Brief Explanation of Groups

Twinshock Two rear shock absorbers; Drum brakes; Air cooled Engines (with a few exceptions). Basically around pre 1983 when most manufacturers introduced mono shocks, disc brakes and water cooling.

The twinshocks are split into two classes

Sportsman

Beginner's and less experienced riders.

Clubman

More experienced riders

Both the Sportsman and Clubman are then divided equally by an average age making the groupings of over and under.

Pre 65 Bikes manufactured prior to 1965.

Pre 74 Bikes manufactured prior to 1974.

Both pre 65 and pre 74 are divided into two engine sizes

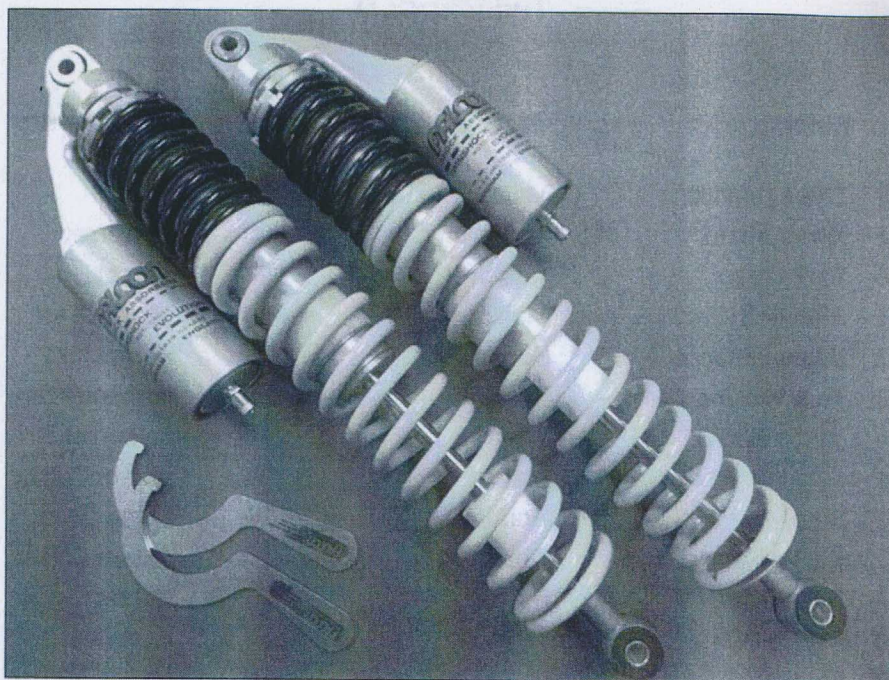

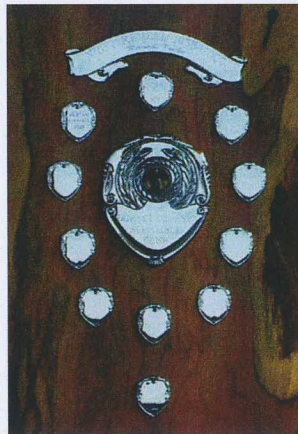
The Nigel Revell feature race will include the 1st six finishers from each race in the first block.
