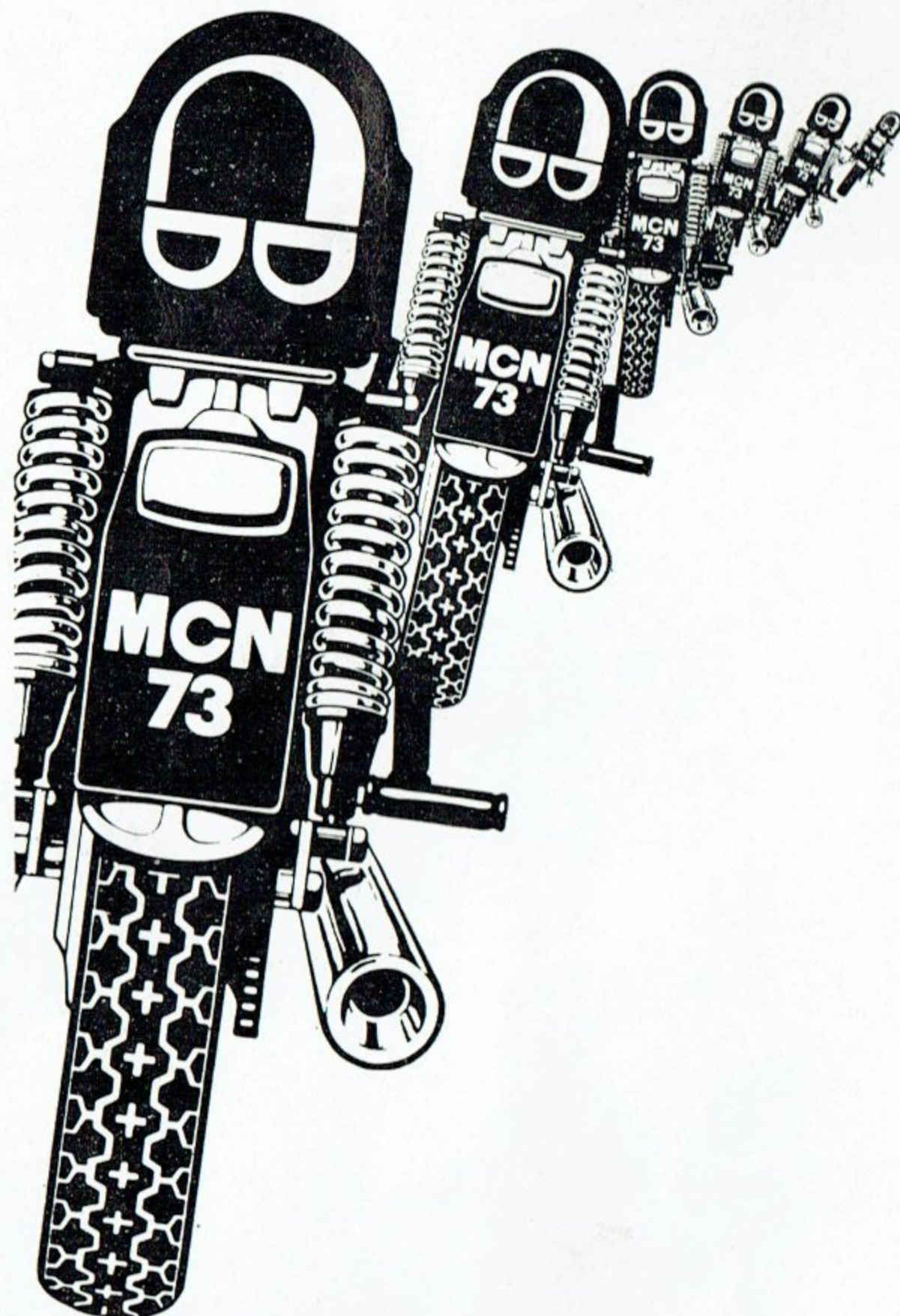

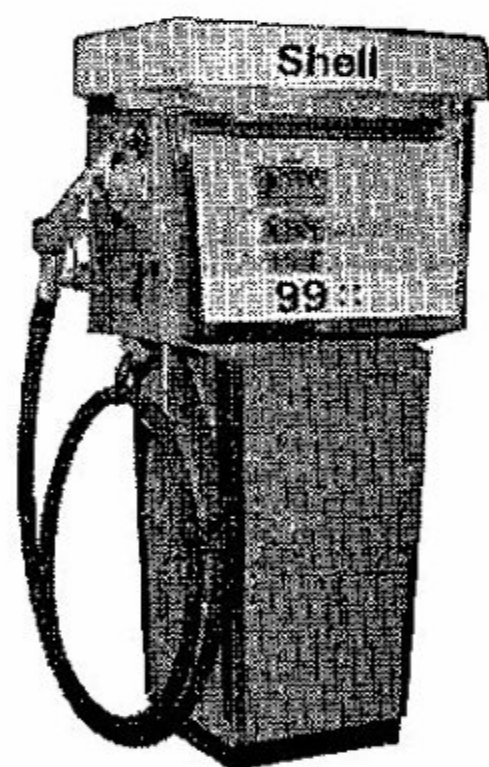

Hants Grand International 1973

I expect a Yamaha to score a first major British Moto-Cross victory today and the rider will most probably be Ake Jonsson.

Although the thirty year old Swede is still experimenting with his new bike, which sports Maico front forks, Jonsson is my tip for "The New Look Hants".

A staunch supporter of this Easter classic since it achieved International status seven years ago, Jonsson was at the height of his fame with Maico when he won at Matchams in 1971. It was the year he came within a whisker of taking the 500 cc World Title after a fight to the finish with Roger de Coster.

My forecast for the first Hants Grand International to be held in Dorset is made safer by the fact that Hakan Andersson, runner-up in last year's 250 cc World Championship will be supporting Jonsson on another 400 cc Yamaha. A third Swedish Ace, Uno Palm, makes his first British appearance on a Puch from the Austrian factory. Previously with Husqvarna, this flaxen-haired 28 year old was 5th in last year's 250 cc World Contest.

Finland is represented by the forceful Heikki Mikkola on a Grand Prix Husqvarna and by Kalevi Vehkonen on a Montesa on which he shattered the International scene with his explosive speed at a recent Belgian event.

After a spate of success on a Cheney B.S.A. during which he took the lead in the 500 cc British Championship before a promising World Title bid, John Banks is probably our best hope.

I have never seen the Wimborne Club's Grand Canyon Circuit before but from all accounts it could be the sort of circuit which brings out the best in Bryan Wade.

Thanks to the Wimborne Club, who have provided a replacement for the Ringwood Club's traditional, but now outdated venue, we can expect a spectacular day's racing.

John Turner, the British Sidecar Champion who recently suffered a surprise defeat from Kevin Logan, has Nick Thompson to worry about, and now that a 125 cc Class seems here to stay, I look forward to seeing how they can compete against 250 cc in the same race.


