FOREWORD

By JACK BURNICLE

The 1987 British motocross season has already seen its first three major meetings dominated by reigning National and World Champion Dave Thorpe (Honda). Here at Hawkstone Park, in front of the BBC Television cameras, in January; down at the Patchquick Trophy in Devon in February; and deep in the mire of the Early Birds at Canada Heights, Kent, in March, Thorpey proved invincible. Only a first turn crash at Canada Heights prevented him making a clean sweep of every race. The strength, determination and aggression of this dedicated 24 year-old Berkshireman makes it difficult to see him being beaten again in Shropshire. "There's only one man amongst us who is fit enough," observed the guy who benefitted from Thorpe's mishap at the Early Birds. Alan Morrison, also Honda-mounted, has been the champ's greatest threat so far, despite his lowly number 41. Expect the bright 20 year-old Ulsterman to be challenging for honours again today.

Other strong Honda contenders will be the lean 25 year-old Worcestershireman Rob Andrews, his burly John Banks Racing Team-mate Mark Banks, and the beefy Shirlaw Racing-backed Scottish veteran Willie Simpson. But Kawasaki, KTM and Yamaha all possess the firepower to embarrass the Honda heavies. Team Green is spearheaded by Kurt Nicoll, their number one contender for the 500cc world title honours. The 22 year-old from Newport, Essex, has been notching up some sensational early-season victories abroad. Backing him up will be national 125 champ Greg Hanson, fresh from a successful winter in New Zealand, where he won their 500cc crown; Newbury's stylish Andy Nicholls; the strong 26 year-old Ulsterman Laurence Spence; Hanson's winter travelling companions Perry Leask and Julian Clarke; muscular North-Easterner Jared 'Awsome' Smith; and rugged young Welshman Derek Roberts, whose second overall behind Thorpe at Canada Heights showed his prowess on rough, tough tracks like Hawkstone.

KTM's assault is led by 500 grand prix contenders Mervyn Anstie and Dave Watson. Berkshire's Anstie, backed this year by ex-world and British champion Graham Noyce, shares much of the latter's gritty determination to succeed, while 26 year-old Irishman Watson rides the light, nimble 350 KTM with which he aims for a top four 500 world title placing. Back-up for the Austrian factory runners features the Bryan Goss Motorcycles duo Russ Jarman and Mark Bennett and Anstie's teenaged number two in the Noyce Team. lanky Martin Cole.

Mitsui Yamaha put their faith in youth, Hampshire's Kevin Froud being the oldest member of a squad containing 18 year-old 250 grand prix hope Rob Herring, Welshman Stuart Coyle and dashing teenager Dave Denly. Also always strong at Hawkstone is David Jones Motorcycles backed Andy Watkins who, together with Roberts, Coyle and Dai Llewellin, forms the strongest Welsh representation for many a long year at national motocross level.

Team Suzuki's new race boss is local veteran Rob Hooper, the only survivor from that original Top 30 back in 1975! Their challenge for top honours, however, will be pinned on the gifted but erratic Jem Whatley. The 24 year-old Hampshireman unluckily broke bones in his left hand at the Early Birds, but will hopefully have recovered sufficiently to boost the 250cc open class challenge. Throw in Maico's fiery young Scot Tony Caig, gutsy Honda privateers Rob Meek, Alan Blood, Willie Burgess and Mayson Wear and Pro-Circuit Husqvarna newcomers Andy Breacher and Lee King, plus a possee of Kawasaki privateers and you have the ingredients for an entertaining, closely-fought afternoon. And remember to keep an eye on the lads contesting those midfield placings. That's often where the hardest work is being done.


