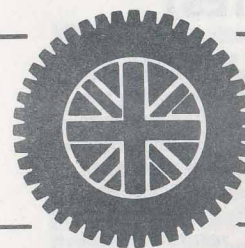

SIDECAR INTERNATIONAL

Due to the injury he received at the Long Buckby 125 International Steve Hague the AMCA Sidecar Champion may be missing from the team to compete in the Belgium Round of the IMBA Sidecar Championship on July 8th.

The Team will be Norman Brown and Ian Coulter from the East Cheshire Club, Nigel Pinckbeck and Martin Guildford from Andover, Cliff Barton and Lee Watkinson from Leigh with John Davies and Paul Robinson ready to replace Hague and Chris Herbert should they cry off.

RIDERS ABROAD WARNING

Several cases have come to light of thefts from riders when abroad. Usually at events when the lads are riding and the vans are left unattended.

Riders and Spectators should take out insurance to cover this possibility and anyone going abroad should obtain the form E111 from Social Security Offices and complete the form before going abroad to cover against hospital expenses whilst in the Common Market Countries.

SPECIAL EVENTS OFF

The two mid-week scrambles planned by the East group in the first week of July (4th and 6th) have been cancelled due to lack of support. Very few riders had expressed an interest in the events.

CO-OPERATION BETWEEN CLUBS.

Pleasing to report the North Avon Club have offered the use of their Cribbs Causeway Circuit near Bristol to the Hillingdon Club for an event on the 29th July.

The North Avon Club are also loaning their stakes and Hillingdon have a transporter for the rest of the kit.

This excellent circuit will give the South East group of clubs a ride and for most of them its just along the M4 unless you live in Eastbourne or Crowborough.

Hillingdon are having problems finding a settled circuit at the moment and they had to cancel on June 24th.

LAP SCORERS CONCERNED.

Several riders are using the American style type of Racing numbers on their machines and some lap scorers are finding them difficult to read. The rules regarding Number plates are on Page 4 of the Rule Book.

WEST REGION FREEDOM OF CHOICE.

On the 1st July events in the 4 West Groups the riders have been fitted in at their 1st choice event except the Brierley Hill Club who have been asked to go to the Kinver event (South West Midlands). Part of the problem has been that 342 riders asked to go to the Telford event, 35 of these riders were from the Blackheath and Teme Valley Clubs who have run events themselves on the days of freedom of choice earlier in the season. Brierley Hill will have priority for the 8th July events which is the next freedom of choice date.

YORK - 15th JULY

The York Club who are running an event on the 15th July state camping will be available at a camp site in Rosedale Village which has all the necessary camping facilities available. York club members will be on hand on the Saturday.

SOLO PROTEST

Brian Tomkin of the Banbury Club has also had his appeal turned down regarding the 3rd - 250 Championship race at the Northants International at Long Buckby. He protested about the result but the Committee after hearing from the Club officials and checking the lap scoring sheets including independent ones decided the original results should stand.

SIDECAR PROTEST

The Racing Committee have discussed appeals by Nigel Pinckbeck and Paul Scholfield over the results of the first sidcar championship race held at Long Buckby on the 27th May and the decision was to turn down the appeal.

Only two Sidcars were allowed to gain points as the riders could not climb the hill before the finish and most riders used the ground between the track side rope and the Spectator rope.

DATE CHANGE THE ENDURO CLUB 3 DAY EVENT

The 3 day Welsh Clubmans event will take place at Lawnt Farm, Moelfre, Nr. Llanilin, (Oswestry), Wales on the days Friday 10th, Saturday 11th and Sunday 12th of AUGUST. The purpose of the whole event is to bring together as many varied types of rider and machine to participate in their own events and an all-comers enduro on the Sunday. It also serves as a special social occasion.

Proposed are: A Time Trial and Special Trial: ATT Scramble. Solo Scramble: Hill Climb: Circuit Lap Speed Test: Enduro.

Camping facilities will be available from the Thursday night 5.00 p.m. until Monday mid-day. Entrants requiring space should book in advance.

Entry fees for A.M.C.A. and Enduro Club members £9.00. All others (which includes Insurance) £15.00. Applications to A.M.C.A. Darlaston Road, Walsall WS2 9XL. '3 Day Welsh'.

A minimum entry of 75 is required and a maximum of 120 solos will be accepted: 25 Trials Solo/Chairs: 20 ATT's: 10 Sidcars.

Sidcars will have a series of races on the Friday evening. On Saturday an enduro of 2 hours is offered on a long MX circuit. On Sunday there is the speed lap and the main full circuit enduro.

THE ENDURO: An anticipated 7 mile circuit will provide entrants with a challenge of achieving set number of laps in the best time. The overall period is 4 hours. Classes will be Expert and Clubmen, with the usual type classes. MX-Enduro-Trail-Trial-ATT's and Sidcar (Triscar).

It is essential to have helpers and scorers throughout the 3 days. It is hoped that MX followers will provide the basis for the MX events and a Trials club will officiate on the trials events.

Mobile marshals will also be needed. Catering will be available throughout. Toilets will be available.

ENTRANTS must be sure their bikes are well silenced and carry spare muffling. Such an event requires the co-operation of everyone and it is essential to respect the owner's farm and land.

There is every reason to believe this event will be great fun and worthwhile.

If your vehicle is stolen you may be reimbursed for its loss, but you will get no compensation for the months of inconvenience suffered whilst awaiting the results of your claim. If you have left your vehicle insecure, spare a few minutes to immobilise it. It could save you hours in the weeks to come.

DOGS.

Under no circumstances are dogs allowed within the precincts of the Course. This ruling will be strictly enforced.

CROSSING THE COURSE.

Under no circumstances should you cross the Course whilst racing is in progress—at such points where it is permissible to cross the Course, a marshal will indicate when it is safe to do so.

STARTING.

A clutch start in conjunction with a mechanical starting gate will be employed in all races.

FLAG SIGNALS.

Chequered Flag	...	Finish.
Black Flag	...	Driver riding machine bearing that number to stop.
Red Flag	...	Danger. All machines stop.
Yellow Flag	...	Caution.

NOTICE TO RIDERS

Your attention is drawn to the serious consequences which could arise following an accident caused by unauthorised riding in the paddock. Any rider found riding in the pits or any other area than the track will be asked to leave the meeting.
