

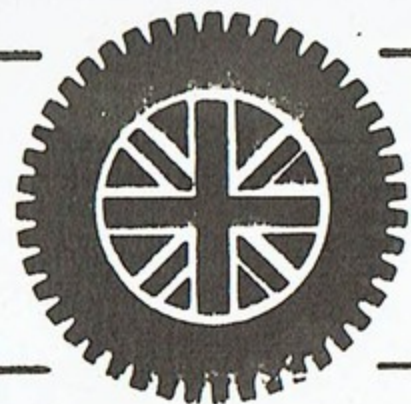

ISLE OF MAN 86'

PART 1.

The Annual trip to the Island got underway on Friday 29th August with the first parties catching the 5 o'clock ferry from Heysham arriving in Douglas around 10 o'clock.

Saturday sees the start of the Manx Two Day Trial from the grandstand, with the first sections for solos, the famous Gas works steps (some 150 steps), a good crowd watching on a nice spring morning, is this the start of a good week? I hope so. Watch more sections during the day, calling in at Knock Froy Scramble Course in the afternoon to plan the course for the Scrambles, the Clubroom is open so its a good time to quench ones thirst with a nice pint of lager, just in time to see the trials boys arriving for their sections here.

Saturday evening sees the arrival of more A.M.C.A. Members including Lionel Beck and Ann Morgan, but not before we have seen the Manx Clasic Road Race.

Sunday morning its off to Knock Froy again, put up direction signs on way, see Paul Mottram and his back up party at Quarter Bridge on his sponsored unicycle ride around the T.T. Circuit. Then its on to

the course, where most of the lads are already there, I have decided to use the full course so that means going through the stream, most of the rope is up, but some alterations are necessary, a few groans from the sidcar boys.

The work was completed in around the hour, good show lads.

Monday the first day of the Scrambles, overnight rain has made the track a bit slippy to start with, but after practice its ideal. Good racing during the day with Junior Phil Hall of the Upton Club getting a maximum 45 points and Tony Barley on 34 followed by Bill Herring on 32.

The Sidcars with 5 outfits making the trip saw Bernard Gleeve win with a maximum 45 points - passengered by Graham

Stevens., 2nd was David Nield and Paul Halliday on 30 points. Outfit No. 96 Martin Daley and Paul Mottram started the day off well, but Paul after his epic ride around the TT Circuit on Sunday 12 hours in all, was feeling rather sore and blistered and required the attentions of Ann Morgan.

Tuesday was the day of the newcomers and Junior Manx G.P. so its off to Greeba Bridge to join Ann and Lionel who are on First Aid Duty.

Wednesday its back to Knock Froy again, heavy overnight rain has made the stream too deep for comfort so we have to revert to the shorter course, quite a bit of alteration to do, but once again its done in record time, track is ideal again, with another good days racing.

Phil Hall Junior gets another maximum 45 points but second this time is Bill Herring on 34 points and 3rd is Anthony Hurst on 32 points.

The Seniors sees Darren Herring in No. 1 spat again on 39 points, second today is Roger Heginbotham on 31 points and 3rd Phillip Naylor on 26 points.

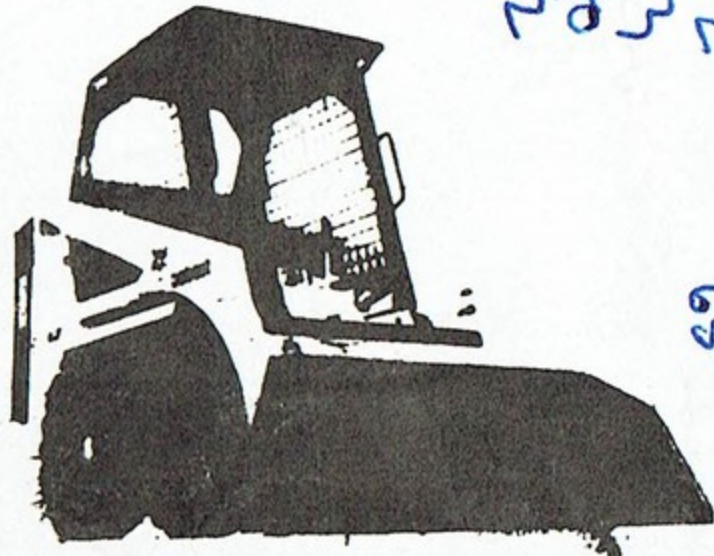

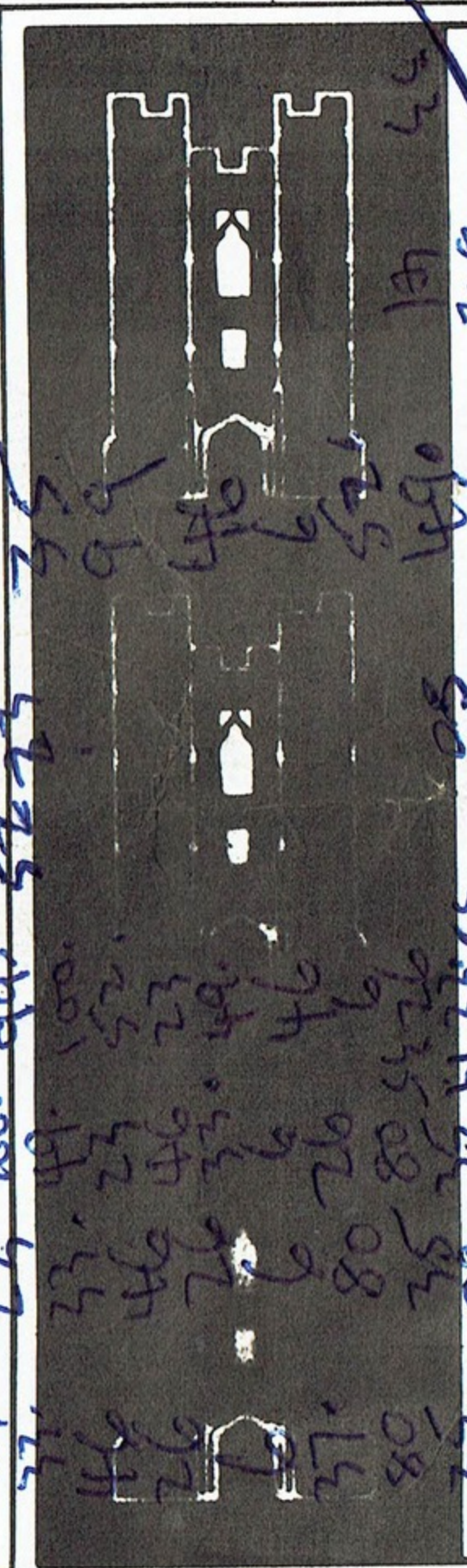

A.M.C.A. TRIALS ENTRY
FEES SLASHED

At a meeting of A.M.C.A. clubs who run trials mainly in the Midlands last Thursday, it was agreed that the entry fee for A.M.C.A. trials this winter will be just £2 plus and extra £1 if they enter on the day. Guest riders will be able to ride in any three A.M.C.A. trials (without an A.M.C.A. licence) for £4 (which includes Insurance) or £5 on the day.

A mixture of 22 trials, some open and at least a dozen closed circuit type, will be run starting on 12th October with the popular Welshpool Trial organised by the A.M.C.A. oldest club the Moseley who were running amateur trials in 1929. At least 8 different groups of sections will be used on the 40 mile course including a lot of off road going.

Any rider interested in taking an A.M.C.A. Licence which costs £5 for trials can join any one club in the A.M.C.A. to ride in all the events and there are now 3 Trials Only Clubs who between them (Black Country, Ibex and Studley) will be running 10 of the events.

CHAMPIONSHIP 1986-87

This will be run over 14 events and all the 14 events will count, including a riders own clubs trial.

OVER 40's

A special over 40's award will be given in both the Intermediates and the Non-Experts classes over the season.

DUAL SECTIONS

Most events will include dual type sections with the Experts and Intermediates riding the difficult sections and the Non-Experts the easier way.

TRIALS FIXTURES 1986 - 87

(Open - Use of Roads) (C.C. - Closed Circuit) (C - Championship Rounds).
