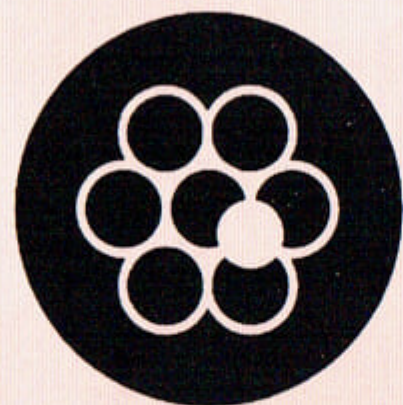

NEWBURY OF BATTLE

BACK FOR ANOTHER NEWBURY BATTLE

Just over 13 years ago I wrote a piece entitled "The end of an Era" which was published in the Race Programme for what we thought was the last ever motocross to be staged here at the historic "Fox and Hounds" circuit, and now we're back again - hopefully to begin another era - thanks to the tireless efforts of Roger Haskell and others of the Thames Valley Classic Club who are staging this, the latest of a long series of "Battle of Newbury " meetings.

The first ever Battle of Newbury was fought just down the road at Skinner's Green. It was in 1643, during the Civil War between the Royalists and the Roundheads. I think Cromwell's Roundheads got the verdict in that one. Then, in another Battle of Newbury which took place on March 28th 1965, the winner was a stocky bloke, wearing a helmet painted black and white, and riding a steed with number "6" emblazoned on its flanks. His name? Joe Johnson and he won on a track set out just over there near the Fox and Hounds Pub after a battle royal, not with the Royalists, but with local kingpin, Rob Jordan and Hampshire's Roger Snoad.

And now this 1998 Classic Battle of Newbury is against cancer, that awful disease which has probably claimed lives of friends or relatives of every one of us here today. One who succumbed to cancer was Captain J.S. Fairhurst, the former owner of this circuit, therefore the main solo final will be dedicated to his memory. The main sidecar final will be for the Dave Joyce Memorial Cup.

I knew Dave Joyce, he managed a motor cycle shop in Newbury and was a leading light in the Newbury and District Club, who staged topflight meetings here, including one 250cc solo Grand Prix, two sidecar Grand Prix, many British Championship rounds and many Battles of Newbury. Dave was a highly efficient, yet unflappable organiser and a really nice bloke. His widow Sally, who also played a major role in the staging of motocross here in the past is going to present Dave's trophy this afternoon.

So enjoy the day folks - the sight and sounds of Classic solos and sidecars in nostalgic combat - all for Cancer Research and all will be described by that incomparable race commentator, John V Mould. He's an ace on the mike and he was good on a bike in his 1950's heyday.
