

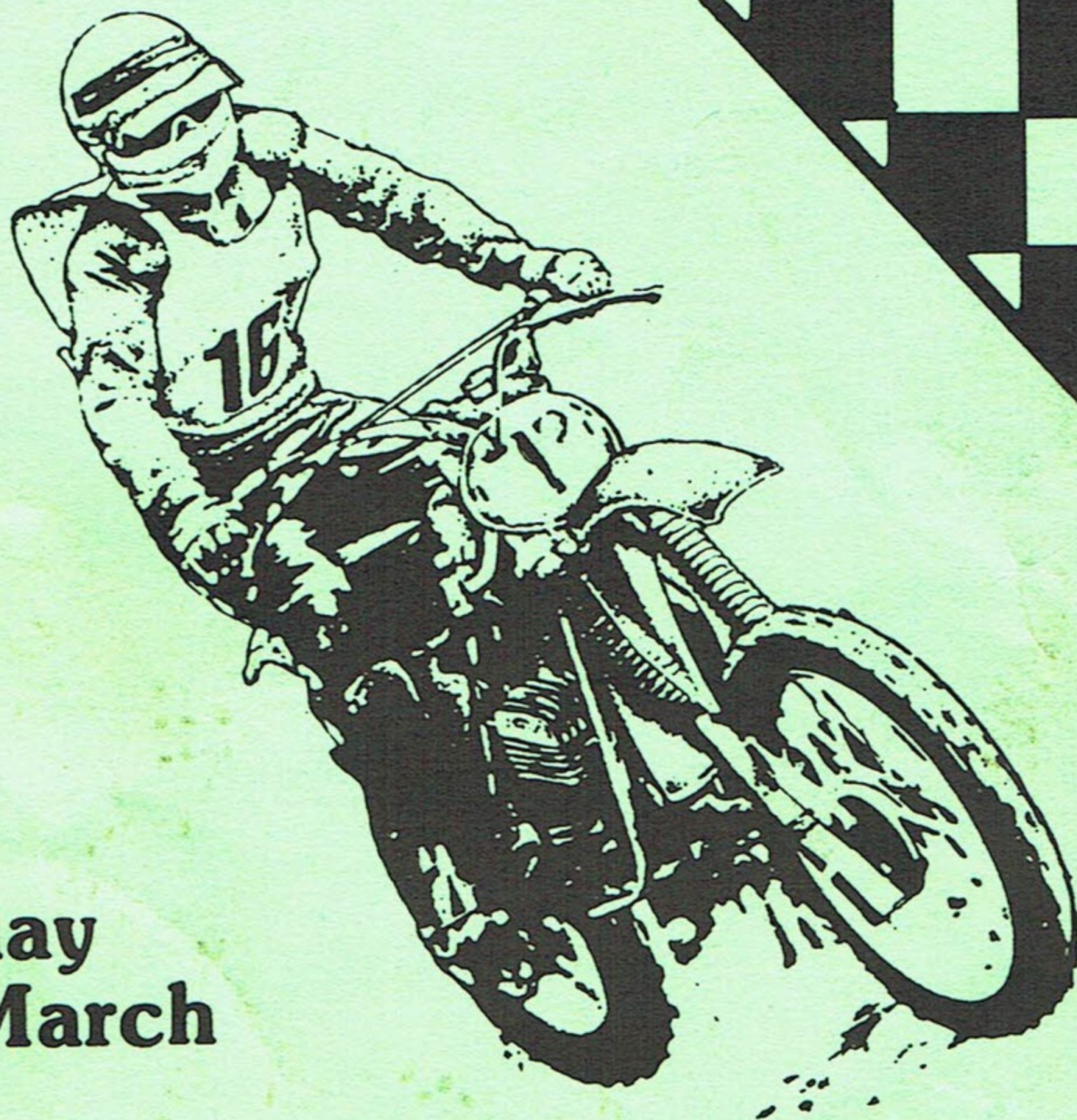

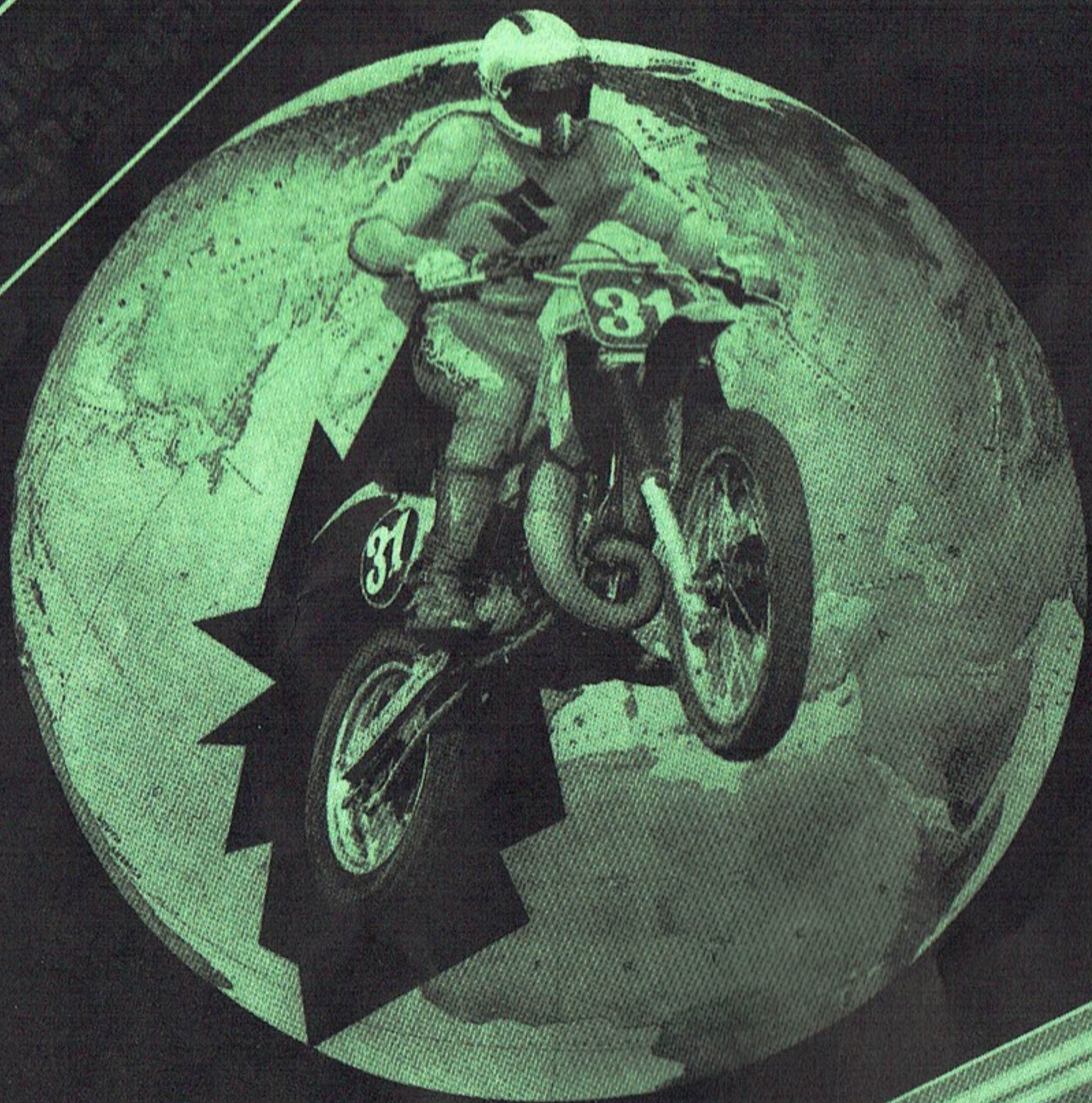

Foreword

by Western Morning News Motor Cycling Correspondent Mick Perry

Hello and welcome to the first major Moto-X of the year. The Patchquick has long been regarded as the "curtain raiser" for the forthcoming British championships, and with all the main title contestants entered the stage is set for an abundance of close and thrilling wheel to wheel racing throughout all three 25 minutes plus two lap legs for the coveted trophy.

The circuit here at Whiteway Barton has been extended since last year's meeting. It now features several new jumps, including a new "Ski" jump.

Every one of the aces will be hoping to start the new season with a win but the question of who is going to come out on top will only be answered when the points are totted up after the final leg, but Dave Thorpe, winner for the past two years, will be going for his hat trick. If he does pull it off, he'll create history by being the first ever to win three consecutive Patchquicks.

The Berkshire youngster, has an impressive track record here winning six races from as many starts—3 on Kawasaki and 3 on Honda machinery.

Former Maico star "Badger" Goss holds the record with four wins to his credit, the last ten years ago in 1974; Bryan will be present today presenting the silverware.

Carrying the number two plate today is Honda's new signing Neil Hudson. The former World 250cc Kingpin, who has recently moved back to the West Country, will be making his debut at Whiteway, but he scored his first ever National win in the 1976 event at Denbury—on a Maico, and he also trumped the aces in that wet and muddy 1981 event at Rocombe.

Like Hudson former World Champion Graham Noyce has yet to set foot on the track but with his reputation and renowned fighting spirit he's bound to create quickfire action on board his new KTM's. He won the event in 79 and then went on to win the World Title for Honda.

Suzuki are the only Japanese factory not to have won the event, but I'm pretty sure that the talented Jem Whatley, Willie Simpson and Steve Beamish will be trying to put the record straight today.

Watch out too for soft spoken Gloucester based Dave Watson who gave Thorpe many anxious moments last year. On this occasion Dave will be mounted on a Boyesen Kawasaki—a marque favoured too by 1978 winner Rob Hooper.

"The older he gets the faster he goes" was how one of his rivals described new National 125 Champion Roger Harvey. Yamaha mounted Roger never fails to shine in the West Country and although he's an invariably slow starter he's always around at the end of a long hard race.

It is perhaps unfair to single out individuals in a star spangled line up but Kurt Nicoll, Kevin Froud and Andy Nicholls were three of the most improved riders on the circuits last year and are bound to be in contention today.


The meeting takes on something of an "International" flavour with the inclusion of Ulsterman Laurence Spence—remember his heroic ride in the British Grand Prix at Farleigh Castle last year—and fellow countryman Julian Patterson together with British Enduro Champion Geraint Jones.

A quick glance through the entry for the supporting event and one is assured that there's plenty of talent filtering through from the schoolboy ranks.

1983 winner Tony Caig is competing in the main event and being realistic it is an "any one from forty" situation, but I personally will be expecting to see Mayson Wear, Stewart House, Ian Bettison and Alan Blood fighting for places on the winners rostrum at the end of the day, however there are thirty-six others waiting to prove me wrong. But whatever the result please, please, keep well behind the ropes, heed the advice of Marshals, and finally give as generously as you possibly can to the Red Cross appeal in the Interval and on the way out. And finally make a note of the date of the Club's British Championship round at Rocombe near Torquay on July 29th. See you there.



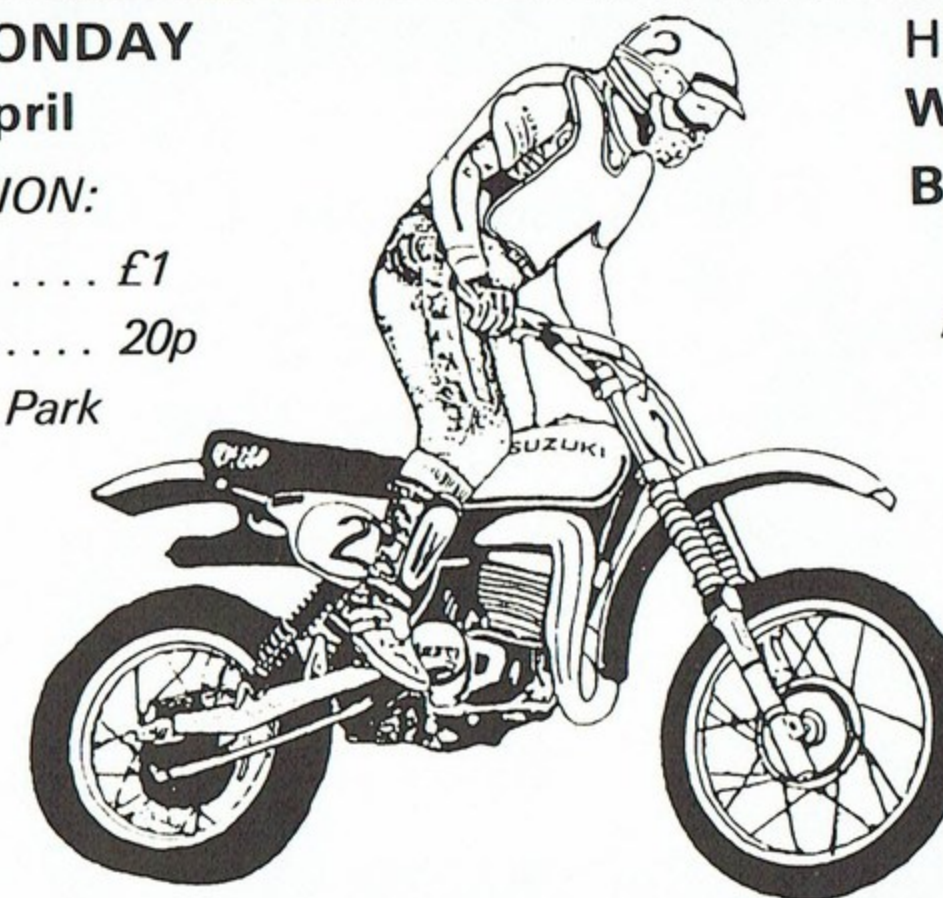


