For those new to our sport, a little explanation may help you enjoy your day.

The Pre '65 group: white numbers on black plates. It's fairly self-explanatory - bikes manufactured prior to 1965, some modification is allowed but the bike should remain in the spirit of the period.

The pre '74 group: Bikes manufactured prior to 1974, up to 250cc have white numbers on green plates & white numbers on red plates for over 250cc. Both pre '65's & pre '74's groups are sub divided into two engine sizes groups.

Twinshocks; Black numbers on yellow plates. These are divided into ability groups, A being the faster group through to D for the less competitive minded rider. Engine size is not considered in these groups. Twinshocks should have two rear shock absorbers, drum brakes and an air-cooled engine. There are exceptions, such as the single shock Yamahas that you can see here today, but that opens up a whole can of worms.....
