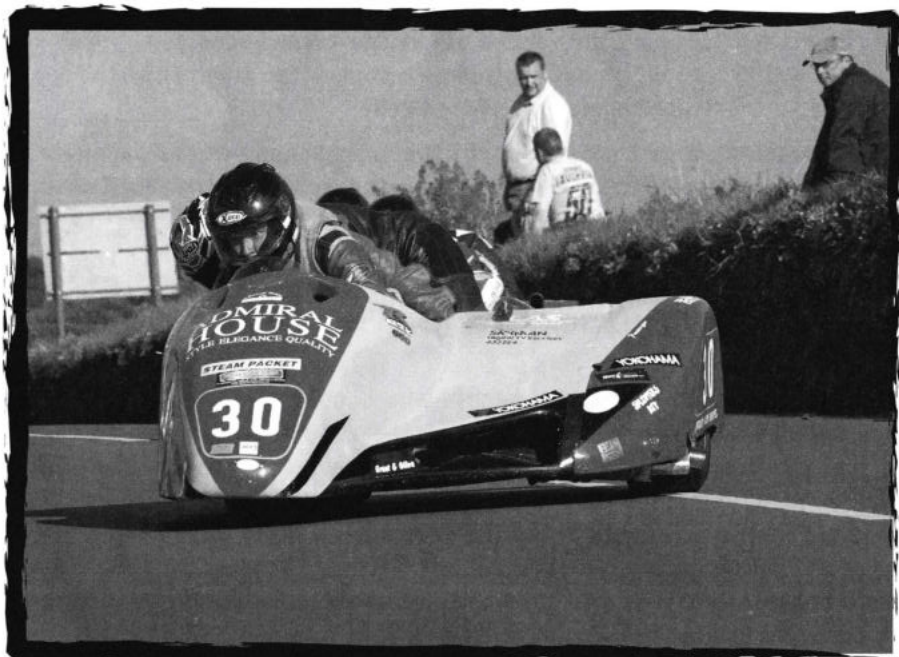

Michael and William Dunlop are currently second and third, with Keith Amor, John Burrows and Steve Plater completing the top six.

The 2008 Southern '100' Solo Champion, Ian Lougher, has previously won the Duke Rankings on three occasions and whilst he is presently in a lowly place for him, eighth position, by the conclusion of racing at Billown on Thursday afternoon, could well be in contention to mount a challenge to his rival, Ryan Farquhar.

This leaves the race wide open with previous winners Ian Bell and Greg Lambert along with Roy Hanks, Phil Dongworth and newcomer Gary Bryan, all likely to be in with a shout.

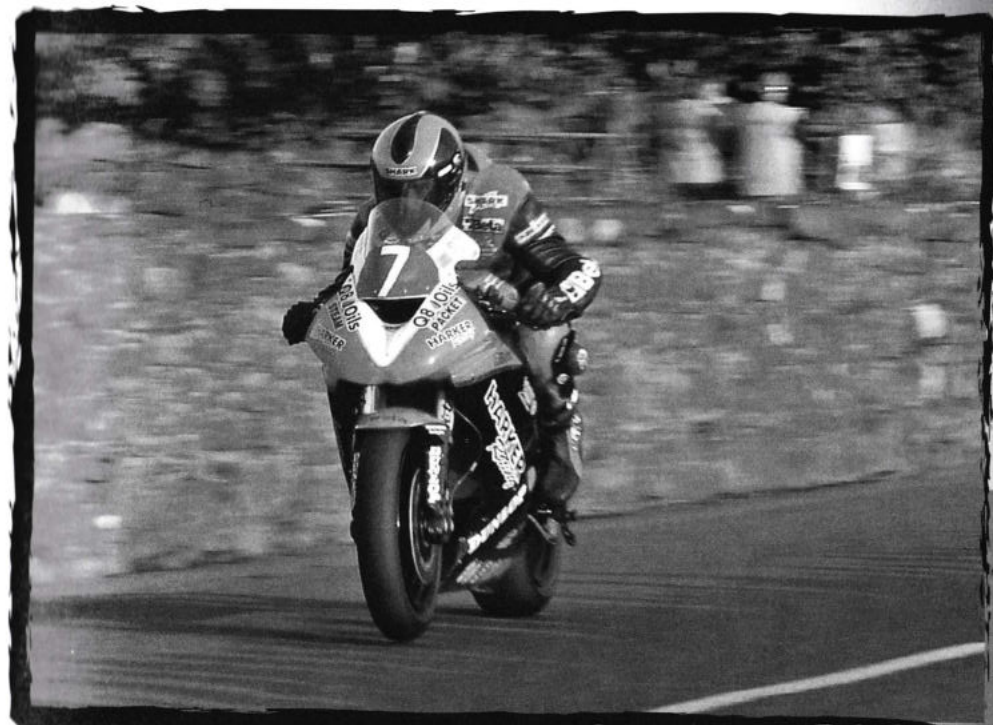

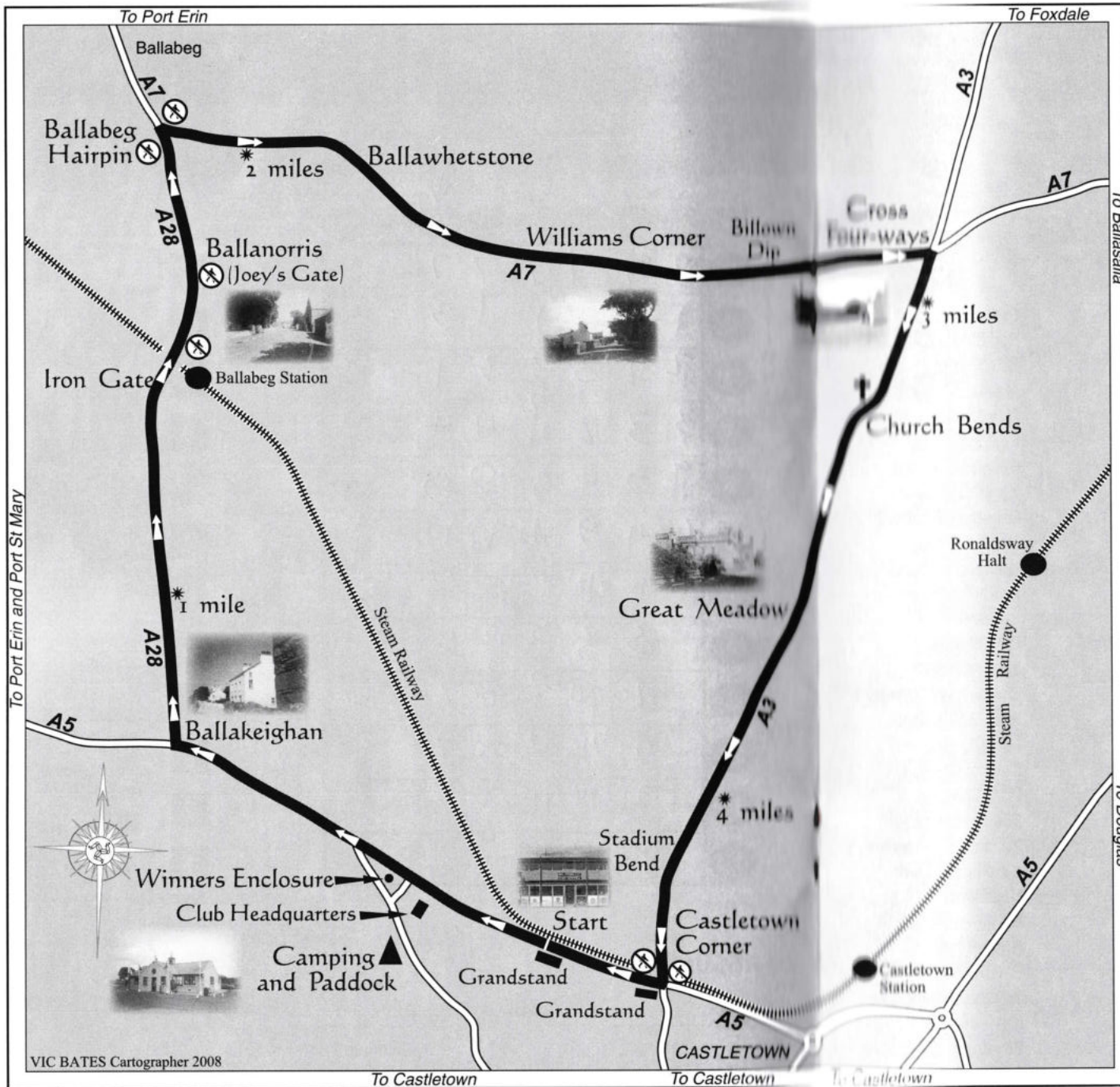

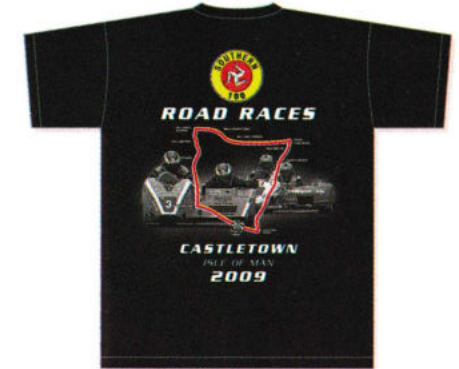
