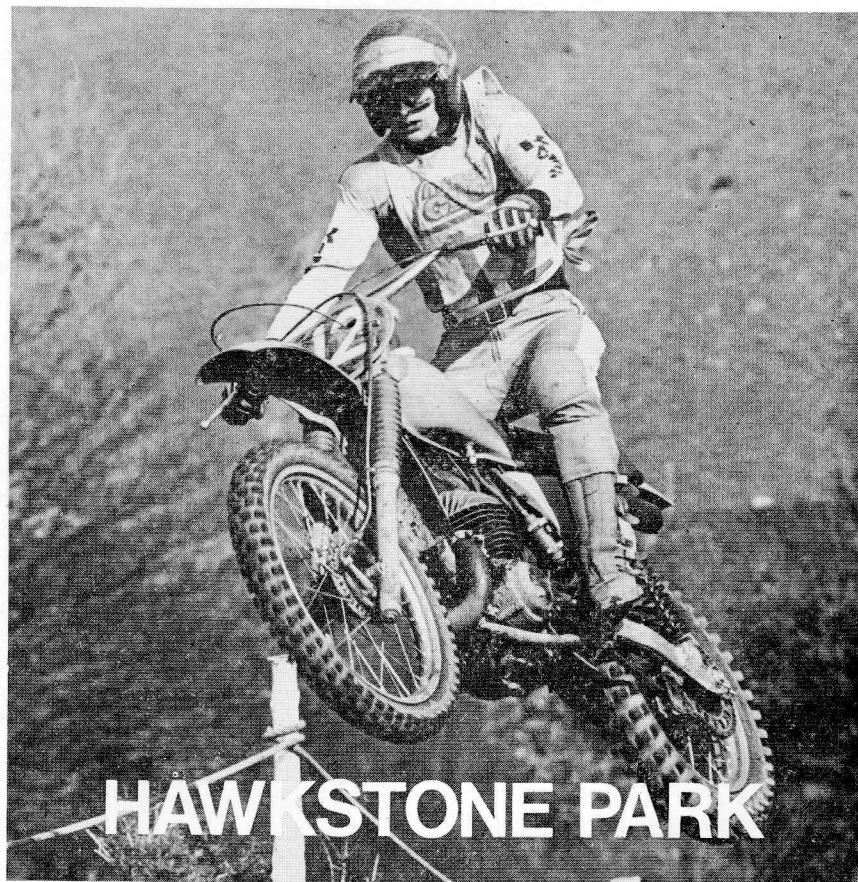

The main event of the day is the 250cc class, for which the prize money totals £280. The winner will receive £100 plus the annually awarded KAWASAKI TROPHY.

This event will see the end of an era as far as schoolboy racing is concerned Dave Thorpe, who gave such an outstanding performance here in October, today rides his last schoolboy race before going to the A.M.C.A. to gain valuable experience riding bigger machines and competing against senior competitors. We wish Dave all the luck in the world, and look forward to seeing him back at Hawkstone in the not to distant future.

A now well established and popular event at this meeting is the roadracers "demonstration run", which this year could be called the clash of the champions. World sidecar champions George O'Dell and

Cliff Holland, British Champion Steve Parish, along with Mick Grant Barry Ditchburn, Ron Haslam and possibly Barry Sheene, could be "doing battle" with the British Speedway Champion Michael Lee, who has no doubt heard a lot about Moto-Cross from his father Andy Lee, Graham Drury and our old friend, Tom Leadbitter. Hopefully all these boys, along with a host of other household names, will be in attendance. Give them all a big wave and a cheer as they pass, and make them feel welcome in the "rough track" arena.

The "A" Moto-Cross brings together top British scramblers, including Bob Waight, who will be riding the new 1978 Works C.C.M., Vic Allan, back on Bultaco, Montesa mounted Andy Robertson, Rob Hooper, Norman Barrow, Roger Harvey (Beamish Suzuki) who along with the winner of last year's schoolboy races, Dave Watson and all the other boys will be competing in the New Year Grand National.

Local interest centres around Pontesbury's Terry Challinor, who at the time of going to press was not sure of what machines he will be riding, Neville Kirkham from Minsterley and Tyronne Poutney from Baschurch.

We sincerely hope that you all have an enjoyable day, a safe journey home and a happy, prosperous and sporting New Year, and look forward to seeing you all at the meetings throughout the year, and in particular, the second round of the British Championship on April 2nd.
