



#### THE WESSEX SCRAMBLE

THE WESSEX SCRAMBLE was first held in 1929 and every year thereafter until 1938. After the war, the series was re-started in 1947 at Farleigh Castle, near Trowbridge, held in January under Arctic weather conditions, with half-frozen mud it was a truly frightful affair.

The event was not run in 1948 due to petrol rationing and in 1949 the

Wessex Centre decided to entrust the organisation of the Scramble to the TOR

CLUB and the first of a run of very successful meetings was held at Glastonbury.

Other Clubs who have run the Wessex include the SHEPTON MALLET CLUB, the BATH

CLUB, the BRISTOL CLUB, the FROME CLUB. The WEST WILTS CLUB was to have run in


1966 but bad weather stopped them.

Only one man has gone through to the card unbeaten; this was in 1965 when the Frome Club run the Wessex at Longleat Park, the rider being Don Rickman, riding 250 c.c. and 500 c.c. Metisses.

On March 31st 1968, Don finished 5th overall in the Spanish Grand Prix, riding a 250 Bultaco, the same machine as he is riding to-day. Don will be hard pushed to-day by such riders as Jimmy Aird, the 1967 Scottish Champion 250 c.c. Class. Vic Allan, the 1965 and 1966 250 c.c. and 500 c.c. Scottish Champion who now lives in England and rides Works Greeve machines which are kept for the British championship meeting and T.U. meeting, rides in the Greeves team with Bryan Wade and Arthur Browning.

The A.J.S. works machines are ridden by Malcolm Davis, Chris Horsfield and Dick Clayton. All these and many more will be after Championship points to-day.

In the 500 c.c. WESSEX SENIOR SCRAMBLE the 1967 South Western Champion, Terry Cox and 1967 Wessex Centre Champion, Rob Taylor, will be up against all the Works' boys and many other top experts.
