1981 BRITISH MOTO CROSS CHAMPIONSHIP

Foreward: by Paul Fowler (Motor Cycle News)

Welcome to Hawkstone Park and the blast off for a brand new British Moto Cross Championship Series.

The 1981 season is destined to be one of the most exciting for many years — and for once it is not just the riders contribution that makes it so.

For the first time the makers of the four Japanese marques have banded together to form the Japanese Moto Cross Manufacturers' Association and back the Title series with both cash and facilities.

But however much the Clubs, Sponsors and Makers try to grab the limelight, its the riders who will get the lions share of attention.

The question of the day is bound to be "can Graham Noyce win back the title"—and the answer? You'll have to wait until after today's British Championship races to get an indication. Only one thing is certain, there will be thirty four other riders on the line determined to stop the Honda ace from adding a fifth British title to his list of achievements.

First in line is sure to be reigning Champion Geoff Mayes, the bearded Suzuki man who snatched the injured Noyce's crown last season, and bearing the No. 2 plate is K.T.M.'s Dave Tomasik, he'll certainly be out to go one better this year.

Yamaha have a complete new team for top flight Moto Cross this year and any one of the four man squad is capable of winning races. World 250 cc runner-up in 1979, Neil Hudson, will be praying for an injury free run in '81 and early season results have shown a renewed determination in the un-assuming West Countryman. Team mates Dave Watson, Roger Harvey and Pete Mathia have all made the top ten last year and will be bidding to improve their positions this time around.

Many eyes today will be concentrating on the man who many say is the most exciting prospect in British Moto Cross. Dave Thorpe finished 5th in last year's series — his first in the British Championship proper. Now, after recovery from a serious injury, 18-years-old Thorpe is embarking on his first season of G.P. racing and many see him as a likely British Champion this year.

In a Championship as wide open as this, no one can tell who the potential high scorers will be. Swindon Yamaha man Paul Hunt, Suzuki's Steve Beamish, 250 Kawasaki mounted Jonathan Wright, and Maico man Rob Hooper will all be in among the points.

So with the best of good luck to all the riders — in both British Championship and Qualifying Series, here's to another fantastic days sport — let battle commence!

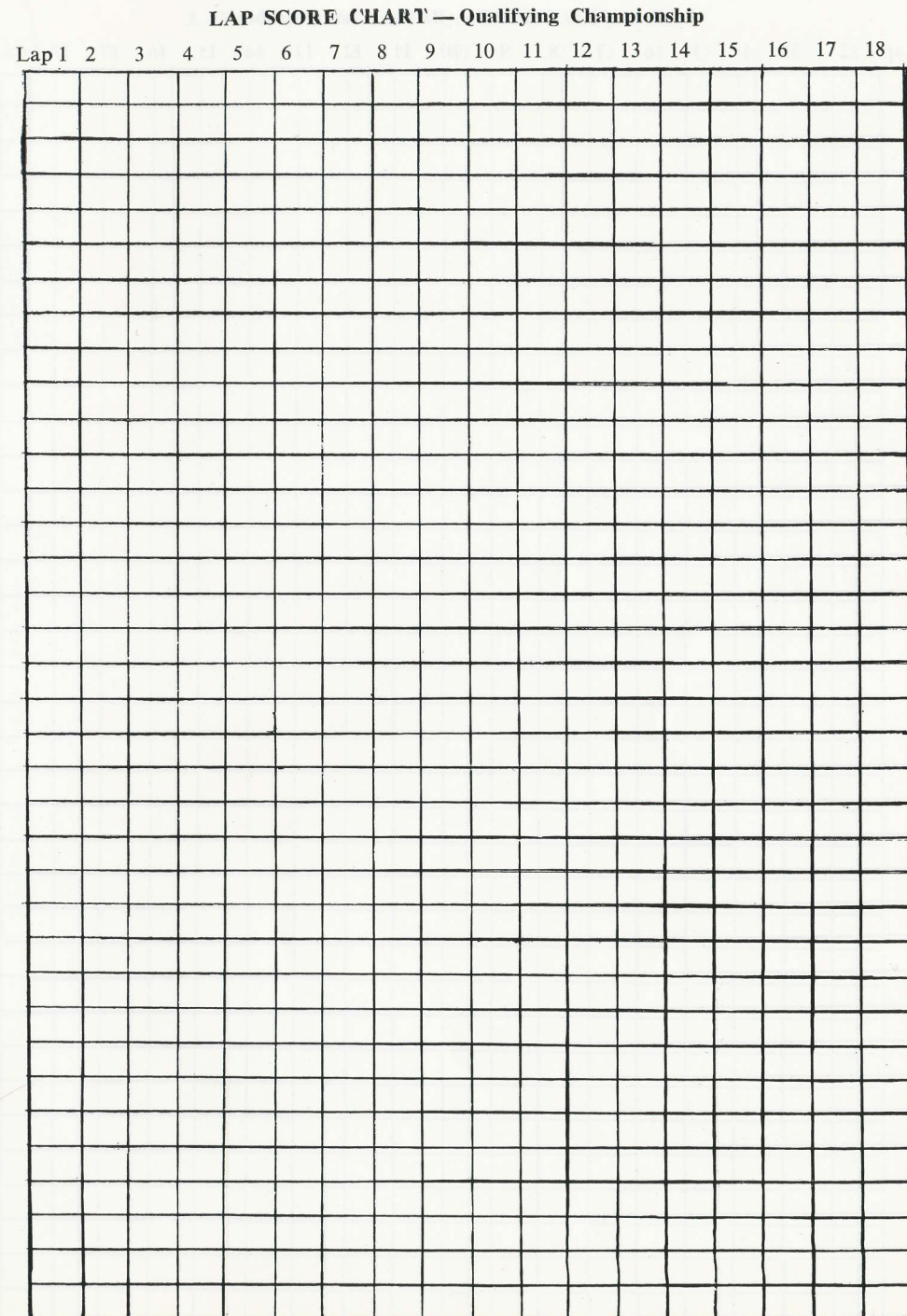
