Licence for '96 are up

Over 2,500 A.M.C.A. Competition Licences have been issued by Friday 12th April, with the Wessex Group top with over 265, followed by the Avon Group with 255 and West Pennine, who gained the Ashton Vale this year, topping 238. The largest Clubs are North Avon with 52, Macclesfield and Warsop each have 41 riders with Rossendale and Plymouth both on 40.

Rossendale Club have gained Planning Permission

The Rossendale Club have narrowly won permission for a limited number of events at the Whalley Nab circuit.

Several residents had objected to the site being used and the Club are keen that riders follow the correct directions to the circuit and practice on this circuit is strictly forbidden, otherwise the venue will be lost.
