



1980 BRITISH 250 cc MOTO CROSS GRAND PRIX

Foreword: by Alex Hodgkinson

The 250 World Moto Cross Championship might not be as glamorous as the 500 series but it more than makes up for it with the competitive nature of the racing.

Not only are there far more riders capable of winning a Grand Prix in the 250 class but machine-wise there are machines from all over the world fighting it out for points, a very different story from the 500 class in which the Japanese big four of Honda, Kawasaki, Yamaha and Suzuki dominate.

Georges Jobe, the 19 year old Belgian, won his home GP for Suzuki and Germans Rolf Dieffenbach and Fritz Kobele won two of the first three rounds on Hondas but in the most open contest for years they are facing stiff opposition from two of the longest established factories in Moto Cross—CZ and Husqvarna.

Despite the loss of last year's 250 world, champion, Swede Hakan Carlqvist, Husqvarna are well represented in the chase for the title by Raymond Boven, Dimitar Rangelov, Patrick Fura and Erik Sundstrom while for CZ the irrepressible Jaroslav Falta is having his best season since he was beaten for the title in 1974.

The Czechoslovakian, whose career since then has been dogged by illness and injury, is so unpredictable that 'Enigmatic' has become his middle name but, despite the return to the CZ fold of the Russians Gennady Moiseev and Vladimir Kavinov, he has been the top runner from Eastern Europe this year.

Moiseev has been disappointing but he can never be ruled out. He scored two wins here at Hawkstone in 1977 and has not been beaten on British soil since 1975. The three times world champion will be anxious to show his true mettle today.

Jan Kristoffersen and Jean-Paul Mingels of Yamaha and SWM's Jean-Claude Laquaye have had to play supporting roles so far this year but both have the ability to win while Hawkstone's sand should suit Dutchmen Kees Van der Ven and Bennie Wilken riding Maico and KTM respectively.

Unfortunately Britain's main hope for success, Neil Hudson, is out of action at the time of going to press with a broken ankle but Rob Hooper, Billy Aldridge and Dave Watson have all shown good form in Continental rounds and with the encouragement of their home crowd could spring a surprise.

Completing the British line-up for this one round are two men with vast GP experience. Roger Harvey, currently in the middle of an outstanding run of success, was fifth in the 125 world championship four years ago while Andy Roberton represents Yamaha, who, along with Girling Gas Shocks, are sponsoring today's meeting.

It all makes for a day of exceptionally exciting Moto Cross with the rest of Britain's best riders in the three supporting races. The odds are that at the end of the day you'll be noting the date of June 21st, 1981 in your diary for on that day the Salop Motor Club will again be organising the British 250 Grand Prix here at Hawkstone Park.
