

This race is open to all solo machines. It will prove very popular due to the high level of prize money paid on the day, and the fact that the Open class pitts the skills of riders on bigger engines against the smaller, lightweight machines. This race is the only one of the day to count double in points, and being eligible for club championship, gives the rider just the one shot at getting in the points and prize money available. The race results pay the first ten finishers £110, £75, £50, £40, £30, £20, £20, £20, £15 and £15 respectively, with points awarded 20, 16, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 to the first nine finishers. The end of year championship pays £400 to the winner, and all prize money paid on the day and at the end of the year is donated by Business Systems Group. This class is eligible for the overall club championship.


