



Catering facilities

The Coppice Cafeteria, situated within the Museum complex adjacent to the main entrance car park, offers full catering facilities. The Paddock Cafeteria (licensed) also offers a full range of meals while the adjoining open Barbeque bar offers steaks, pizzas and a carved buffet.





The entry is divided into two sections for practice, odd and even numbers, which will be timed. The fastest 18 sidecars automatically qualify for the final unless the track conditions for the two practice sessions are very different. In the event of the latter the fastest 9 sidecars from each session automatically qualify for the final. The remaining competitors go forward into the Qualification race and the first six finishers from the Qualification race qualify for the last six positions on the grid in the final.






