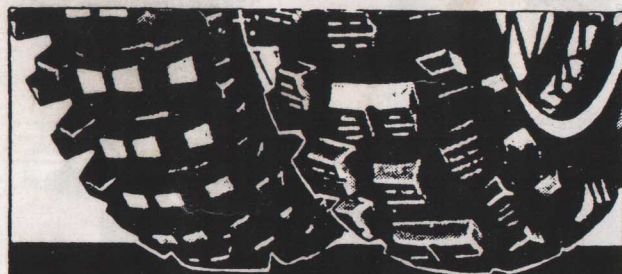

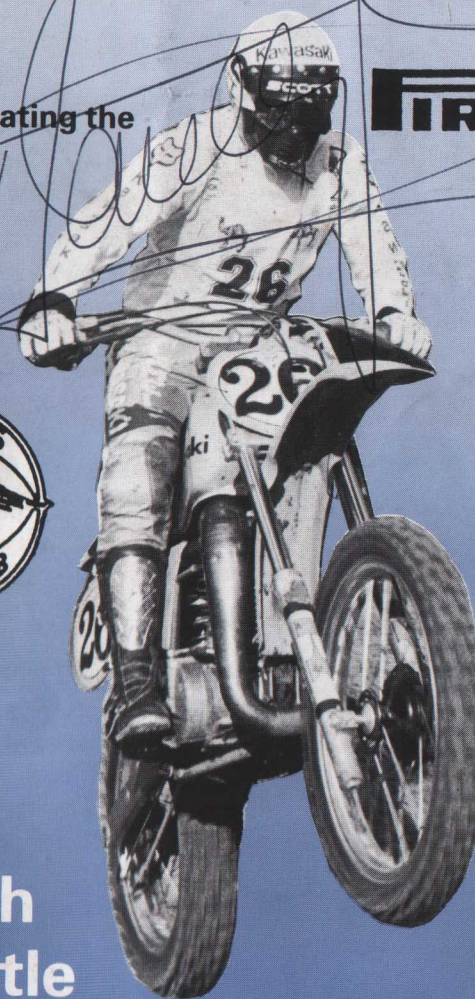

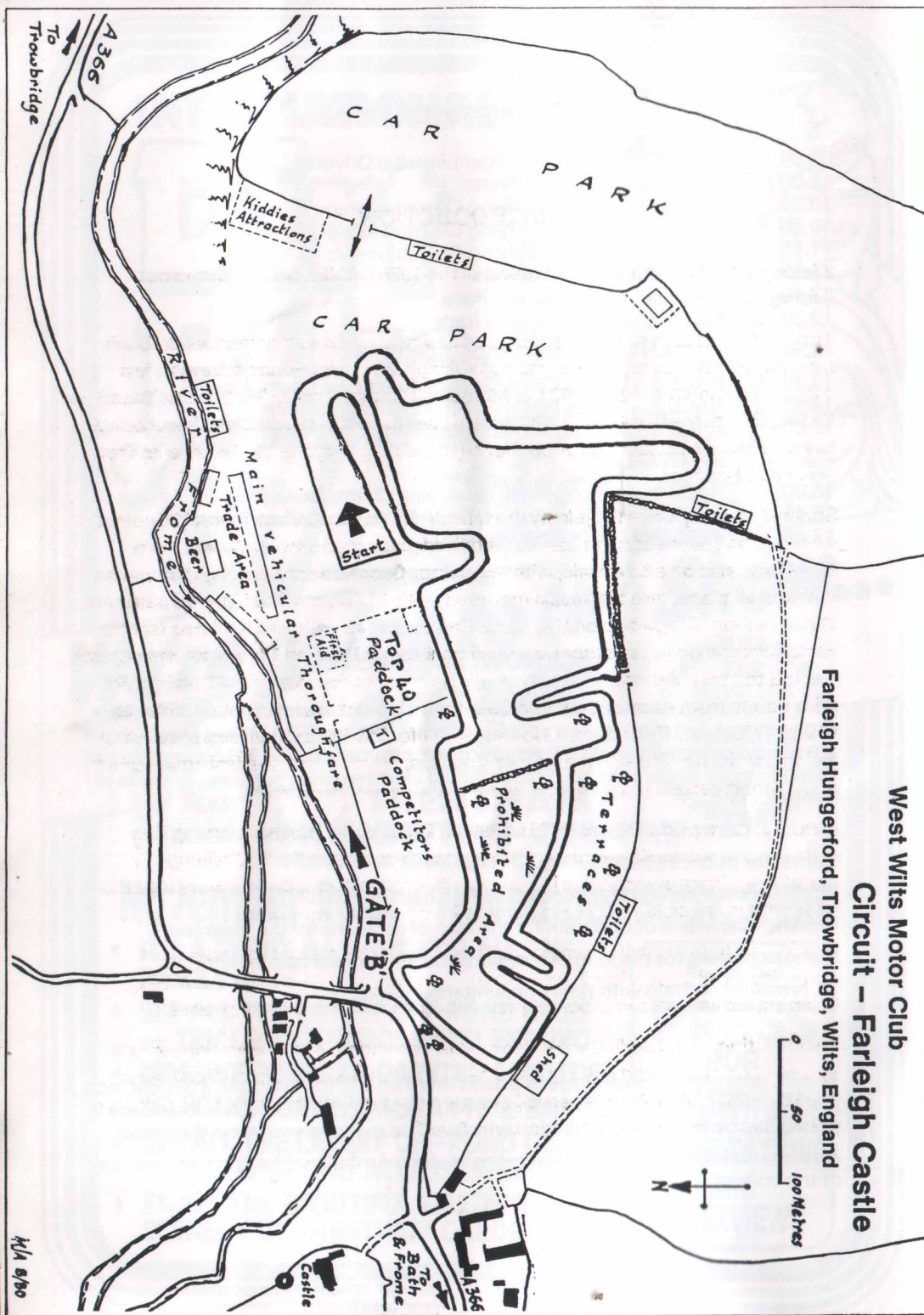
ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the sixth and final round of the 1986 CAMEL British Motocross Championship.

The 1986 title has already been decided and goes to Dave Thorpe for the fourth successive year, as befits this young Wokingham works Honda rider who last month retained the World 500 c.c. Motocross Championship. He became World Champion for the first time in 1985 but this will in no way prevent him from racing to win. Also it has been reported that he could be giving the 1987 Honda its first try-out at Farleigh.

Second place is currently held by Kurt Nicoll on a works Kawasaki with 185 points who has had some stirring battles with third place man Mervyn Anstie from Newbury, also on a Kawasaki, with 167 points. Greg Hanson from High Wycombe is in fourth place, also Kawasaki mounted, with 137 points. Then comes Jeremy Whatley from Ringwood on the works Cagiva on 119 with Rob Andrews from Earls Croome on yet another Kawasaki right behind him on 116 points whilst just behind the two of them is Andy Nicholls on a works Yamaha with 93 points. So with points from each of the three Championship races ranging from 20 for 1st place, 17 for 2nd, 15 for third, 13 for fourth, 11 for fifth, 10 for sixth and on down to a single point for fifteenth the final positions, apart from first, are far from decided and there is certain to be some very hard and determined racing.

A rider whose performance will be watched with great interest is young Rob Herring on a works Kawasaki who has come through the Pirelli Challenge Qualifying Championships to join the full Championship at the halfway stage this year who is an exciting and very talented prospect for the future.

In addition to the top 40 riders in the three British Championship races a full compliment of hopefuls will be competing in the Pirelli Challenge Qualifying Championship Heats in order to qualify for the two Championship races.

This meeting at Farleigh Castle also means something of a celebration for Ken Lywood, a popular and greatly respected West Wilts Motor Club official, for it marks the 50th time he has carried out the immensely responsible duties of Clerk of the Course during his long service in the Club.

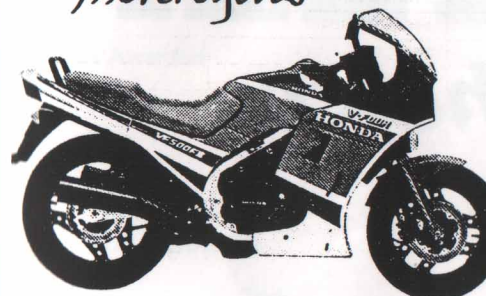
