The other is Chris Adlem, who will be making his debut on a works Kawasaki, which will be presented

to him at the meeting by Alec Wright. Good luck to them both, and we look forward to seeing and hearing more of them in the future.

A feature not to be missed is the display of the Kawasaki Range of motor cycles at the KAWASAKI ROAD BIKE SHOW which is being held in the large marquee situated in the centre of the course. In addition to the machines and music, some of our top Road Racing boys will be in attendance, they will include' hopefully, Mick Grant, John Williams, Cliff Carr, Geoff Barry, Neil Tuxworth, Bob Heath, and our own local Hero from Market Drayton, the British Sidecar Champion passenger, Cliff Holland. The "A" Moto-Cross brings together most of the top scramblers in Britain. Joining John Banks in the C.C.M. team will be Bob Wright who seems to be quite "at home" on the bigger machine. We welcome back Graham Noyce after his American trip, which, by his own standards, was not too successful. Never mind Graham, good luck in '77 and we hope that you have even more success in the World Championships than you had in 1976. The other young globe trotter, Neil Hudson returns after a very pleasing and successful journey to Australia.

Another re-union takes place today. The Rugeley duo Rob Hooper and Roger Harvey are back on Huskey's, and both are "raring to go." Rob in particular, who has a score to settle with Vic Allan, who just pipped him in the recent T.V. series. Incidentally, at the time of going to print, Vic has not decided on what machine he will be riding.

As well as the previously mentioned debuts of Billy Edwards and Chris Adlem, the "B" Motor-Cross heralds the arrival into the Senior Ranks of Chris Small and Kevin Ruddock. Local interest in these races centres around Terry Challinor, who, without giving away any secrets about his age, reckons that he must now have done more competitive laps here at Hawkstone than any other present rider—no doubt this will lead to quite a bit of discussion.

Other locals include Tyrone Poutney from Shrewsbury, Keith Abrahams from Telford and Neville Kirkham from Minsterley.

We sincerely hope that you all have a very enjoyable day, a safe journey home, and a happy Sporting New Year, and we look forward to seeing you all at our meetings throughout this year and future years.

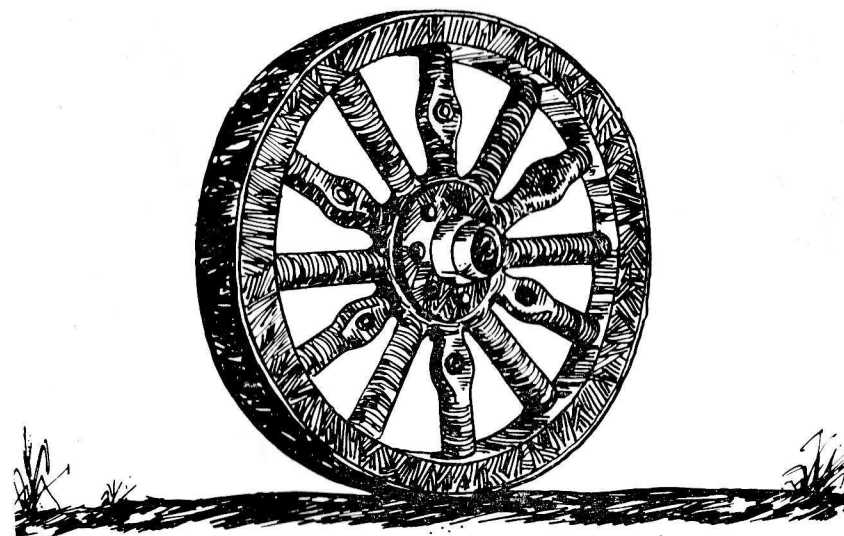
