## FLAG SIGNALS

**Red:** When shown at Marshal's Posts around the circuit all riders must immediately cease racing and return with extreme caution to the Start/Finish line.

**Yellow (waved):** Great danger in section of track ahead, slow down, proceed with caution.

**Yellow (motionless):** Danger in section of track ahead: take care, no overtaking, maintain positions until clear of section displaying yellow flag.

**Green:** Course clear. Used on Marshals' posts to indicate their position to riders on first lap of all practice sessions. Also shown immediately after the post where a yellow flag has been shown to indicate circuit now clear ahead.

**Black:** Accompanied by rider's number on separate board. That rider to stop in pits next time round. Always shown at start/finish line on special instructions from the Clerk of the Course.

**Yellow with Red Stripes:** Deterioration of adhesion of the track surface. Displayed when oil has been dropped on the circuit in that section & displayed until the hazard has been dealt with.

**White:** Ambulance or Course Car on circuit.  
**Yellow with Black cross:** Denotes start of last lap.

**Black/White chequered:** Denotes finish of race, usually waved at the winner and held motionless until every other rider has passed.

## THE CLUBMANS GRAND PRIX

Jim Parker and Del Jones write..

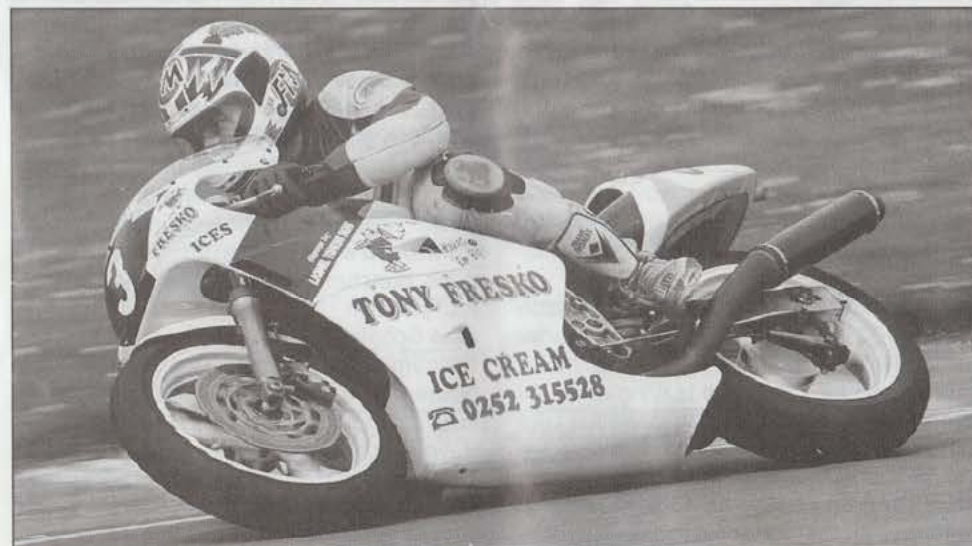
Welcome to Donington Park for the biggest and most important Club meeting of the year - the penultimate round of the Shell British Clubmans Championship. The meeting is organised by the New Era M.C.C., and the members have been eagerly looking forward to today as they only get the occasional chance to ride at this wonderful Grand Prix venue.

The British Clubmans has been well supported this year and has built up to a crescendo with the most attractive meetings being left 'till last - here at Donington and then Brands Hatch for the final on 29th October. At the last round at Pembrey South Wales earlier this month certainly had it's fair share of excitement in most classes. Disaster struck in the 125 class for Nuneatons Shaun Hawkes. He broke the scaphoid bone in his left arm on the Saturday in a New Era Club championship race and this has, unfortunately, put him right out of contention for the remaining two clubmans rounds. Said a very upset Shaun "I feel pig sick that this has happened, it's ruined my chances of a possible series win. My not riding at Pembrey wasn't through the lack of trying as I worked

all night on my wrist with ice packs and bandages in a bid to relieve the pain and swelling, but the pain was persistent, and a visit to Llanelli hospital showed the damage. Still I wish all the best for Kev, and I feel he will win the series".

Shaun has been involved in an all season needle match with series leader Hulland Wards Kevin Thraves, they have fought it out round after round for the championship, and as they went to Pembrey only six points separated them. Thraves now leads by a comfortable 16 points from now, second in the points Preston's Garry Bennett as they come to Donington.

Ashford's Brian Bartlett stamped his authority on the SS600 race at Pembrey, fulfilling a personal ambition, to beat Dewsbury's Pete

Jennings to the chequered linen. After a superb race dominated by some serious outbraking displays Brian commented "it was a great race, Pete is a very safe rider and safe to ride close to, he is also a good friend. Winning that race was just what I needed to give me a lift for the next round at Donington where just maybe I can do a repeat performance". They will no doubt clash here again today. Brian now moves up into second in the points table moving Dave Rathbone to third spot. He took a fourth at Pembrey, and will be all out to regain his second spot here today. Burnley's Mark Townsend won the 1300 open event, but crashed out of the SS400 final on lap one, trashing his chances of vital points. This was followed by an all change situation in the 400 stakes when series leader Burbage's Sean Adams' Yamaha motor blew up mid race distance leaving eventual race winner, Nottingham's Chris Walker take command of the championship. While we are on the 400 scene, watch Medstead's Elliott Burgess today, he took second at Pembrey, and is currently showing superb form. Though Chris Walker also mopped up in the

250 final, it is Jason Davis that now leads the quarter litre class as they come to Donington. He made up some ground on points to take command as arch rival Kidgrove's Derek Welch was a non starter at Pembrey, but Welch is here today to try and regain his lead in the points table, question is, can he do it? He will also have Walker to contend with on his brand new RS Honda. Sean Hegarty Jr and Stuart Coe won the open sidecar race at Pembrey with Tony Williams and George Crow second, and again bad luck struck for Roy Tansley when his chain snapped as the flag dropped ripping out a brake hose and rendering him a spectator. Tansley had bad luck in the Cadwell Park round when he was rammed by another outfit, puncturing his rear tyre when in a top four position. Alan Schofield and Andy Thornton took top honours in the Formula Two sidecar event bolstering their points situation as they close in on championship leaders Martin Clark and Boyd Hutchinson. The Shell Oils 'man of the meeting' at Pembrey was SS600 contender Brian Bartlett for his superb ride in the 600 final. He will be presented with a new Bieffe helmet here at Donington today.

This 1,000cc twin is amazingly light and very fast, and with navigation sorted it is a possible winner today. Another man to watch is Tamworth flyer Roger Banks, on the DTS Ducati 900 as a change from his SuperCup Singles challenge. And hard ridden singles can still score in this company - John Littlewood is in sixth place in the championship on a 600 Hejira-Rotax that he bought for £2,000!

**PICNIC GOSSIP** - Snetterton effectively decided the title race, with IAN COBBY on the Chris Clarke 900SS Ducati doing the business after a real old set-to with FRANCIS WILLIAMSON on Jim Lomley's two-valve Guzzi and RIK LEWENDON on the RaceCo four-valve Daytona. It was good to see Fran back up near the front, even if the Guzzi's inclination to put up a smoke screen did hamper Rik's vision in the final laps. The motor was nearly red hot when it stopped in a growing pool of lubricant at the end of the race, but it was 17 points in the Team Blomley bag and Ian cobbled to an unbeatable position. PETER BRANTON, who was Ian's only

challenger at this stage, put the Folan twin into the countryside in practice and shortened the wheelbase by about two inches; Peter is still the same length but rather bruised. He didn't make it to Oulton Park, where we had another fine race plus assorted jollities...

**OULTON PARK** - IAN COBBY opted out of this one and the Folan was too sick, so FRANCIS WILLIAMSON and RIK LEWENDON made it an all Guzzi affair. RIK was ahead every time he crossed the line, but FRANCIS gave him a hard race and only dropped back two seconds at the very end. It was a well deserved first win for the four-valve Daytona, and a clear confirmation that WILLIAMSON on the lightweight two-valver is a serious threat. Rumour had it that the Clarke Ducati was actually away having it's motortweaked for the final round at Donington; you can see why. **THE BIG(GER) BANG!** Mutterings about the legality of Jim Blomley's two-valve Guzzi has centred around the size of the engine. To settle the matter the engine was officially stripped and measured after the Oulton Park race and the team now have it in writing that the bike displaces 992.5cc. End of that particular story!
