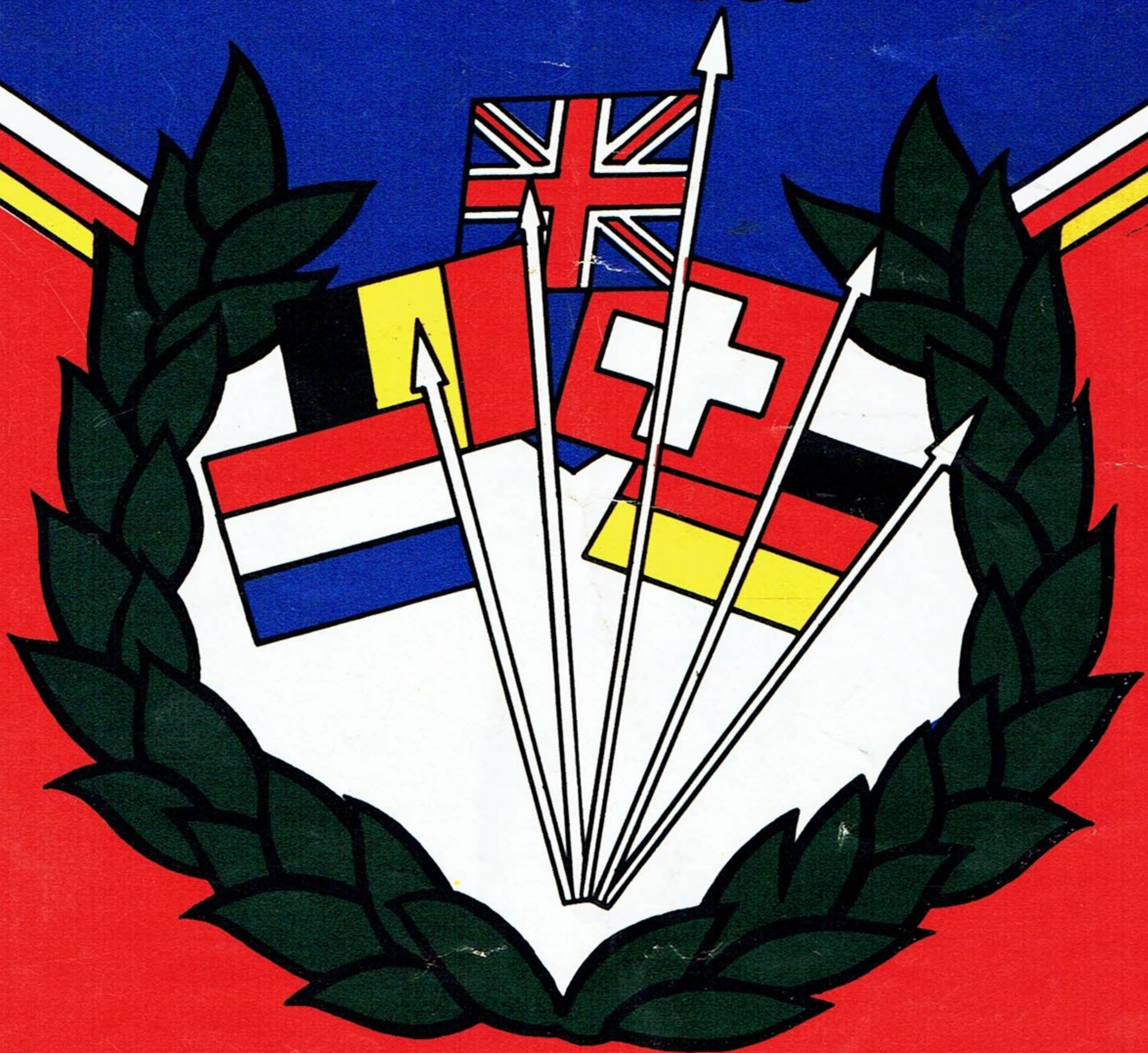

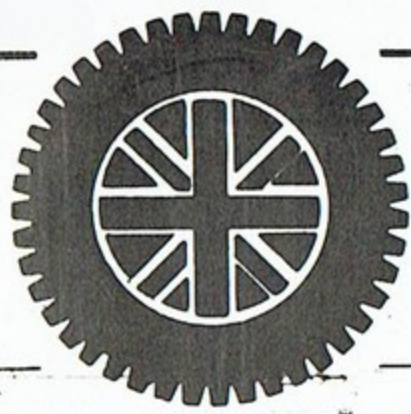

RIDERS INSURANCE

A reminder to riders that the A.M.C.A.'s Personal Accident Insurance only covers the rider against being unable to work due to injury whilst competing in A.M.C.A. authorised events.

One or two riders have claimed the weekly benefit because whilst they are unable to ride they are still working.

This does not apply to those riders who paid the £2 - 1/2 unit and who are students or those people presently out of work.

Any rider who paid the small £2 - 1/2 unit have have since started working should contact the office and pay the extra premium so he will then qualify for weekly benefit if he is injured.

Any rider who is caught making false claims will be disciplined.

INTER CLUB TEAM

The Inter Club Team will be staged on the 19th October and each group of clubs will be able to field 2 club teams of six riders plus one reserve. Riders must have held a licence for six months with their present club to be eligible.

Groups must decide on the best 2 teams who will go to the final. The venue has not been finalised yet.

Inter Group Team will be at Brownhills on 12th October and it will be six riders plus a reserve.

SIDECAR RAY EDWARDS

The sidecars will compete on October 12th at the Inter Group Solo Team event for the Ray Edwards Memorial Trophy. The sidecars missed the solo event earlier in the season due to several outfits competing abroad.
