Welcome to the June Motocross at Canada Heights. Unusually for our Open Motocrosses, neither the Expert nor Junior entry has been filled to capacity. The lack of Experts could be due to a MX Nationals round at Hawkstone Park, Staffordshire. The Evo class did reach the maximum of 45, but has dropped a bit due to riders' injuries and broken bikes!

As a result, Experts and Juniors are combined in Allcomers races, but prize money and awards will be allocated to both classes separately. We have seen some spectacular and competitive racing this season and this I'm sure will be set to continue with today's line up.

John Powell is the usual Entry Secretary for Sidcup's motocross events, but he has been in the Isle of Man watching the TT, so I have taken over for this meeting. There's more to being a Motocross Secretary than for our Enduro and Trials, which is my usual role! And MX riders seem to leave it very late before deciding to enter, which does not make my job any easier!

Hopefully everything will flow smoothly during the meeting – except rain, of course!

The next opportunity for Sidcup members to ride at Canada Heights is on 9th July. It's a Motocross for Sidcup Club members only – no one-day memberships. Why not make a weekend of it by coming to the Heights on the evening of Friday 7th for our annual Bike Night? Up to 400 riders come for a 3-hour 'social' evening to show off their bikes, meet and chat to other riders and to have something to eat and drink.

Most who come are on road bikes - exotic Superbikes, classic British, Japanese, American and European bikes, scooters, sidecars and the amazing 'Rat Trikes'. Other bikes bought in vans include Road Racers (Manx Norton, Gilera, Triumph, etc.); Trials bikes both modern and Pre-65 British, Enduro and Motocross bikes. We even have had a Jawa speedway bike (I must ask the owner to start it up this year!).

Back to today's Motocross and I hope all riders have a good day's racing at 'the South's most spectacular motocross track'.

Flags: The rules changed a few seasons ago, waved yellows means "Great Danger, prepare to stop, no overtaking. A significant reduction must be seen, therefore jumps should not be attempted" - we haven't gone to all the effort of getting marshals out there for a sun tan, they are there to help you the riders have a safer day. Observing flag signals is there to help you all; we as officials and marshals try very hard to only use waved yellows where necessary so please help us to help you by observing the rules.

Fire extinguishers: This rule has been about for some time, but in today's health and safety culture we need to be seen to be proactive. The rules state each rider shall have at least a 2kg dry powder fire extinguisher. Riders will need to present their fire extinguisher at technical control in the future.

Numbers: It's always a moan about this but we try very hard to help you. The numbers on your bike, let us the race officials, but also your fans / family / rivals /etc know who you are. We do have a permanent number scheme for those that want to look "nice", but if you chose not to use this scheme don't be upset that we give a different number than you currently have on your bike. When you stick a bit of duct tape along side a giant number, shockingly the rest of us can't always tell who you are. We've got some vinyl to hand to cover number plates and Off Road South East have numbers for sale if you can't make your number plate clear yourself.

Security: Many of you will be aware that there had been a spate of thefts early last year. Please do all you can to keep your bikes and possessions chained up when unattended - overnight and during the day.

Marshalling: It's a pain but as we've said above its there for you, the riders, safety. We at Sidcup operate a scheme over the two club members race days - we randomly pick from the entry list enough of you to cover the marshal points for half a day. Once you've done your duty you won't do it at the other meeting. We operate the same scheme over the 4 open meetings (April, May, June and October) - thus everyone marshals once for the club days and once for open meetings. Theoretically you could be lucky you don't get picked, but we only ask you to do it once in each set of meetings during the year. In an ideal world we might have an army of paid persons to do the marshalling, unfortunately we don't and this is the least worst system we have come up with. We are all aware that it is not easy to get someone to do this, all riders are in the same situation, appeals on social media in advance have been successful for many of you. Please be reassured we actively monitor who does marshal and try very hard to ensure that no one "gets away" without doing their bit.

Timed Qualification

Part of each Allcomer group's Practice session will be timed to decide the qualifiers for Groups A, B and C.

The fastest 33% from Q1, Q2 and Q3 will form the A Group. The next 33% the B Group, and the remainder the C Group.

The Evo class will be timed to determine the order in which they will enter the start line.

Unauthorised Riding

The riding of machines of any sort in the paddock and areas surrounding the circuit is totally forbidden. Because the event is on private property it does not place it outside the Road Traffic Act in terms of insurance. It cannot be stressed too strongly, that liability for a substantial claim could rest with the owners of the vehicle and the driver (or parents in the case of a minor) in the event of an accident.

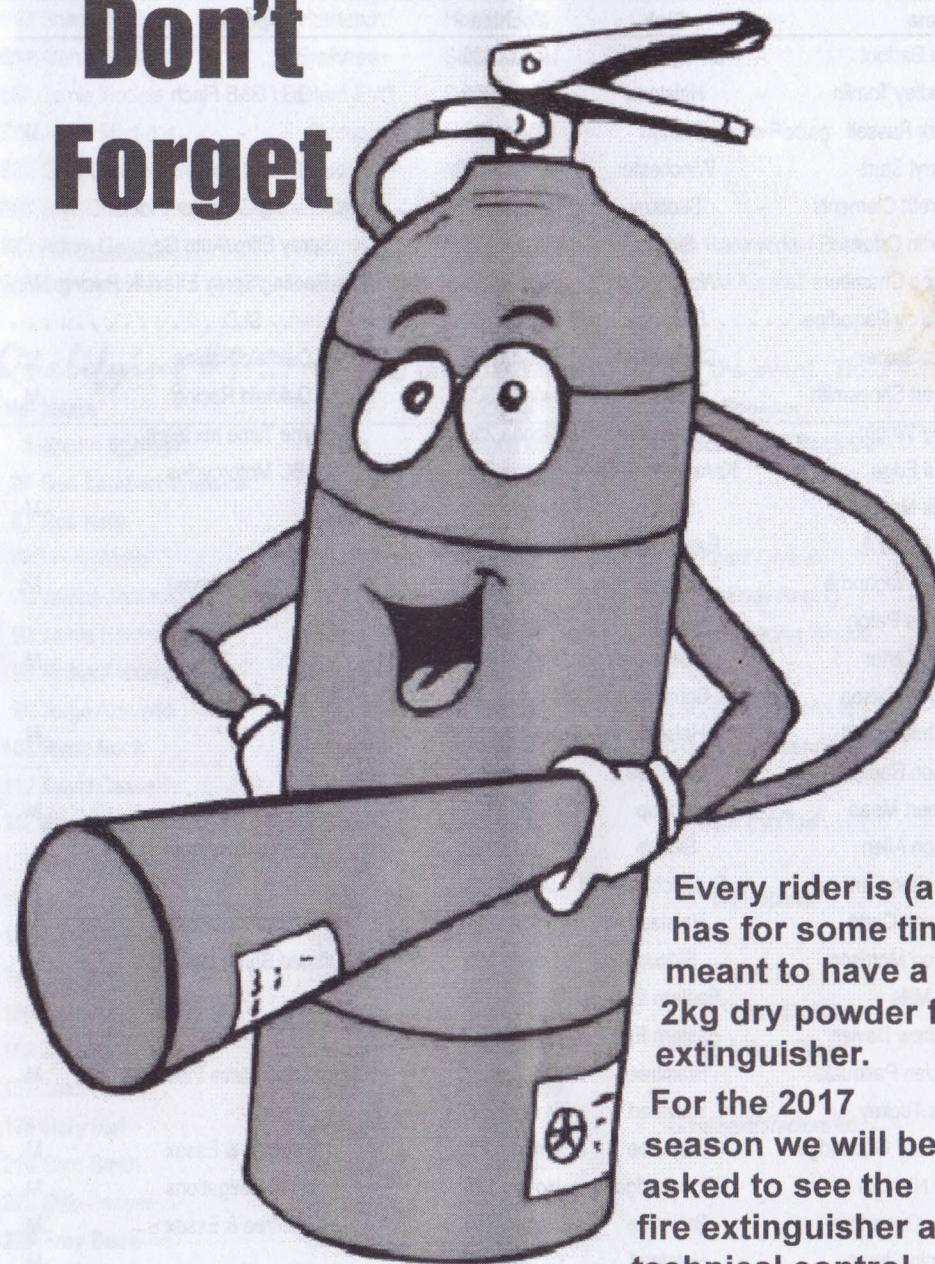

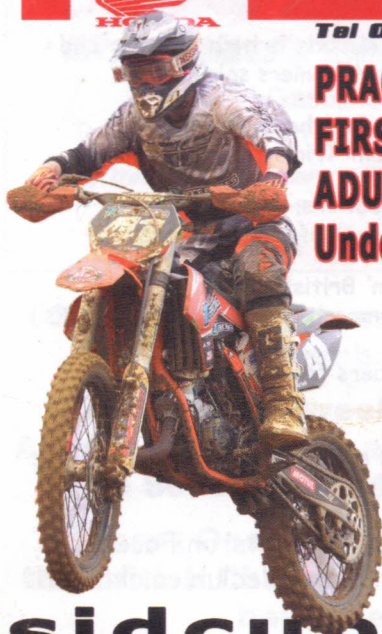
