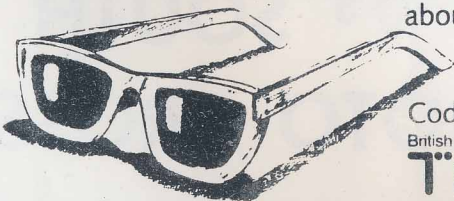

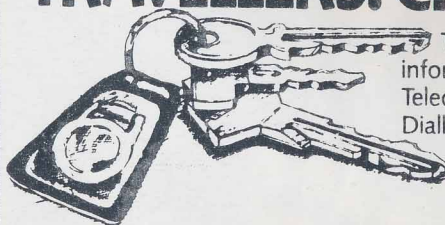

Foreword by Ralph Venables

Revival of the historic North v South Scramble after a lapse of nearly 20 years is not only a landmark in motorcycle sport, it is something which will delight thousands of enthusiasts who used to watch these annual battles and who so deeply regretted the decision to let the series lapse.

Inaugurated exactly 40 years ago by the late Graham Walker, at the suggestion of the late Charlie Markham, the contest between two teams (usually 12 riders each) was for the handsome "Motor Cycling" Challenge Trophy, and, in the early days, there was immense rivalry between the opposing forces.

Organisation for the south was by the Streatham & D MCC, and, for the north, by the Thirsk & D MC. In all, the North v South took place on 43 occasions, there being two events per year until the 1968 meeting at Boltby on August 4, 1968.

It was at this same venue that Jerry Scott had so tragically met with a fatal accident in which Jeff Smith was involved. Needless to say, Jerry's death cast a gloom over the North v South series and perhaps played some part in the discontinuation of what had hitherto been such very popular events.

The southern teams tended to dominate the contest, winning well over 50%. Yet there were times when the northerners never looked like being beaten, and for the welcome revival this month we could well witness a very evenly-matched struggle at both rounds (Foxhill on May 5, Boltby on May 11).

Team spirit in motorcycle sport has diminished in recent years, and the North v South Scramble might do a power of good in that respect. Congratulations to the Thamesdown and Thirsk clubs for their bold decision. May the best team win

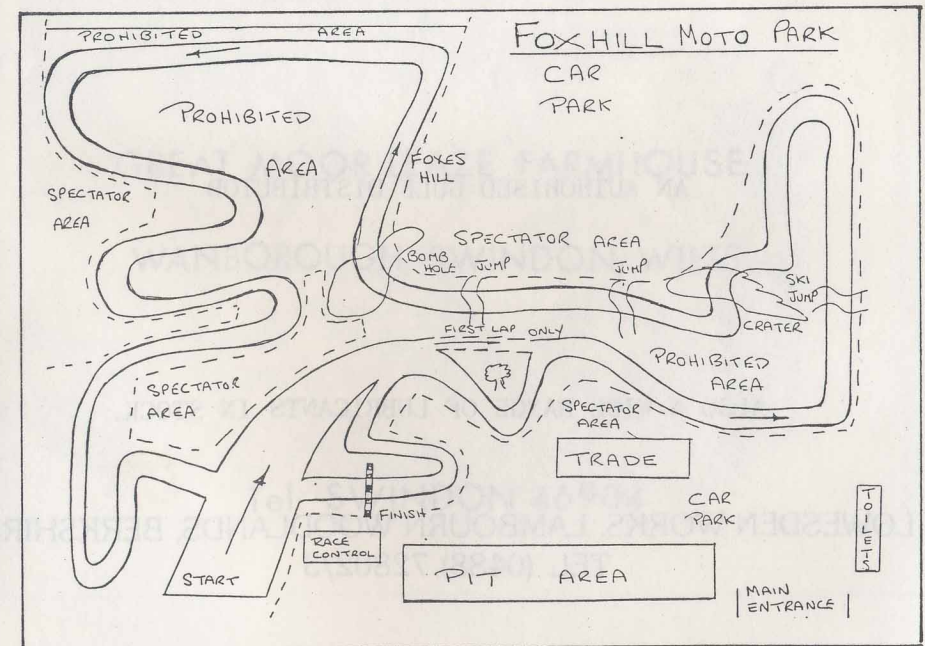
