grovewood Awards for 1978, announced in London at the beginning of this year Keith is backed by Len Manchester Motor Cycles at Melton Mowbray, one of Britain's Yamaha spares stockists run by former racer Arnie Fletcher.

At 22 Keith has plenty of time on his side, but the way he got to grips with his new 750 Yamaha over the close season shows that we will not have to wait too long before he has firmly established himself in the ranks of Britain's super stars.

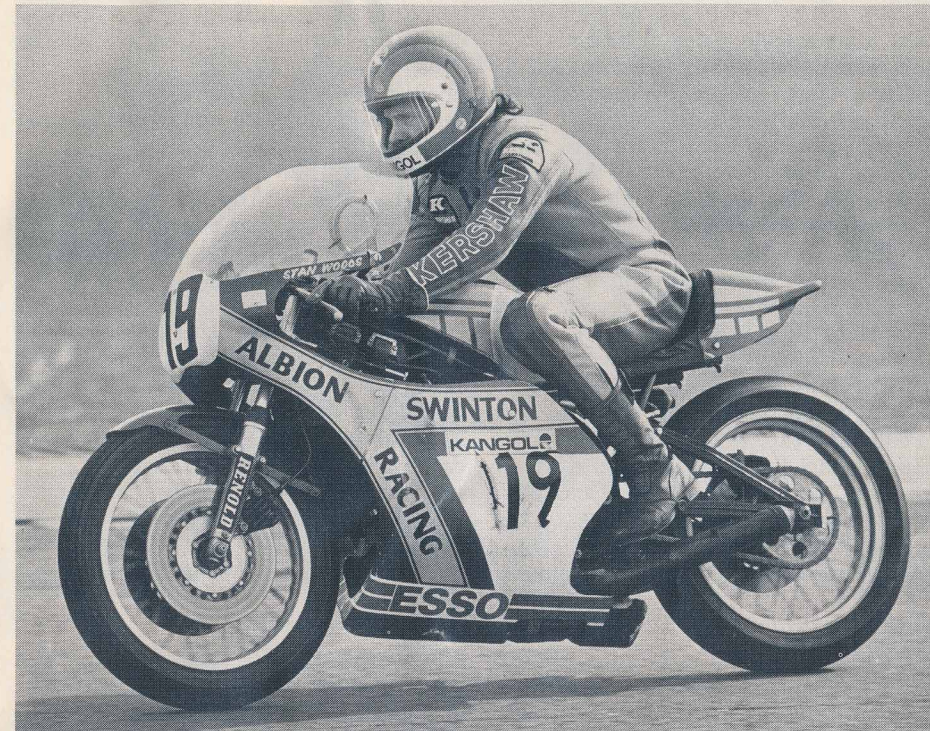
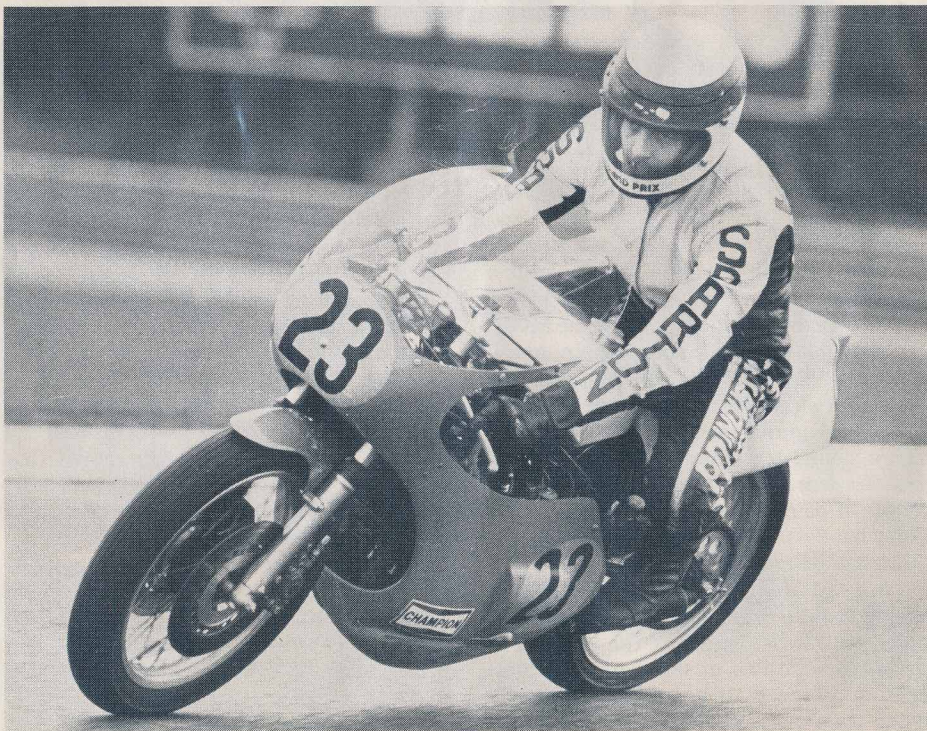
A big problem for Keith at present is finding the time to spare from his booming automatic gearbox business in Kettering, Northants. But when it comes to the crunch racing usually takes priority, just ask Keith's hard suffering partner!

British champion Steve Manship was

another top liner pipped at the post in a bid to qualify for one of those last three team places in the British squad to take on the Americans. It was a disappointment but the Leicester racer has had his share, and more, of blows along the way.

This year though Steve is sponsored by Derby businessman Tony Robinson on a pair of 750 Yamahas. Tony is keen and enthusiastic and prepared to spend the money to help Steve's career.

But even this year, when things began to look a little rosier, Steve found himself brought down at Oulton Park during practice for the Easter Monday meeting, when American visitor Wes Cooley took a dive in front of him.

Last season Steve figured in that controversial 500cc race at the British Grand Prix when heavy rain made lap scoring difficult. Steve was thought to have won the race but was then relegated a place in favour of Kenny Roberts.

Factory rides do not always spell success for a racer. Scunthorpe's Graham Wood knows that all too well! His time spent on the Spartans as a test and development rider did little to help his own career. While the dedicated Barry Hart struggled to keep his racing team going, hamstrung through lack of sponsorship, poor Graham had to grin and bear it.

Finally Barry and Graham came to mutual agreement that Graham could ride another machine in the 750cc class, and thanks to early support from Len Manchester Motor Cycles and then Dennis Trollope from Fowlers of Bristol, Graham has been racing some very competitive Yamahas for the past few months.

Quiet and unassuming Graham is now rapidly emerging as one of Britain's top privateers, and if his results over Easter are any guide to his current form, he will be a tough nut for the opposition to crack today.



Works Honda rides for two more of today's top names, Charlie Williams and Stan Woods, enabled the British pair to emerge as one of the best Endurance racing partnerships in Europe.

Sadly, Honda's decision to axe their Endurance team in preference to the booming Formula class has been a blow to both Stan and Charlie as well as countless fans.

But back once again on the British short circuits. Both men are proving in a big way that their road racing talents cover a wide spectrum of the sport.

Charlie Williams, one of the very best TT riders at the moment, has landed Kangol Helmets as a major sponsor for his racing season this year. Kangol and Belray Oil have put up the financial and material assistance that Charlie needed, and now with special barrels and other parts on his Yamaha from the workshops of Austrian tuner Harald Bartol, Charlie is beginning to

dominate the 250cc class.

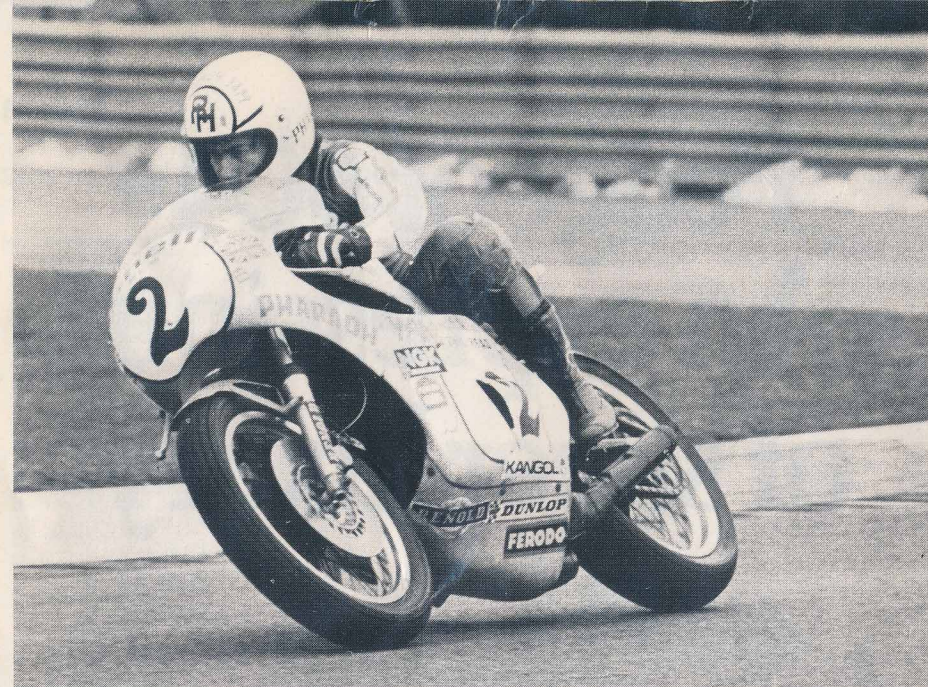
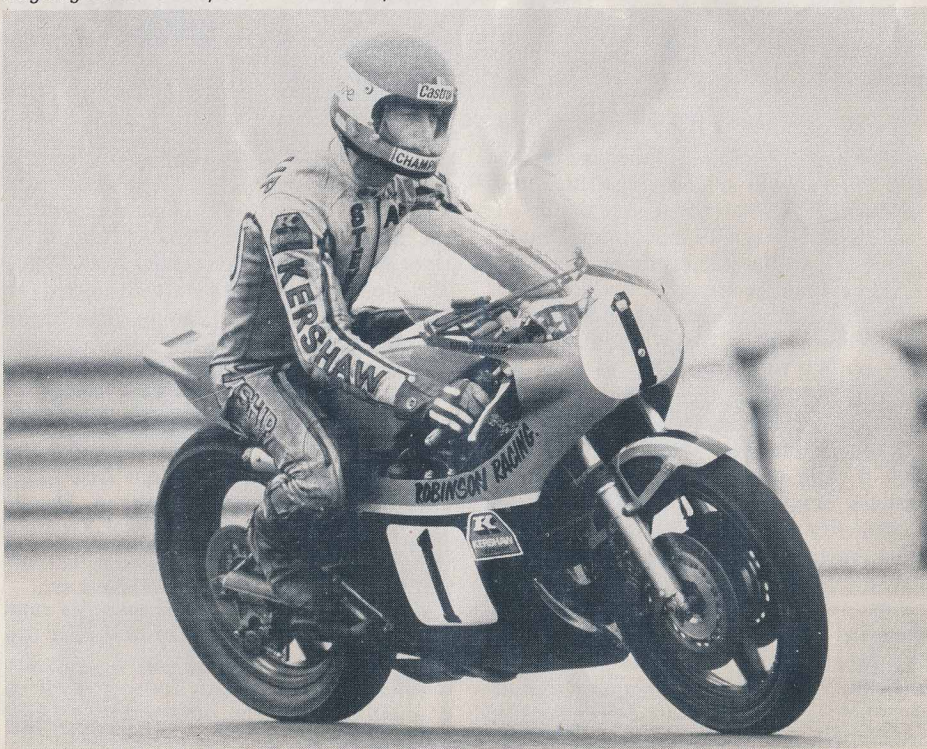
At Brands and Mallory Charlie broke the 250cc lap record, and over the three Transatlantic meetings Charlie won two out of three lightweight races, and finished a close second in the other.

Stan Woods on the 500 Suzuki and 750 Yamaha supplied by Swinton Albion Racing needs little introduction to British fans. Over the past few years family man Stan has been a leading competitor in the big classes, and is a very tough man to beat, or even pass!

At one time a member of the Suzuki GB racing team Stan Woods has had his share of ups and downs in the racing game, but this year looks like being one of his best ever.

Midland motor cycle dealer Tony Rutter suffered a cruel blow last year when his friend and sponsor Bob Priest died, soon after Tony had recovered from breaking his

leg at the Gooseneck during TT practice.

But Oxfordshire chicken farmer Harold Coppock, one of Britain's most enthusiastic, but unassuming sponsors stepped in with the offer of help, and Tony was able to race again.

The new 350 Yamahas are not handling too well at the moment though, and Tony is busy trying to sort out that problem, while showing the sort of form we expect from a former British champion on the RG500 Suzuki.

People have complained for years that a rider from the North of England has a much tougher time making the grade in road racing than his counterpart from the South. Many of the riders mentioned in this article have had to struggle for both publicity and sponsorship, but perhaps Bob Smith from St. Helens has suffered more than most.

Donington fans will remember seeing Bob snatch a dramatic win here in the British championship round last season. Bob went on to finish third in the series, but the cost of racing was then becoming a cruel and almost unbearable burden.

This year though Bob has landed a

healthy sponsorship deal from Marmac, a North West building concern, and with that aid his results have begun to improve.

Bob surprised many people, generally journalists from the South, by finishing fourth fastest in the qualifying sessions for the Transatlantic Team selection at Brands. He was just over half a second short of making the team.

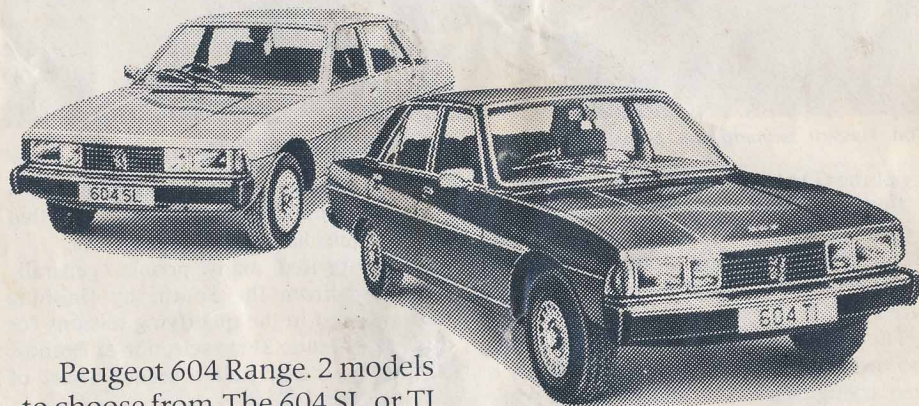
Backed by one of the few lady sponsors in the sport, Dorothy Whitehouse, Dave Hickman the Burton-on-Trent racer, is far from certain to be racing this weekend. A last bend, last lap crash at Brands Hatch in the 500cc race saw Dave taken to hospital with injuries that included three cracked ribs and a broken collarbone. Somehow, though, I am not fully convinced that a little setback like that will stop Dave!
