CENTURY OILS BRITISH MOTO CROSS CHAMPIONSHIP

Foreword by Dave Smith

Welcome to Elsworth Moto-Parc for the Fourth Round of the Century Oils British Moto Cross Championship.

After last Sunday's epic in the Lancashire mud at Preston we have moved into the first man made circuit to be used for a British Championship event, with a lot of riders (in particular the top ones) not knowing exactly what to expect.

Dave Thorpe Honda managed to extend his lead in the Championship by a further 1 point last time out and this on a new second place man, last years Champion Neil Hudson (Yamaha) who leap-frogged over a semi fit Graham Noyce (Honda) to mount his challenge to retain his crown.

Dave Watson (Yamaha) and Jeremy Whatley (Suzuki) are still clinched in battle for fourth spot. The Gloucester man holding a 10 point advantage, but watch for the charge of the galloping Scot Willie Simpson (Husqvarna) and after a brilliant ride last week to finish third overall lies only 2 points behind Whatley.

Kurt Nicoll (Kawasaki), Roger Harvey (Yamaha), Jonathan Wright (Kawasaki) and Stephen Russell (Suzuki) make up the remainder of the top 10 drivers for today's event but watch out for Local boy Geoff Mayes (Kawasaki) who is just outside waiting to move in along with Steve Beamish (Honda) and Dave Tomasik (K.T.M.).

An exciting Support Championship last week saw young Honda teamster Tony Caig's lead narrowed by 1 point by Kevin Froud (Yamaha). The two former Youth Division Champions are intent on fighting this out till the death to decide the glory and honours at the end of the season that goes with winning the Support Championship, but Greg Hanson (Yamaha) is still hanging in well. Behind them moving into his highest overall support placing this week is Worcester's Rob Andrews (Yamaha) and behind him is Cagiva's youngster Mark Fulton. However, there are plenty of riders knocking on the door of opportunity in this Championship including Denis McGarrie (Maico) Mervyn Anstie (Suzuki), Paul Luscombe (Suzuki) Richard Dye (Yamaha) and Tony McNeice (Suzuki).

WELCOME TO ELSWORTH ,MOTO-PARC

Elsworth Moto Parc and the Committee and members of the Cambridge Matchless Motor Cycle Club extend a warm welcome to everyone attending today's important event "The 4th Round of the Century Oils British Moto Cross Championship."

Elsworth has hosted many moto cross or "scrambles" as they were known, in fact the first events organised here by The Matchless Club were in 1953 which makes this venue one of the longest standing in the country. During the late 1950's and early 1960's crowds of up to 10,000 spectators were commonplace, and riders such as the late Brian Stonebridge, Geoff Ward, Dave Curtis, Jeff Smith, Vic Eastwood, Dave Nicoll and Andy Lee battled for honours at events from "open to centre" to British Championship level.

In common with most sports, moto cross has suffered in recent years from smaller spectator attendances, yet who could deny that there is anything more likely to set pulses racing than the sight, sound and colour of modern day moto cross recognised as one of the most physically demanding and exciting sports in the world. The last British Championship the club organised here was in 1966 and it is difficult to make comparisons with the riders and machines of that era, and the new young professionals on their highly potent projectiles.

THE NEW "ELSWORTH MOTO PARC"

Elsworth became a permanent circuit in 1980 when Andy Lee obtained limited planning permission to use the land for training schools and competitive events. He now leases the 22 acres on which the circuit is laid out, and his small but enthusiastic group of part-time helpers work many hours to maintain the track and surrounding areas. This group includes Peter, David and Jack Desborough, Nicolas Thurley and landowner John Logan. The new "tailor made" circuit is probably the nearest thing to full-length outdoor "stadium Cross" you could imagine, and rarely fails to provide close exciting racing.
