1982 CENTURY OILS BRITISH MOTO CROSS CHAMPIONSHIP

Foreword by JACK BURNICLE

Welcome once again to Hawkstone Park, cornerstone of British motocross and a telling venue for the first round of the 1982 Open Championship.

Defending a title he won for the fifth time in 1981 is the popular, virile Hampshireman Graham Noyce. Honda-mounted for a fifth successive season, Graham is fitter and stronger now than he has been at any time since winning his World 500 cc Championship back in 1979.

1981 World 250 cc Champion and runner-up to Noyce in the national stakes last year, Pensford's smooth, stylish Neil Hudson (Yamaha) could prove once again to be his most persistent challenger. Remember they won one thrilling race apiece here last year . . .

Riding at a deceptively lowly number twelve will be Bracknell's nineteen year-old 'Kawasaki Kid' Dave Thorpe. The tall, handsome Berkshire boy raced only half a season in 1981 after injury but has already announced his intention of winning this year's British title. Noyce and Hudson beware!

The number three plate belongs to twenty-one year-old Dave Watson's factory Yamaha. The Gloucestershireman with the broad Ulster brogue also contests the 250 World Championships and should be a force in both domestic and world competition.

Riding at four is the 1980 British Champ, Geoff Mayes, back on his beloved Maico, while number five is the Suzuki ex team-mate Geoff so narrowly edged out last season, Bill Aldridge. In the absence of the injured Jonathan Wright, Bill spearheads the Heron Suzuki effort with newly promoted Jem Whatley. This Dorset teenager pranced away with last year's support series and looks likely to ruffle a few more mature feathers during 1982.

The number seven plate belongs to Mitsui Yamaha's Cheshire charger Pete Mathia, who finished third here last year. 'Math' invariably performs well at Hawkstone, as does the sturdy scot Willy Simpson, who occupies the number eight

His predecessor aboard Maicos, the equally ebullient veteran Lancastrian Bob Wright, has returned his burly allegiance to the Bolton-based Armstrong-CCM concern where he first made his name.

Rounding off the top ten, Rugeley's Rob Hooper claims Hawkstone as his favourite track. After four seasons with Maicos, the lean Midlander will be out aboard Vale Onslow's KTM, striking up a formidable partnership on the Austrian machinery with Herefordshire's big Dave Tomasik, who has ridden the H. C. Cecil model with resounding success since 1977.

The second of Rugeley's popular twins, thirty year-old Roger Harvey, loathes Hawkstone as deeply as Hooper loves it! But the Mitsui Yamaha teamster is always a dogged competitor and can never be discounted. Kawasaki's Paul Hunt, Honda's fresh recruit Steve Beamish, blockbusting Bryco Maico-mounted Derbyshireman Brett Steele, the Harrison brothers from Market Harborough and many more fine riders will also be suffering round Hawkstone today! Two special welcomes, however. The first to Sabden's Andy Ainsworth, returning from two consecutive seasons wrecked by a pair of dreadful foot and ankle injuries. The second to Birmingham's Vaughan Semmens, once number four in the championship and coming back in the support series after two years sidelined with a thigh breakage. Our particular best wishes to them.






