

All AMCA licenced riders will gain points for their Club when they finish a race. The points will be added up after the results are known and the Club's position in the South West League revised and published. The final race of the season hosted by the Devon Classic Scramble Club, will be a **double points** meeting. The League will not have a prize attached to it, merely bragging rights! (there **may** be a sponsored prize of banners/tape/flags etc. to the winning club – tbc). The finishing positions of all riders will be scored with 36 points for 1st, 35 points for 2nd and so on. DNFs will not score. **Only AMCA licence holders' points will count.** Every race will be scored down to the last rider to finish. For twinshock races, the ability-based 'group system' used by the Dorset Classic Scramble Club will be used at the majority of scrambles.

Where classes are combined, each position will be scored with respect to the class entered. E.g. pre-'74 with 125's would be scored as two separate races. Not all clubs will run all race groups at each meeting. Riders need to ensure their club details are correct at signing on, as this will be the club who will be awarded the points should the rider complete the race. If a rider is a member of 2 or more SW clubs, only the club on their AMCA licence can be used for the purpose of the league.

Non-AMCA licenced riders and riders with licences registered with clubs outside of the South West League will be allocated points but they will not contribute to a Club's total. After five rounds:



For those new to our sport a little explanation may help you enjoy your day.

The Pre '65 group is fairly self-explanatory - Bikes manufactured prior to 1965, some modification is allowed but the bike should remain in the spirit of the period. **The pre '74 group** is much the same - Bikes manufactured prior to 1974. Both groups are sub divided into two engine sizes.

Twinshocks - these are divided into ability groups, the entry divided into two halves C & D being for the less competitive/novice rider and the top half being sub divided again by age, the oldest half in one group the youngest half in the other group. Engine size is not considered in these groups. Twinshocks should have - two rear shock absorbers, drum brakes and an air cooled engine. There are exceptions, such as the single shock Yamahas that you can see here today, but that opens up a whole can of worms.....
