

## **FOREWARD**

Welcome once again to Hawkstone Park for this, the third round of the British Sidecar Cross and the J.M.X.M.A. 125 cc Championships and the fourth major meeting at Hawkstone this year.

For the first time since the early 70's, we see the return of Sidecars to this circuit and look forward to a good day's racing on their return.

Championship leaders, Terry Good with his new passenger Kevin Hughes, will be looking to lengthen their 11 point lead over Paul and Mark Millard from Bath. Also high on the leader board we hope to see Doug Fox and local man John Cooper, currently lying third in the Championship, who are hoping to improve their third place in the World Championship next Sunday at the British Sidecar Cross Grand Prix. Other teams in contention for the lead are Paul Morris/Paul Thomas and John Turner/Dave Henley currently lying fourth and fifth in the Championship respectively. John Elliott/Paul Mossman, at present sixth in the Championship, are the major two-stroke competitors as this year is the first year for the two-stroke machinery, although unfortunately, the lack the power of the larger capacities of the bigger outfits.

The 125 cc Championship will no doubt cause some changes on the leader board, as Round 3 sees the return of the fifth place man, David Thorpe (Kawasaki), returning from his Grand Prix Commitments after missing the second round. Peter Mathia (Yamaha) will be trying to hold on to his eight point lead oved Paul Hunt (Kawasaki), but local man, Roger Harvey (Yamaha), from Rugeley, will try to pass Hunt in the Championship as only one point separates Perry Leask (Yamaha) and Harvey from Hunt. Ten points are the difference between the first place man and the fifth place man, so we can hope to see several close battles between these riders.

Another Midland competitor is Rugeley's Rob Hooper (KTM), 6th in the Championship, who will want to improve his position by a double race win after his single race win at the previous round at Llanfair Waterdine. Perhaps we will see one of the famous duals between the Rugeley "twins" this afternoon.

Taking into account the three riders who have recently graduated from the Youth Division Andy Nicholls, Kurt Nicoll and Kevin Froud and also Suzuki's Jeremy Whatley and Honda's Kevin Ruddock and Don Brockbank, we can only expect a superb day's racing on this circuit which hasn't staged a major 125 cc adult meeting since the 125 cc Grand Prix in 1976.

Wishing all competitors success and everybody a good day.


