

What is the aim of the SMCA '100 Club'?

The 100 Club has been formed to offer clubs and promoters moral and financial support in the running of the British Sidecarcross Championship. It is important that National championships are retained for without them the sport of Sidecarcross will be relegated to Centre or Regional meetings and ultimately die. By providing financial back-up it is anticipated that clubs and promoters will view sidecars as a viable and attractive proposition.

How does the '100 Club' Work?

When sponsorship is mentioned many people feel that the sums involved are beyond their means. However, the '100 Club' asks for smaller sums rather than large donations. As the name suggests the amount requested is £100 to go towards the promotion and running of the British Sidecarcross Championship. The donation can be made by individuals, a small business or a group of friends. ALL money raised will be forwarded direct to the Clubs/Promoters running rounds of the Championship series.

What do you get from a donation?

Predominantly you will get more and better sidecarcross racing to watch! Donations will be recognised in the SMCA bulletin and on the Podium Display Board. Ultimately it is intended to produce one-off stickers so that your name will be displayed on a competitor's machine.

Welcome to Canada Heights and our first meeting this season on our revamped track. We hope we have made the track more sidecar friendly and spiced a few areas up to keep your interest high.

We would like to thank our main partners Maxxis Tyres and the News Shopper newspaper for their continued support. Maxxis have also come on board with extra monies together with mxbits.com to raise the profile of the Pro solo expert class and I think you will agree there will be some tight racing here today. A novel new competition with £150 is up for grabs courtesy of Boretech Engineering for the best performance in the Pro Class by a Suzuki mounted rider, and the same goes for a KTM mount courtesy of Trevor Motorcycles and finally on a Yamaha courtesy of Moto Ward all whom are local dealers.

Moving on to the three wheelers and this first round of the 2010 Maxxis British Sidecar Cross Championship, out to defend their title will be last year's winners Stuart Brown and Maxxis British Sidecar-Cross Luke Peters who will still be using Husaberg engines but this year now mounted in a 1st £60: 2nd £50: 3rd £40: 4th £30: 5th MEFO chassis supplied by the veteran £25:6th £20:7th £15:8th £12:9th £11 German driver Willi Liebl.

Hoping to dislodge the current champions are the West Country brothers Daniel & Joe Maxxis Pro Solo (each leg) Millard. They are also using Husaberg motors but they too have changed chassis 5th £40:6th £30:7th £24:8th £16:9th and will be using a WHT supplied from £11:10th £9 Holland. Last season's AMCA winning team, Steven France/Lee Machin, have swapped codes for this year and are intending to mix it Yamaha £150 : Best Overall KTM £150 with the best in the ACU. Returning after 'retirement' in 2009 is the Portsmouth driver 1st £35 : 2nd £29 : 3rd £25 : 4th £21 : 5th Scott Wilkinson now passengered by the £17:6th £15 vastly experienced David Keane. If they can Junior B (overall) stay free of injuries they are very capable of Trophies down to 6th. challenging the leaders.

Exhaust Sound Level

The Clerk of the Course may exclude any machine which exceeds the maximum permitted sound level, or which in his opinion is deemed to be excessively noisy. Sound checks will be conducted by an official throughout the meeting.

Unauthorised Riding

The riding of machines of any sort in the paddock and areas surrounding the circuit is totally forbidden. Because the event is on private property it does not place it outside the Road Traffic Act in terms of insurance. It cannot be stressed too strongly, that liability for a substantial claim could rest with the owners of the vehicle and the driver (or parents in the case of a minor) in the event of an accident.





What is the SMCA?

The SMCA of GB was formed in 1990 with a whole series of aims which are still relevant today. The priority aims are:

- 1. To promote sidecar motocross in the UK at all levels
- 2. To improve communications between riders, organisers, supporters and the press by newsletters, press releases etc.
- To increase public awareness of sidecarcross by advertising both locally and nationally.
- 4. To assist clubs, where possible, in the running of sidecar events.
- 5. To organise social events

So how are they meeting those aims?

- The SMCA promotes both the British and Clubman's Sidecarcross Championships on behalf of the ACU. That entails identifying tracks and organisers prepared to run rounds, writing the rules, recording the results and liaising with the ACU.
- The SMCA currently produces a bulletin for its members, soon to go electronic; has its own website: http://www.smcagb.com; and SMCA members provide many of the write-ups for both international and UK meetings published in T&MX and other publications.
- The SMCA 100 Club was designed to raise money to assist clubs in running championship rounds; £400 per club in 2009 and advertising material was provided. This programme cover was produced and paid for by the SMCA.
- 4. The annual awards evening is organised by the SMCA.

Any Club is only as strong as its membership; new faces bringing new ideas are always needed to meet the changing aspirations of competitors and organisers and to ensure that the Association remains relevant to those it represents. It is a fact that without the efforts of a few dedicated SMCA members the current National Championships are likely to have had far fewer rounds and a decreasing number of clubs prepared to run sidecar classes. If you are a competitor or spectator and wish to see your chosen sport thrive then you should consider joining the SMCA.
