

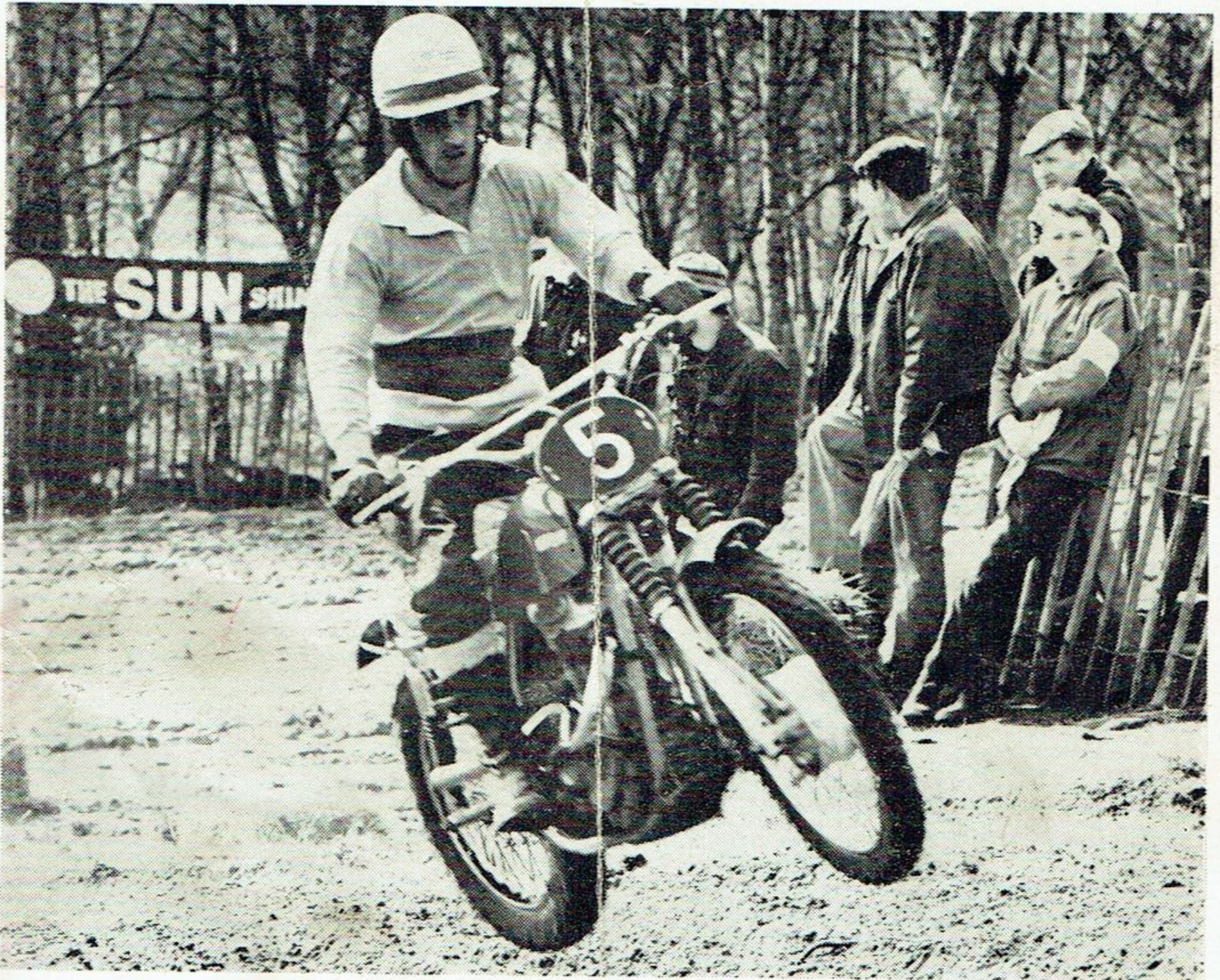

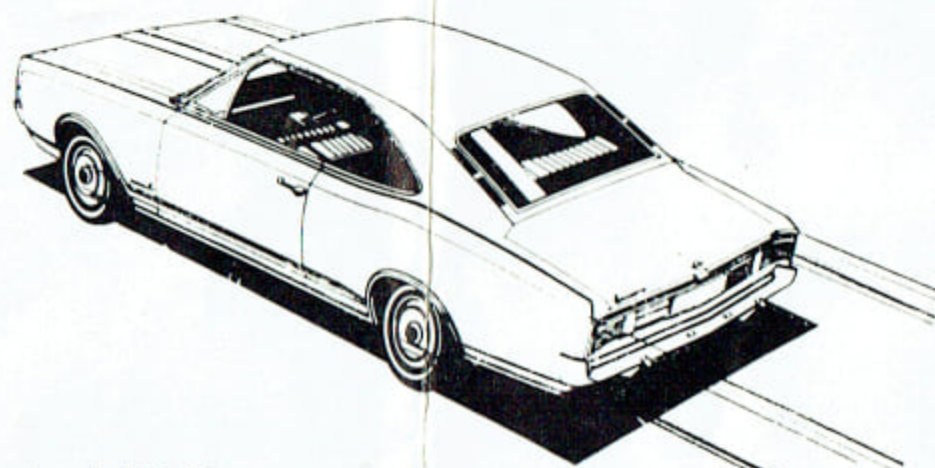

PROGRAMME NOTES

Good afternoon Ladies and Gentlemen. The Ipswich Motor Cycle and Car Club extend a welcome to competitors and spectators at this the 20th National Scramble and the 3rd at Hintlesham Park.

The track itself has undergone no changes since last years alterations, but a clearance of undergrowth and trees within the wood has enhanced the facilities of this part of the course.

After several years lapse we are presenting a programme of both solo and sidecar events, which will we hope cater for all your tastes. The solo races are for the usual trophies and classes and its anybody's guess as to which names will be added to the already impressive list of past winners. There are two events for the 'chair' men and the first, Event 3, is the 4th round of the British Sidecar Drivers Championship.

Before this meeting starts, Nick Thompson is leading the Championship table with Mike Guildford a very handy second-place-man. Len Crane is finding the points hard to get this year so far, but perhaps this meeting will see him really 'go'. We've mentioned the drivers, but don't forget the 'passengers' they earn their corn as well.

It is hoped that you will leave the course thoroughly satisfied with you afternoon's sport and whilst at the meeting we must ask for your co-operation in (a) keeping behind the double ropes; (b) using the Controlled Crossing for gaining access to the centre of the track and (c) respecting our landowner's property.

Points for the Championship race are awarded as follows:—

The main Festival events are given, wet or fine on the only Open Air Stage in England that can be viewed from a covered auditorium.

WHEN ARE THEY?

In the summer usually in July—when the stage and the magnificent trees for which Hintlesham is famous are floodlit—as is the Hall itself in which the Exhibitions are arranged.

In the winter, events at several week-ends may include Concerts, Balls, Films and Chamber Opera in the Saloon and other rooms of the Hall.

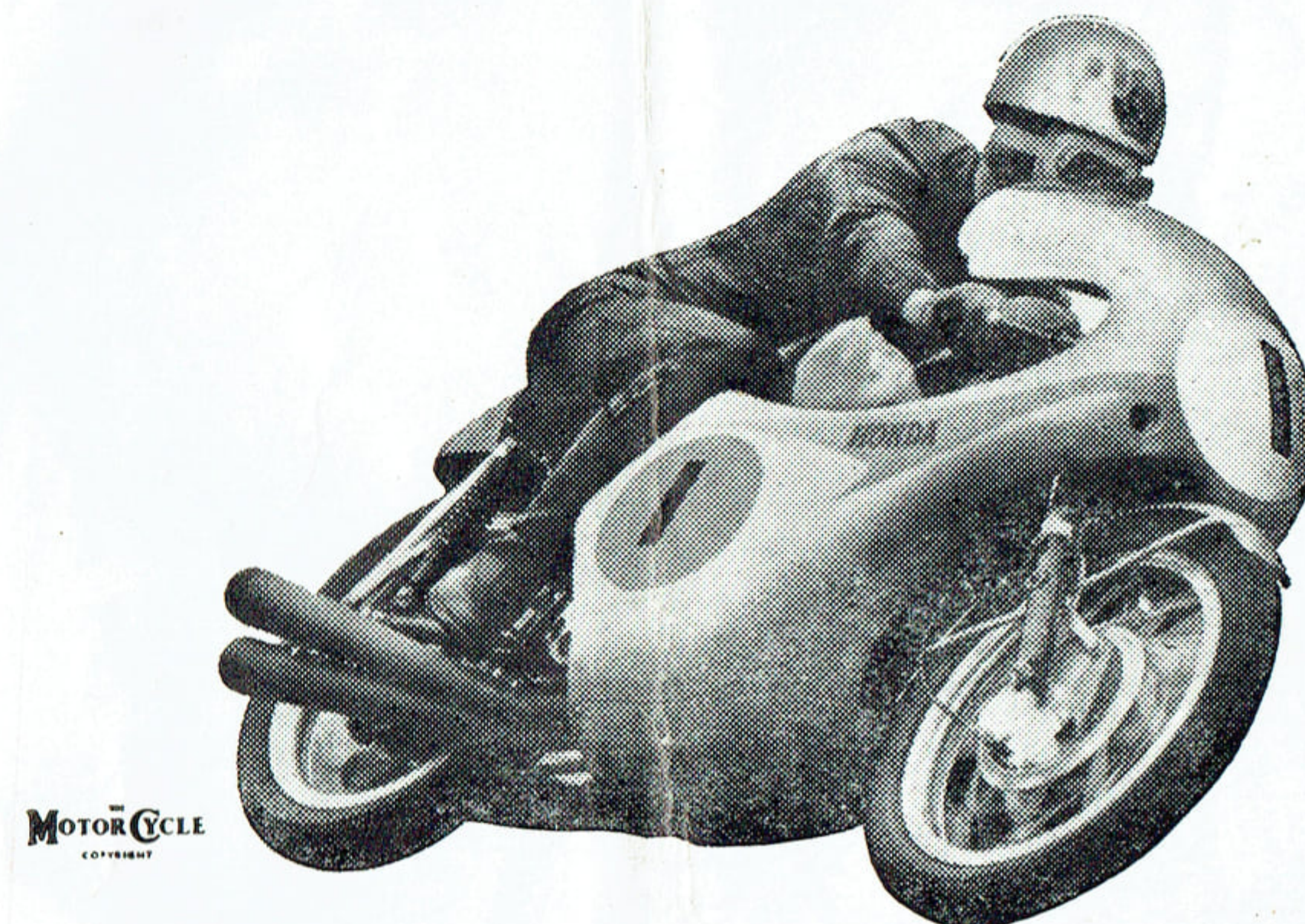
