

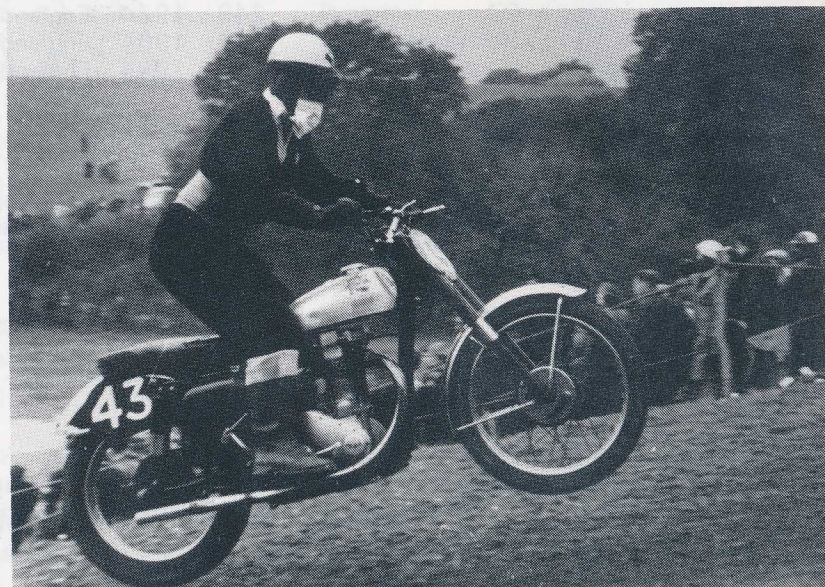

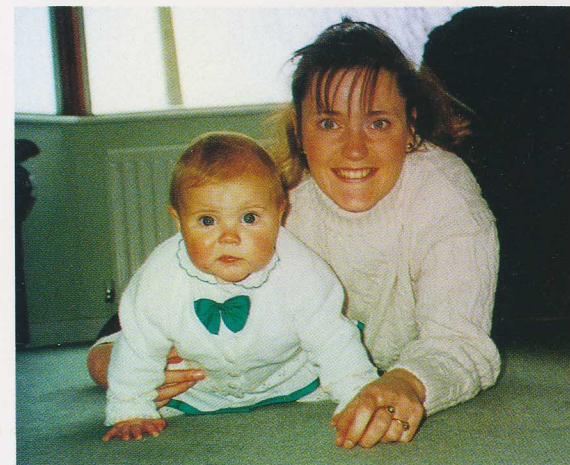

CATH COLEY: A TRIBUTE

On this occasion I can do no more than touch on the many sterling qualities of this lovely and lively lady.

To the Coley family and to Southern Classic she was a tower of strength. Whether as a rider of a quick 2-stroke, or as Secretary of this meeting she possessed great energy and determination. She was purposeful and well organised in everything she did, qualities that have become increasingly evident since her untimely death 3 months ago. Above all, as a wife and mother she was unique.

In the male dominated, and often chauvinistic world of Pre-65, she successfully combined feminine intuition and perception with a positive attitude and a degree of firmness which made her a valuable ally and friend.
