

THE LATE KEN HALL

Who was Ken Hall? What was the history of this popular Petersfield man whose tragic death in 1965 eventually brought the Ken Hall Memorial Trophy Scramble into being.

A tree-feller by occupation, Ken started scrambling in 1950—at a time when motorcycle sport had just regained all its old glory and glamour after the involuntary shut-down caused by World War II.

Never a rich man, Ken's machinery was seldom new. But his determination and courage—his strength and sheer dedication—more than made amends for any mechanical deficiency.

Soon he was challenging Phil Nex, Derek Rickman, Triss Sharp and those other Southern Centre stars who ruled the roost 20 years ago.

By 1954, Ken had become so swift that he won the St. Paul Trophy—and his prowess was brought to the attention of Ariels (who lent him a potent five-hundred for the whole of one season).

Next year he finished third in the Southern Centre Scramble Star contest—beaten only by Derek and Don Rickman. Derek was in fantastic form then, and won the Southern Centre Scramble Championship three times on the trot.

In 1960, at the old Midgham circuit near Newbury, Ken Hall was involved in a spectacular pile-up. He never fully recovered, and we thought we had seen the last of him as a scrambler.

Indeed we had. But in 1965, he reckoned he was fit enough to dabble in grass-track racing. With his engine "breathed on" by Guy Newman, he began to show good results.

Then, finally, disaster struck. At a Salisbury grass-track meeting that summer, Ken suffered another spill. While he lay on the ground, his skull was fractured by the footrest of a following machine.

The Petersfield Flyer never fully regained consciousness, and he died several weeks later. With Ken Hall's passing went perhaps the last link with that carefree era of non-professionalism which characterised Southern Centre scrambling throughout the 'fifties.
