BRITISH MOTOCROSS CHAMPIONSHIP

FOREWORD by Nick Harris (Motor Cycle News)

Welcome to Higher Rocombe for the first round of the Motor Cycle News British Motocross Championships

This year's series has been increased to eight rounds, two more than last year, which range throughout the country as far afield as Bootle in the North and Brighton in the South.

Last Year's Championship turned into a battle royal between two of Britain's brightest grand prix starts Graham Noyce and Neil Hudson which was not resolved until the final round when Noyce clinched his third successive title.

Twenty two year old Noyce, who is number one rider for the giant Honda factory, has started his season in brilliant style beating World Champion Heikki Mikkola in Holland recently and is deternimed to hang onto his hard won title.

Challenger Hudson had a superb season last year riding his West German Maico. In addition to finishing second in the British Championship he was fifth in the World 250 series and became the hero of British fans when he became the first British rider to win a grand prix for nine years when he was victorious in Sweden.

However, don't run away with the idea that these two are going to completely dominate the Championship for there are a number of capable riders just itching to get their hands on the Championship crown.

Veterans Vic Allan (Bultaco), Andy Roberton, who switched to Yamaha from Montesa in the close season, and Bryan Wade, who rides the Italian Villa machines after leaving Suzuki, are certain to be in contention although there are plenty of young riders beginning to make their mark.

Sussex youngster Steve Beamish (Suzuki) looks in fine form and will receive support from team-mate Jonathan Wright and Billy Aldridge. British Under 18 Champion, David Watson, makeshis Montesa championship debut while Michael Pearce (Maico) looks well set after a fine ride in the recent Motor Cycle News Motocross Masters meeting.

Bob Wright brings the all-british four valve four-stroke CCM to the line determined to make a good start to his Championship campaign while the new Cotton/EMX pairing of Ultersman Rob Wilkinson and Pete Mathia look formidable.

The Midland Maico duo of Vaughan Semmens and Roger Harvey are in good form and Maico form a formidable factory challenge with Geoff Mayes, Paul Harrison and brother Steve, who was support Champion last year, and Roger Garrett.

Welcome back to Rob Hooper, winner of last year's Patchquick here at Rocombe, who returns to the Championship scene after a bad crash last September and watch out for Andy Ainsworth (Husqvarna), the K.T.M. duo of Dave Tomasik and Terry Dyer, Stuart Nunn (Yamaha), Jimmy Aird (CCM) and Vic Eastwood (Yamaha).

At the end of the season five riders are relegated from the Championship series and replaced by the top five riders in the Support Championship. This ensures competitive racing in the support series where former British Schoolboy Champion Dave Thorpe (Kawasaki) makes his debut.


The two British Championship races are each 40 minutes plus two laps in duration with the Support races each 30 minutes plus two laps.

The winner of each race receives 30 points with scoring down to 15th spot where the rider gains one point.
