STARTING

A clutch start in conjunction with a mechanical starting gate will be employed in all races. Unfortunately the Sidcup Club's starting gate does not conform to the British Championship Rules and we are therefore very grateful for the loan of the Greenwich M.C. & M.C.C.'s gate. Members from Greenwich will be helping all day to see that it works smoothly.

RIDING IN THE PADDOCK

Machines must now be pushed in the paddock with dead engines; anyone breaking this rule will be excluded from the meeting.

All too frequently at meetings children are allowed to ride machines in the mistaken belief that because a race meeting is on private property and outside the jurisdiction of the Road Traffic Act, no insurance is necessary. It cannot be stressed to strongly that LIABILITY FOR A SUBSTANTIAL CLAIM COULD REST WITH THE OWNERS OF THE VEHICLE AND THE DRIVER (or the parent in the case of a minor).

The Union's insurers will quite legitimately repudiate any claim on them for damages arising out of the accident caused by an unauthorised driver.



BRITISH CHAMPIONSHIPS HOW TO WORK OUT THE RACES

We have attempted to lay out the programme to make it easy for you to understand. You will need to listen carefully to the Commentator for the results of the qualifying heats in the morning to make sense of the rest of the days racing in the Championship Classes.

The Top 24 placings from the first round at Hawkstone Park last week will be seeded directly into the main Championship Races. The remaining 16 places will be drawn from the heats. If we have any non starters in the Top 24, we will be allowed to take more from the results of the heats.

In both the **Open and 125 Championship Races** the rules allow us to have 40 riders on the start line at all times, so, if there is a non starter we will be allowed to fill the place with the next finisher from the heats.

The **Non Qualifiers Race** will be made up from the remainder of the heat riders plus reserves and non championship expert riders.

This year will see the introduction of a **Superclass** at the end of the day. This will consist of the **top 20 overall** points scorers on the day from the Open Class and the 125 Class. Together this will make a total of 40 on the line but we will not be allowed to top up this class with reserves.

To add a bit of spice, the riders will line up in finishing order in the box, with the 125's on one side and the Open Class riders on the other. The starter will call one from each line, starting with the first 125, the first Open rider, the second 125 and the second Open and so on.

If you miss any of the vital announcements, Race Results will be available all day from the Secretary of the Meeting's marquee and you are welcome to collect a set to take home.

However, we welcome Joakim Karlson from Sweden to CANADA HEIGHTS who will be competing against the best of Britain's Moto Cross talent - although to be honest, I will be hoping that local ace Mark Eastwood shows everyone the way home.

Pre race form currently indicates very little, the big meeting at Foxhills turned out to be a mudbath, the West of England's Patchquick Trophy had to be cancelled and Hawkstone Park have had to cut some bits of their track.


Mark Eastwood, riding here today at his local track is the eldest rider in the




