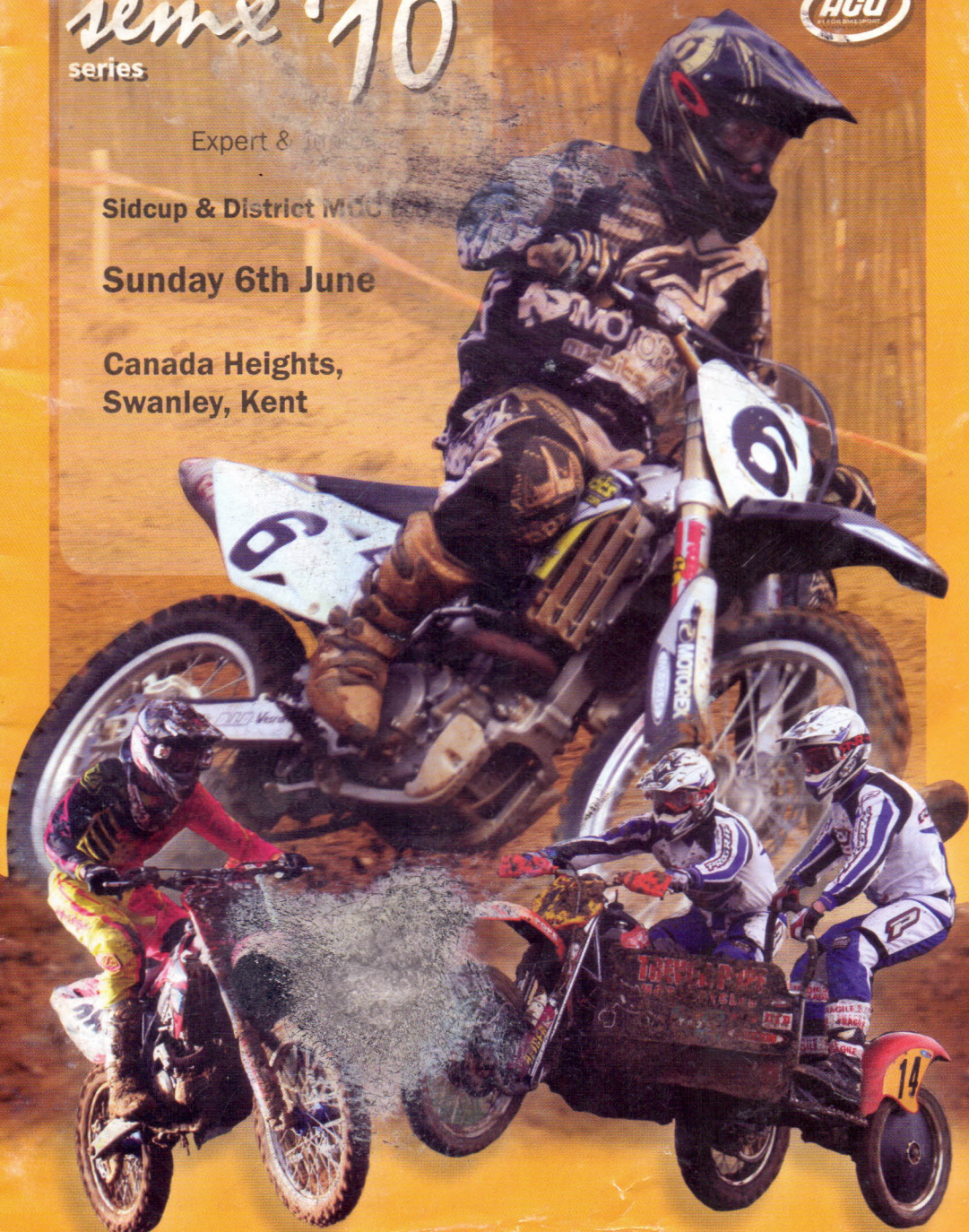

Supplementary Regulations

The event today is a round counting towards the South Eastern Centre Motocross Championship for both Junior and Expert classes. This season-long competition will feature two more rounds to be held at this circuit the next on July 4th and the final round on October 10th.

We also extend a warm welcome to the EVO Class - or Evolution to give it its full name is a fairly new idea built onto the Twinshock Class as the years are rolling forward. Basically it is for any Pre 1990 machine and has no restrictions on engine size or stroke or rider age limits. It is a chance to see some much loved machines that have been restored and raced which hold some strong memories from our recent past. This is Round 4 of the Dave Thorpe EVO Championship.

As a particular point of interest we hope you will all cheer the super fit Mark Eastwood as he jumps from his modern Honda in the Expert Class to riding a Dennis Slythe prepared 500 Honda in the EVO Class around this demanding Canada Heights circuit.

Finally may we wish competitors in all classes an enjoyable day's racing.

Practice: Experts, Juniors Nos. 52-149, Juniors Nos. 150-955, EVOS Minimum 2 laps free practice. A board at the finish line will indicate that timed training has commenced (approx 2 laps)

Juniors seeding to races: 1st 23 from timed training in each group to Junior A, next 22 from timed training in each group to Junior B and the remainder to Junior C.

Start Line Positions: Experts and EVOS as per timed training results. Juniors alternate positions from timed training results of Group 1 and 2.

Timed Training times and race results will be printed out and displayed at the signing on container. (There are no monitors).

Sharing the Secrets of Success
