# PREVIEW *by Paul Fowler (editor Dirt Bike Rider)*

In the period 1966-72 and since 1977 Farleigh Castle has been the venue for Britain's 500cc grand prix, these West Country hills have been the scene of more than one epic battle in the world title stakes, but never has the GP circus reached these shores with the battle for the world title poised at such a crucial stage.

Whatever happens today and whoever ends the day by standing atop the victory rostrum, you are certain of one thing. You will have been watching a new world champion in the making.

With double champion Andre Malherbe out of the reckoning, nursing the leg he broke in America last month, the crown is sure to rest on a new head when the final tally is made next month.

And with just three rounds remaining there is everything to go for here. In fact Farleigh Castle is likely to prove the most crucial GP of the year for those involved in the title chase.

Farleigh favourite Brad Lackey dearly wants to repeat his 1977 & 1978 victories here as a prelude to taking the world crown. He's twice been runner up in the world and many see this as his last chance for the ultimate prize in world motocross. The bearded Suzuki supremo has forged his way to the top of the table thanks to a superbly consistent showing in a year which has seen 5 different winners in eight GPs.

Recalling the great Suzuki days of Robert Geboers, DeCoster and Wolsink, it's the Suzuki of Belgian Andre Vromans that's out there neck and neck with his team-mate in the tussle for the title.

This year the 25 year old Flemish speaker has proved he's able to ride the harder tracts as well as the sand courses of the Benelux countries and he could be the first Suzuki driver to take the title since 5 times winner DeCoster.

With Malherbe out of it, it's our own world 250 champion Neil Hudson who heads the strongest British challenge since the days of the mid 50s. And surprisingly it's the Honda mounted West Country wonder's first visit to the West Wilts Club's GP venue — he's previously been involved in 250 grand prix elsewhere.

1979 world champion Graham Noyce is the second of our extra-strong British challenge though the five times National champion may still have problems from the knee injury sustained in a fall from his Honda in the States.

And last but by no means least of our top ten trio is Kawasaki's talented teenager Dave Thorpe who, in his first full year of GP competition, has become probably the most talked about man on the circuits of the world. But in addition to our trio at the top there are four more men from the British Isles who'll be striving to enhance their GP standing.

A GP regular for many years, 1980 British champion Geoff Mayes has missed out on the last rounds but he's back for Farleigh and hoping to contest all the remaining GPs. KTM's Rob Hooper has been a regular on the 250cc grand prix scene but has this year switched his attention to the 500s and makes his debut today.

And finally it's a duo from across the water who complete the British line-up. Lawrence Spence is due back after an enforced lay off due to a shoulder injury and the stocky Ulsterman will be out to break his world title duck along with fellow Ulsterman Geoff Leaney in his first GP.

But for a final word we turn to Dave Thorpe: "It would be nice if we could see a British one-two-three here at Farleigh!" We'll all drink to that!!!

## Grand Prix 'Qualifying'

The 1982 season sees the introduction of a 'qualifying' method of Grand Prix entry and to assist readers, a brief outline of the method is given.

Automatic entry is given to the First 10 of the previous years World Championship.

Grand Prix race start line is for 40 drivers and therefore the remaining 30 places are 'qualified' for.

The Organisers have to accept all entry applications from drivers on the Graded International (500cc) list of their National Federation. If the entry exceeds 30 after listing the automatic entry drivers, then a ballot is made to divide the remaining entries into two timed training sessions. The fastest 15 of each timed training session will then be entered in the two G.P. races. All this will take place on the Saturday.

The timed training session for the 40 G.P. drivers on the Sunday morning will decide the order of going out to the start line for the G.P. races.

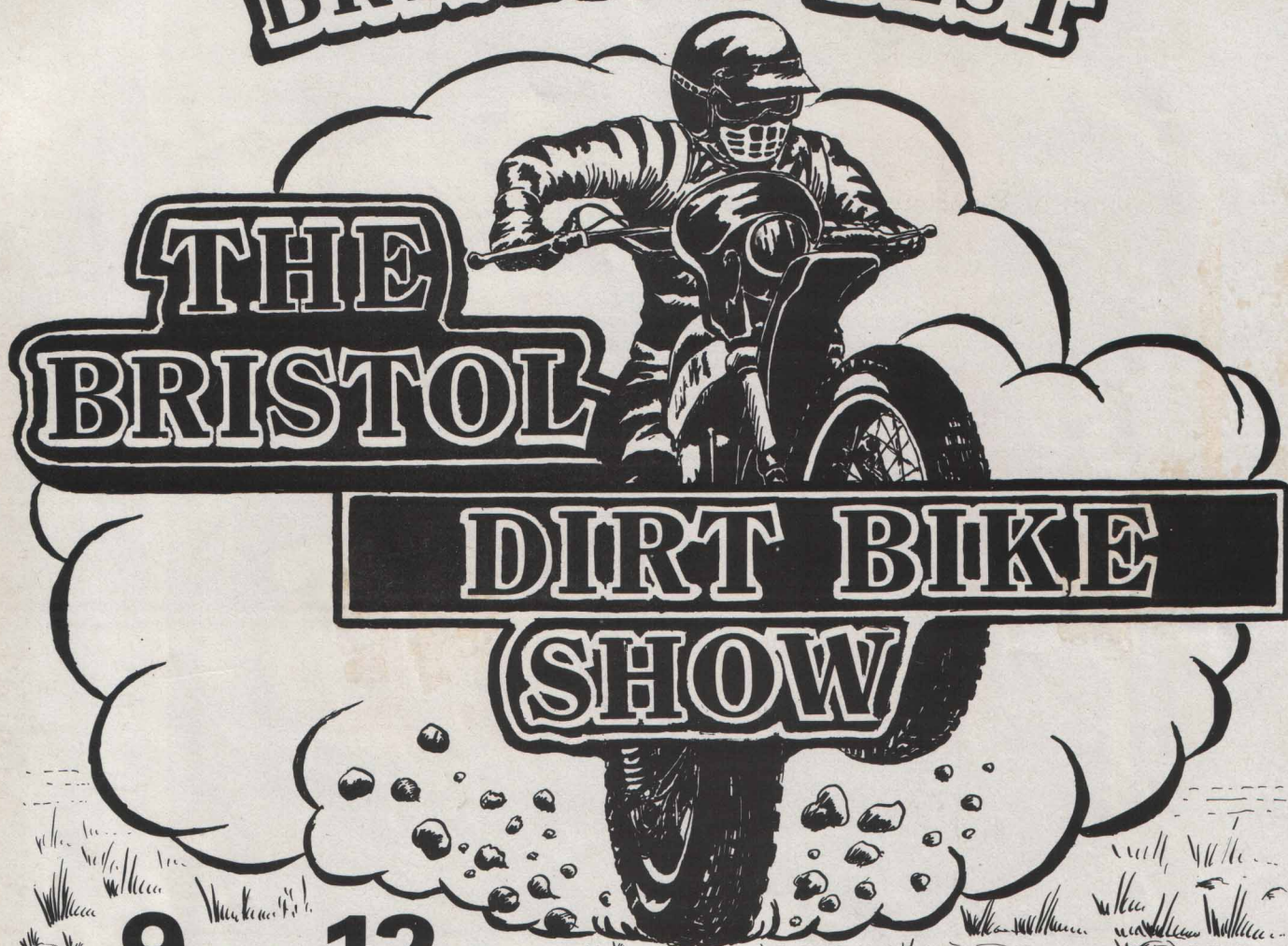
