

This is the first time that the "Classic Dirt Bike" British Classic Scrambles Championship has visited Farleigh Castle. Like Hawkstone Park, Farleigh Castle is one of the iconic circuits in British motocross history.

The 2011 championship series includes a Pre-65 championship and a Pre-72 championship. Today however Farleigh Castle will only be hosting a round (the 3<sup>rd</sup>) of the Pre-72 championship, a total of 4 races spread over the 2 days.

Championship points are awarded as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> Place = 20 Points

2<sup>nd</sup> Place = 17 Points 3<sup>rd</sup> Place = 15 Points

4<sup>th</sup> Place = 13 Points

5<sup>th</sup> Place = 11 Points

6<sup>th</sup> Place = 10 Points

Down to 15<sup>th</sup> place and 1 point

All the leading contenders are here including the current British Pre-72 and European + 35 champion Scott Hayworth. Scott is likely to be pushed all the way by Wayne Partington, James Holt, Tim Dallaway, Rich Warner and the rest. All will be keen to mark this first visit to Farleigh Castle with some outstanding racing. Each race will be 15 minutes plus 1 lap.

## **CCM - CELEBRATING 40 YEARS**



CCMs first championship came via Jack Matthews in 1973 in the British Sidecar Trials Championship. Matthews won the championship aboard his 498cc CCM.

John Banks joined CCM in 1974, and by the June of that year he had secured CCMs first British Championship victory.



## **CCM - CELEBRATING 40 YEARS**



1977 - Farleigh Castle - GP

CCM had two riders at the British GP at Farleigh Castle in 1977; John Banks and Bob Wright. In race one the CCM riders did very well battling for most of the race for 1st and 2nd position. By the end of the race however Banks had pulled out of the race and Wright had fallen back to 6th position. In the second race Wright had a crash on the start and did not complete the race. Banks meanwhile had a great racing leading the field for much of the race before Heikki Mikkola finally took the race win. The rules of GP racing were that ALL machines in the top five positions must be checked after both races. The machine of Bank's was checked and found to have a stroke of 410cc, well within the 500cc maximum capacity. As Wright had not finished in the top 5 in either race, his bike would not have to be checked, however a protest was put in that his bike should be checked as rider Andy Roberton, who had finished 5th in the first race was not eligible for championship points and therefore Wright would be the 5th championship points scorer. Alan Clews however refused to have the bike measured and Wright's CCM was quickly loaded into the race van – I suppose we will just have to guess what CC Bob Wright's bike was that day!!!!

## **CCM - CELEBRATING 40 YEARS**



Towards the back end of 1980, Armstrong Equipment Ltd had taken over CCM. It was in 1981 that Austin Clews rode the CCM Armstrong to victory in the AMCA British 4-Stroke Motocross Championship.




In 1987 Alan Clews bought back CCM from Armstrong. The first bike to be produced under the newly re-purchased CCM was a 600 Sonic in November 1987.

A sad time for CCM came in 1991, when thieves broke into the Vale Street factory and set fire to a bike that spread a devastating fire throughout the whole factory. What was left from the factory was brought back to the Clews' family home to continue the business.

## **CCM - CELEBRATING 40 YEARS**



In 1995 Austin Clews designed the C25 CCM. The name came about as the bike was built during CCM's 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary year. Only three C25 CCMs where produced in 1995, and racer Donny Schmidt took the helm of one of these machines to win the American Sound of Thunder and the World Four-stoke championship.



In 1998 after several years of financial troubles, CCM was put into receivership and immediately taken over by two new investors; Richard Robson and Peter Swift. Over the next few years bikes for track and road racing were produced.

On 8<sup>th</sup> July 2004 the liquidators were called into CCM, but was this to be the end of CCM? The answer was no – on 12<sup>th</sup> September 2004, CCM was signed back into the Clews family. The first bike of this new era was the FT35 and it was launched at the NEC Motorcycle show in late 2005. In November 2007 CCM unveiled its return to motocross with the CMX450. In 2008 Greg Hanson was signed up to ride the CMX in the World Veterans cup and in April 2008 he had won the first Veterans Cup race at the GP in Bellpuig.
