**Final Instructions**

**Directions to Canada Heights:** (Postcode for SatNavs – **BR8 8DX** and keep going for ¼ mile). From Junction 3 of the M25, take the Brands Hatch signs onto the A20 (note: **not the M20**). Straight on at the first roundabout, then turn left after 300 yards into **Button Street**, signposted **Swanley Village**. Canada Heights is on the right after one mile of this narrow and bendy lane -**TAKE CARE!**

All machines **MUST** be presented to the Scrutineer before proceeding to the start. No machines are to be ridden before a rider's actual start, except to the start by the shortest route. Engines may be started for warming up, but please keep the noise level down.

The start is at **9:31am**; **4 solo** riders per minute. Sidecar will start one per minute. Two laps of eighteen sections per lap.

**IMPORTANT** See the separate sheet of the **Riders Start Time.. Competitors are allowed 5 hours to complete the course. All sections will close at 3.15pm.**

**SPECIAL TEST.** In the event of a tie the times from the *Special Test* will decide the winner.

**SECTION MARKING CARDS.** **White** cards for the hard route, **Red** cards for the easier route, **Yellow** for the **C** class girder fork, Sidecars and *Gentlemen*. (**W, R** and **Y** in the following list).

**MARKING** will be 0,1,2,3,5 with **10 for missing a section**. Please ensure you visit every section on both laps. This trial is run to the "no stop" rules: i.e. no stationary balancing or rolling backwards.

**The Jack Thompson Trophy** will be awarded to the best performer in Class A riding the **WHITE** route.

The official results will be published and displayed within approximately 45 minutes of the last competitor's finish. Any protests must be with the Secretary of Meeting within **30 minutes** of the published time and with the correct fee of £50.

**Riders:** If you wish to change from White to Red (Hard to Easy) or Red to White (Easy to Hard) route, please tell the Secretary of Meeting when you sign on. If riding the Red route, please ensure you have **RED** numbers on your bike, or you may be given "Fives" for riding the wrong side of markers.

If your Class is wrong in the above list, or you are riding out of class for No Award, please tell the Secretary of Meeting.

**Don't forget that it is 10 marks if you miss a section. If you do not want to tackle a section, ask the observer to mark you as a '5'. Also your Secretary of Meeting does not have to spend ages trying to find if an error has been made by the observer or when inputting the scores into the computer!**

**Don't forget to SIGN OFF at the end of the Trial.**

## Competition Mind



### Sharing the Secrets of Success

- Do you feel as though you could go faster, get better results, and enjoy your competition more but don't quite know where the answers are?
