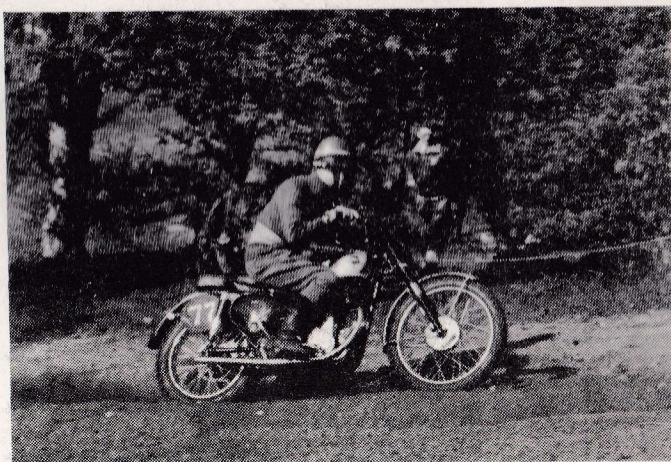

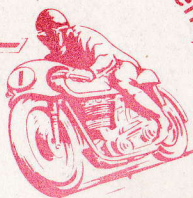

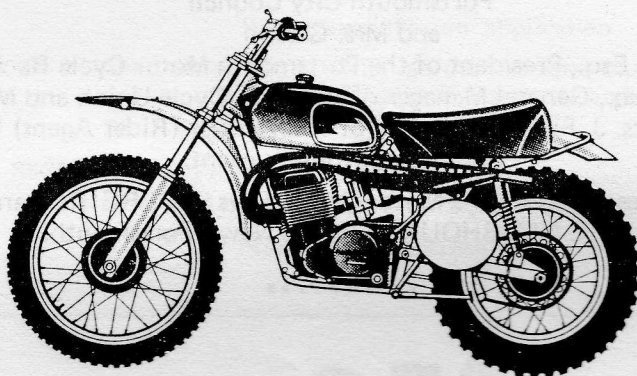

## MARTIN CHRISTIE of *MOTOR CYCLE* writes —

This Sunday the eyes of the Moto Cross World are turned on Britain. It's two year's since a Grand Prix was held in this country, and never before have the world's top riders appeared at the Ladies' Mile, Chalton course. So today the spotlight falls on the go-ahead Portsmouth Club, upon the enthusiastic support of it's members, and the generous sponsorship of local dealer John Fisher.

But also on test today will be Britain's scrambling hopes. Our six men on the line today combine three of the best we have in experience, and three of the most promising young riders. Britain has not shone in the 250 cc World Championship for more than ten years — since the days of Dave Bickers and Greeves. If we are to again, it is in the hands of our team at Chalton today.

British Champion, Malcolm Davis, tied down with his own Motorcycle business in Gloucester, has abandoned the long haul and the expense of the international circuit. But on a course he has ridden well before, Malcolm's consistent, tactical riding will make him a good pacemaker for the British line-up.

Similarly, Rob Taylor (Maico) has the experience to stay well up among the finishers, though he has never excelled in the Grand Prix.

But the main hopes must lie with 28 year-old Scot Vic Allan, the only Briton contesting all the World Championship rounds this year. Crippled with a broken ankle last year, Vic does not know the Chalton course so well, but with a string of British wins behind him, and good showing in the Grand Prix so far, we should expect to see his factory Bultaco well up with the leaders today.

Leading the young British contingent, and contesting several of the Grand Prix, 23 year-old Roger Harvey (Yamaha) will be out to demonstrate his international experience before the home crowds. Throwing off bad form that dogged his switch from Husqvarna, he should surprise people today. So too could 22 year-old Stuart Nunn (CZ). He has a lot of experience of the long 45-minute races, and will be well up amongst the runners.

Youngest and least experienced, 20 year old Terry Dyer is on good form, but will be struggling to overcome unreliability that has hindered the Suzuki GB camp this season.

But, though they are all riding at Chalton for the first time, the international opposition will be devastating. On current showing, the two most dangerous men are young Czech Jaroslav Falta (CZ) and wild Russian Gennady Moiseev (KTM).

Moiseev, at 26, is one of the Soviet Union's most formidable and experienced moto cross men. Like 23 year-old Falta, he is a dedicated sportsman. The state-backed East Europeans work a seven-day week practising and racing on scrambles tracks. The only thing which has held them back so far has been lack of experience against the tactical riding of the top Western internationals. This could be the year of their wild, unconventional style. And Falta, the man who won the last 250 cc British Grand Prix, looks to be the likely man.

Reigning Champion Swede Hakan Andersson (Yamaha) has had a disastrous season so far, breaking his right wrist in Spain, and straining leg and back muscles in a practise pile-up in Czechoslovakia. He seems to have no chance of catching up the points leaders to defend his title, but if he regains his lost luck, the determined 28 year-old could be a threat today.

Favourite with the crowds, multi-champion Joel Robert is still quick enough to set the pace, but marriage and middle-age spread have set aside his serious title chasing. Other Suzuki team members, and fellow Belgian Sylvain Geboers should be well up though, and I expect Geboers in particular to excel on the Chalton course.

But the real starlets today should be some of the younger riders. 21 year old Belgian Harry Everts on the six-speed Austrian Puch won't win, but could be in the first three. Compatriot, 20 year old Raymond Boven should be well up for Montesa. West German Hans Maisch, who just happens to be the son of the Maico boss, is motoring too.

The big surprise this year is the performance of the European factories — and the relative decline of the Japanese. A complete reversal of recent history. Swede Torleif Hansen will be spectacular, but is dogged by an unreliable Kawasaki.

Riding in Britain for the first time, American hope Jim Pomeroy still has a lot of handling to sort out on the factory Bultaco, through his own personal preferences.

Finn Kalevi Vehkonen has been off form since his switch from Montesa to Husqvarna, but the Girling gas-and-oil damped rear units he uses will be the only British component in today's Grand Prix — a sad comment on the decline of our moto cross industry.

We can only offer up some of our best riding talent. And they will have their work cut out, when even the second-string foreign entries are so quick. Pavel Rulev (Russia, KTM), Herbert Schmitz (West Germany, Puch), Jo Lammers (Holland, Bultaco) and Eugene Ribalchenko (Russia, CZ) — all of them very experienced internationals, who will be hard men to get by. So have your programmes ready to wave when you see the Union Jack go by.
