This race is open to bikes from 550cc up to 1100cc. The race results i the first race pay the first four finishers £50, £30, £20, and £10 respectively, with the second race awarding trophies. Points are awarded 20, 16, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 to the first nine finishers in each race. The end of year championship pays £250 to the winner, donated by best of bikes (Doug Randall). This class is eligible for the overall club championship.






