Welcome to Canada Heights for the second round of the 2018 season, we hope you have a safe and enjoyable day.

At the May Motocross last year's champion and Canada Heights Expert Mark Eastwood had a big bullseye on his back and the young guns had the 47 year old firmly in their sights, first disappointment was when ex-champion Danny Arnold got mixed up in a start line melee resulting in a trip to hospital with a suspected broken wrist. Late entry Jack Brunel was quickly away taking a commanding lead with Eastwood in the second position, it was all going to plan for Jack until the Woodbridge Kawasaki failed to show mid race and Jack dropped to 9th, in the following races Jack borrowed an ASA bike to replace the expired KXF. Connor Hughes pulled off a win and a second but a 5th place cost the Essex ace the overall. So it was the evergreen Mark Eastwood with 2 wins and a runner up spot that secured the maximum points and the elusive SEMX championship lead. It was mixed fortunes for some riders who were back from long lay offs, Junior Thomas and Gareth Morley had good rides but as mentioned Danny Arnold was out after 100 yards, Ryan Nock reinjured an old shoulder injury and Rowan Hill killed his Kawasaki after an impressive hole shot in race 1. The Juniors were undeterred mixing it with the Experts in these Allcomer races, Joe Walklett on the Husqvarna 450 was top Junior with Ross Clarke from Halsted second on a 250 Yamaha and Biggin Hill's Tye Green third who recovered from a back bruising fall in moto 1.

Dave Williams dominated the Vet+35 group as he continues his "retirement" and with a smaller than usual group today probably due to the fact that it is Father's day and I suspect it will be a calmer group especially as the guest British Superbike boys John Waghorn and Matt Coles return to the tarmac at Snetterton.

Today we will be running Experts and Juniors again to form 3 Allcomer groups to be determined by transponder timing, look out for the timed training board after a couple of laps into your practice.

This year the ACU have implemented the wearing of body armour (front and back) our scrutineer's will be checking randomly on the line and you will be pulled if you have not complied. We will also randomly check for fire extinguishers at your van.

Don't forget after the meeting riders and spectators can reflect on times, positions and overall positions using the MyLaps website or the new MYLAPS Speedhive app on your iPhone or Android device.

Sidcup MCC would like to welcome and thank BM Ambulance Service Ltd who have helped us out at this meeting when our St John's regulars had to pull out due to staff shortages.

On a sour note:

Motocross is blighted at the moment by low life who travel to meetings countrywide with one thing in mind to steal bikes, generators and anything they can get away with, despite our CCTV footage being shown to Police we are pretty much on our own, lock everything and watch out for your neighbours belongings as well as your own.

Special thanks to Eastwood Wiseco Honda racing who for the third year running have boosted the prize money to £1000.00 per SEMX meeting.

Finally please take all your rubbish back to the bins or home with you as whatever litter is left has to be picked up by a volunteer who would much rather go home early after a good days Motocross racing.

Timed Qualification

Part of each Allcomer group's Practice session will be timed to decide the qualifiers for Groups A, B and C.

The fastest 33% from Q1, Q2 and Q3 will form the A Group. The next 33% will form the B Group. The remainder will form the C Group.

Unauthorised Riding

The riding of machines of any sort in the paddock and areas surrounding the circuit is totally forbidden. Because the event is on private property it does not place it outside the Road Traffic Act in terms of insurance. It cannot be stressed too strongly, that liability for a substantial claim could rest with the owners of the vehicle and the driver (or parents in the case of a minor) in the event of an accident.

It is also advised that all competitors should wear a body belt/kidney protector. Checks will be made at technical control and the holding area at the start.

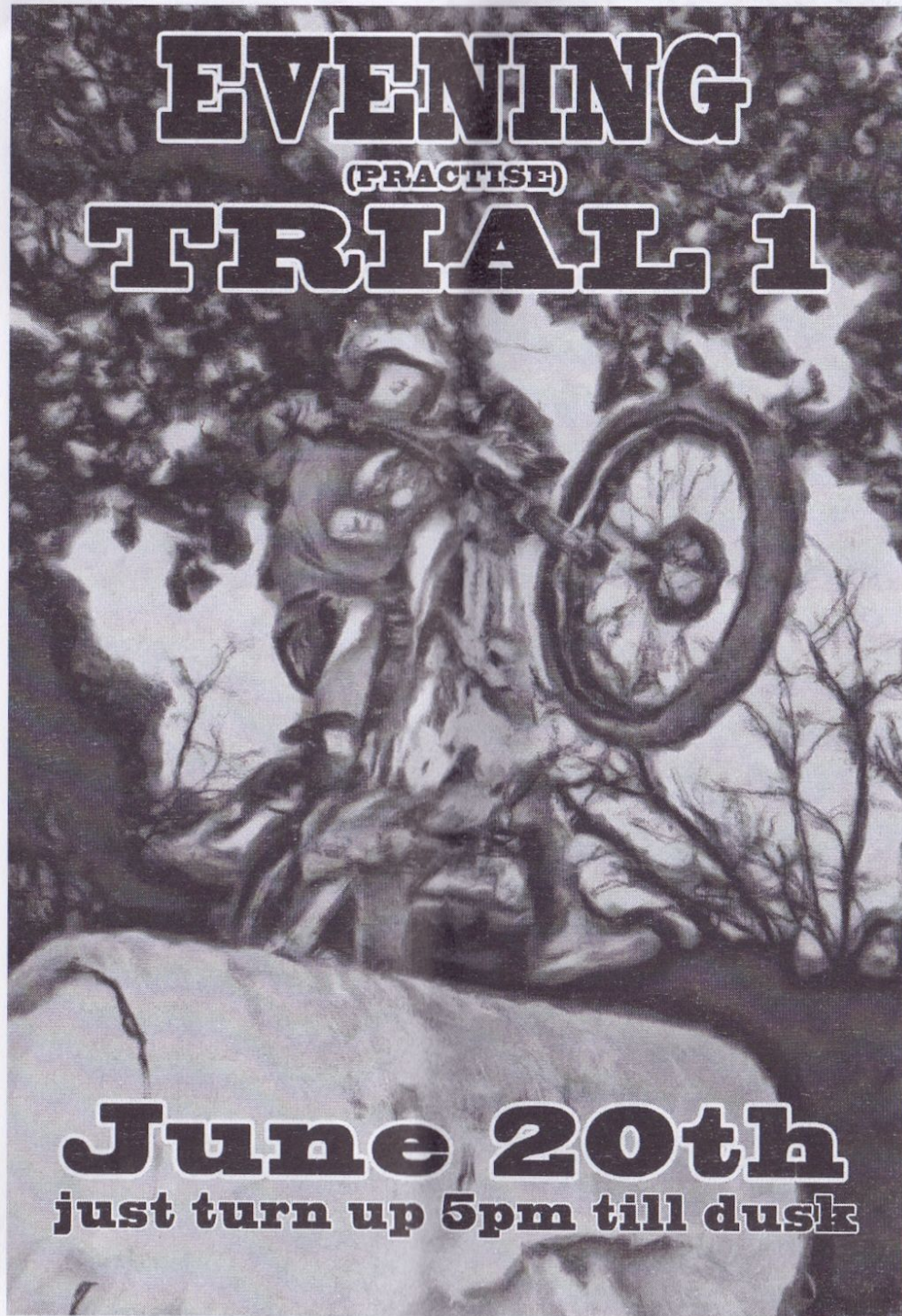
